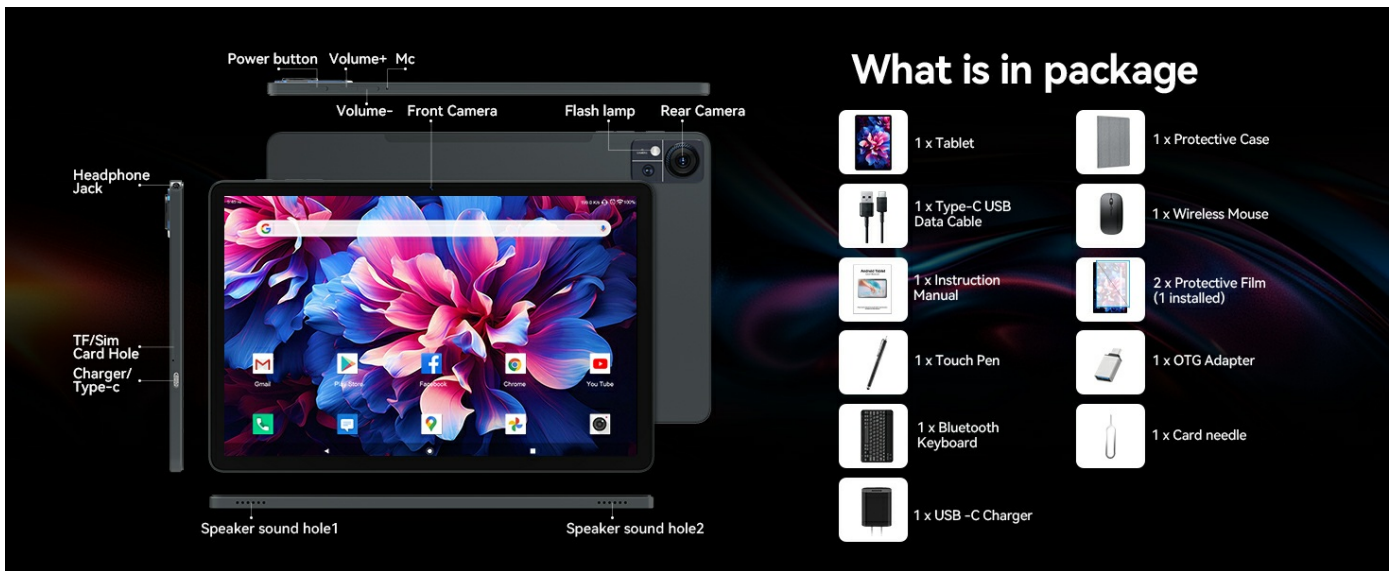


Figure 2.1: Tablet components and included accessories.

3. DEVICE OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the physical features and ports of your ZONKO tablet.

3.1. Tablet Layout

The tablet features an 11-inch Incell display, dual cameras, and various ports for connectivity.

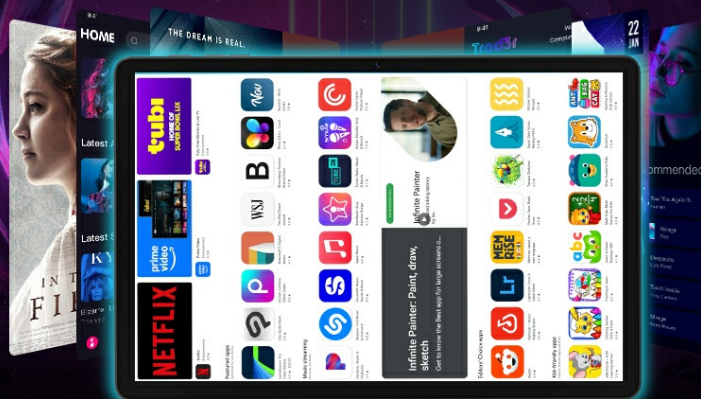


Figure 3.1: Front view of the ZONKO 11-inch Android 15 Tablet.

3.2. Ports and Buttons

- **Power Button:** Located on the side, used to power on/off or wake/sleep the device.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjust audio volume.
- **USB Type-C Port:** For charging and data transfer.
- **Headphone Jack:** For connecting wired headphones.
- **TF/SIM Card Slot:** For inserting a microSD card (up to 1TB) or a SIM card (for LTE models, check compatibility).
- **Front Camera:** For video calls and selfies.
- **Rear Camera:** For taking photos and videos.

4. SETUP

4.1. Initial Charging

1. Connect the provided Type-C cable to the tablet's charging port.
2. Plug the charger into a power outlet.
3. Allow the tablet to charge fully before first use. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging status.

The tablet is equipped with an 8000mAh battery, providing approximately 9 hours of average use on a full charge.

4.2. Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button until the ZONKO logo appears.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until the power options appear on the screen, then select "Power off."
- **To Sleep/Wake:** Briefly press the Power button.

4.3. Initial Android 15 Setup

Upon first power-on, follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup:

- Select your language.
- Connect to a Wi-Fi network.
- Sign in with your Google account or create a new one.
- Review and accept terms and conditions.
- Set up screen lock (PIN, pattern, password).

