# NBD K200 64MP 4K Digital Camera Instruction Manual

Model: K200

## 1. OVERVIEW

The NBD K200 is a compact digital camera designed for capturing high-quality photos and videos. It features a 64MP photo resolution, 4K video recording capabilities, 16X digital zoom, and autofocus. Its lightweight design and user-friendly interface make it suitable for various users, including beginners and travelers.

## 2. SETUP

### 2.1 Charging the Battery

Before first use, fully charge the camera battery. The camera uses a Lithium Ion battery.

1. Insert the battery into the camera's battery compartment.
2. Connect the camera to a power source using the provided USB-C cable.
3. The charging indicator light will show the charging status. A full charge typically allows for over 300 photos.

### 2.2 Inserting the Memory Card

The camera supports microSD cards. A 64GB TF card is included.

1. Locate the memory card slot on the camera.
2. Insert the TF card into the slot with the gold contacts facing the correct direction until it clicks into place.

3. To remove, press the card gently until it springs out.

## 3. OPERATING THE CAMERA

---

### 3.1 Power On/Off

Press and hold the power button to turn the camera on or off.

### 3.2 Basic Controls

The camera features a Multi-Functional Roller Button for simplified operation.

- **Roller Button:** Used for one-touch mode switching and precise zoom adjustment. Roll left to zoom out, roll right to zoom in.
- **Shutter Button:** Press to take a photo or start/stop video recording.
- **Mode Button:** Cycles through different shooting modes.
- **Flash Button:** Activates the built-in flash.

### 3.3 Taking Photos

The camera features autofocus for clear images.

1. Point the camera at your subject. The autofocus system will automatically detect and focus.

2. Use the roller button to adjust the 16X digital zoom as needed.
3. Press the shutter button fully to capture the photo.

### 3.4 Recording Videos

The camera supports 4K video recording at various frame rates (24, 30, 60 FPS).

1. Switch to video mode using the mode button or roller.
2. Press the shutter button to start recording. A red indicator will typically appear on the screen.
3. Press the shutter button again to stop recording.

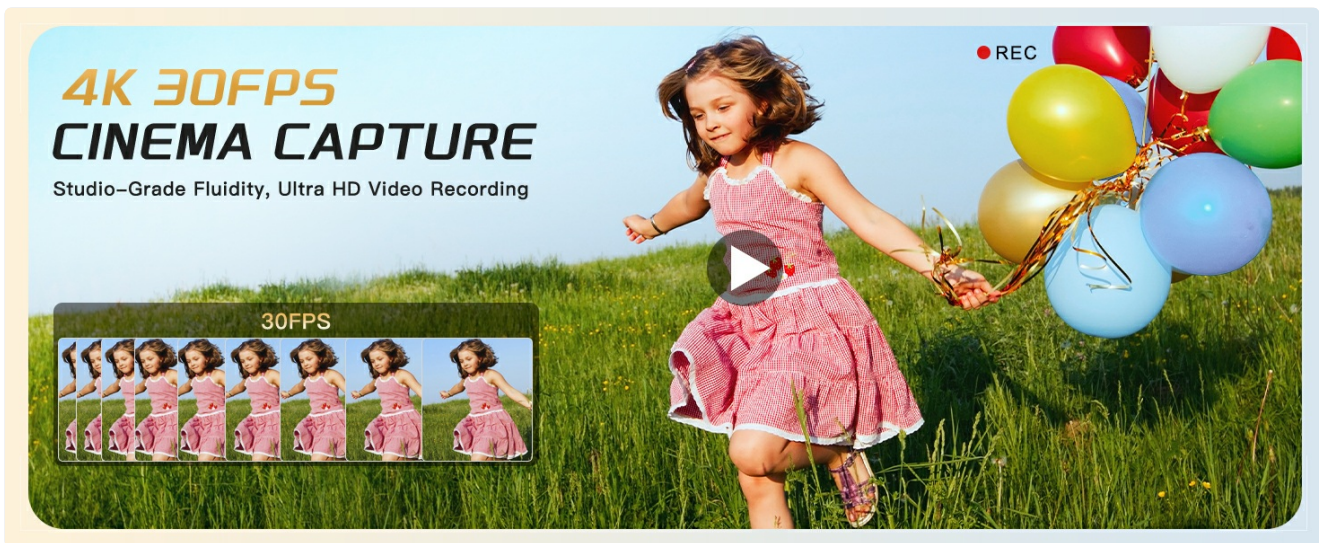
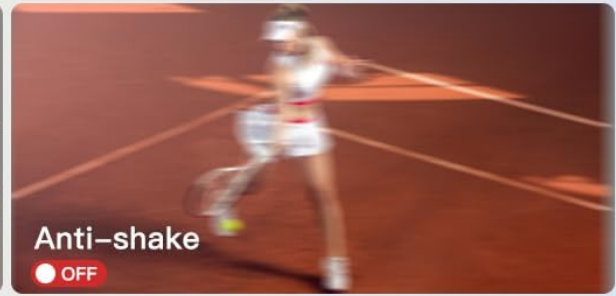

