Blurry images	Out of focus, atmospheric conditions, dirty lens.	Adjust focus using the app. Wait for better seeing conditions. Clean the lens carefully.
Tracking issues	Improper calibration, unstable tripod, low battery.	Recalibrate the telescope. Ensure tripod is stable and level. Charge the battery.
App crashes or freezes	Outdated app version, device compatibility issues, insufficient device memory.	Update the DWARF Lab app. Check device compatibility. Close other apps to free up memory.