### 3.5 Shooting Modes and Features

The NBD K200 offers several modes and features to enhance your photography.

- **Beauty Mode:** Enhances facial features for portraits and selfies.
- **Night Mode:** Optimizes settings for low-light conditions, smoothing grain and balancing tones.
- **Portrait Mode:** Designed for capturing natural radiance in subjects, balancing tones and softening light.
- **Sport Mode:** Ideal for capturing fast-moving subjects with anti-shake stabilization.
- **Burst Mode:** Captures multiple photos in quick succession (up to 10FPS) for action shots.
- **Built-in Filters:** Apply various creative filters like Vintage, Cool Tone, Warm Tone, Sepia, Sketch, and Japan Style.
- **Self-Timer:** Options for 3, 5, 7, or 10-second delays for group shots or selfies.

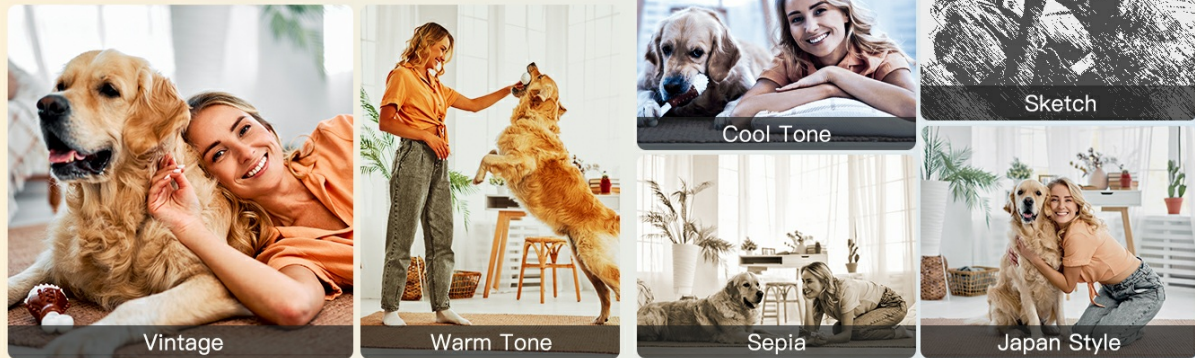

### 3.6 Transferring Files

Transfer photos and videos to a computer or smartphone using the USB-C cable.

1. Connect the camera to your device using the USB-C cable.
2. The camera will appear as a removable storage device.
3. Drag and drop files to your desired location.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

### 4.1 Battery Care

- Charge the battery fully before extended storage.
- Avoid exposing the battery to extreme temperatures.
- Use only the provided or approved charging cables and adapters.

### 4.2 Cleaning the Camera

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the camera body.
- For the lens, use a specialized lens cleaning cloth and solution. Avoid touching the lens directly.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

### 4.3 Storage

- Store the camera in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- If storing for a long period, remove the battery.
- Keep the camera in its protective case or a soft pouch to prevent scratches.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
---------	-------------------

Problem	Possible Solution
Camera does not power on	Ensure the battery is charged and correctly inserted.
Cannot take photos/videos	Check if the memory card is inserted and has sufficient space. Ensure the camera is not in playback mode.
Images are blurry	Ensure autofocus is engaged. Check for smudges on the lens. Hold the camera steady or use anti-shake feature.
Camera not recognized by computer	Ensure the USB-C cable is securely connected. Try a different USB port or cable.
Flash not working	Ensure the flash is enabled in the camera settings or via the dedicated flash button.