4.4. Inserting a MicroSD Card or SIM Card

To expand storage or use cellular data (if applicable):

1. Locate the SIM/SD card tray on the side of the tablet.
2. Insert the provided eject pin into the small hole next to the tray to open it.
3. Place the microSD card (gold contacts facing down) or SIM card into the designated slot(s) on the tray.
4. Carefully push the tray back into the tablet until it clicks into place.

4.5. Connecting Accessories

Your tablet comes with a Bluetooth keyboard, wireless mouse, and touch pen. Follow these steps to connect them:

4.5.1. Bluetooth Keyboard and Wireless Mouse

1. Ensure the keyboard and mouse are charged and powered on.
2. On your tablet, go to **Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth**.
3. Turn on Bluetooth and select "Pair new device."
4. Select the keyboard or mouse from the list of available devices and follow any on-screen pairing instructions.

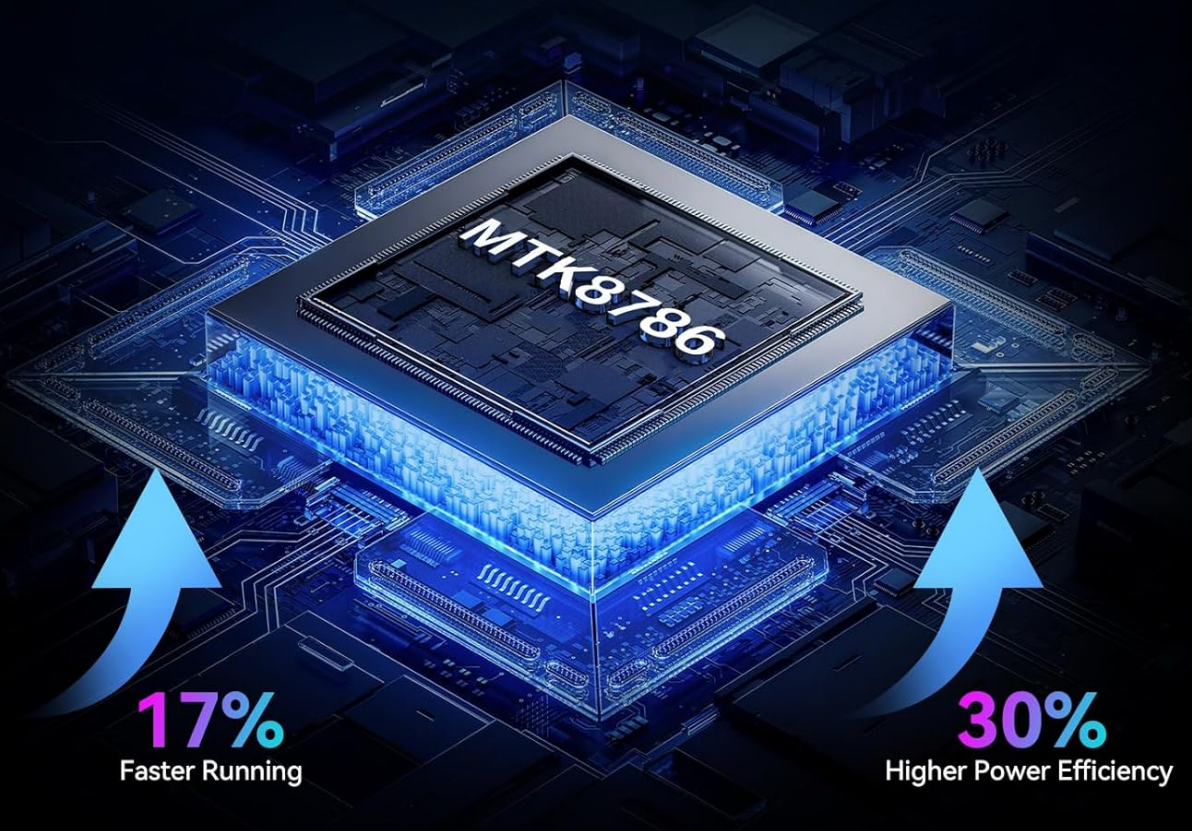

4.5.2. Touch Pen

The touch pen typically does not require pairing and can be used directly on the screen for navigation and input.

5. OPERATING

5.1. Basic Navigation (Android 15)

Your tablet runs on Android 15, offering an intuitive user experience.

- **Home Screen:** Swipe left or right to access different home screen panels.
- **App Drawer:** Swipe up from the bottom of the screen to view all installed applications.
- **Notifications & Quick Settings:** Swipe down from the top of the screen to access notifications and quick settings toggles.
- **Multitasking:** Swipe up and hold from the bottom of the screen to view recent apps.

5.2. Wi-Fi Connectivity

To connect to a Wi-Fi network:

1. Go to **Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi**.
2. Turn on Wi-Fi.
3. Select your desired network from the list and enter the password if prompted.

The tablet supports 2.4GHz and 5G dual-band Wi-Fi for stable and fast internet access.

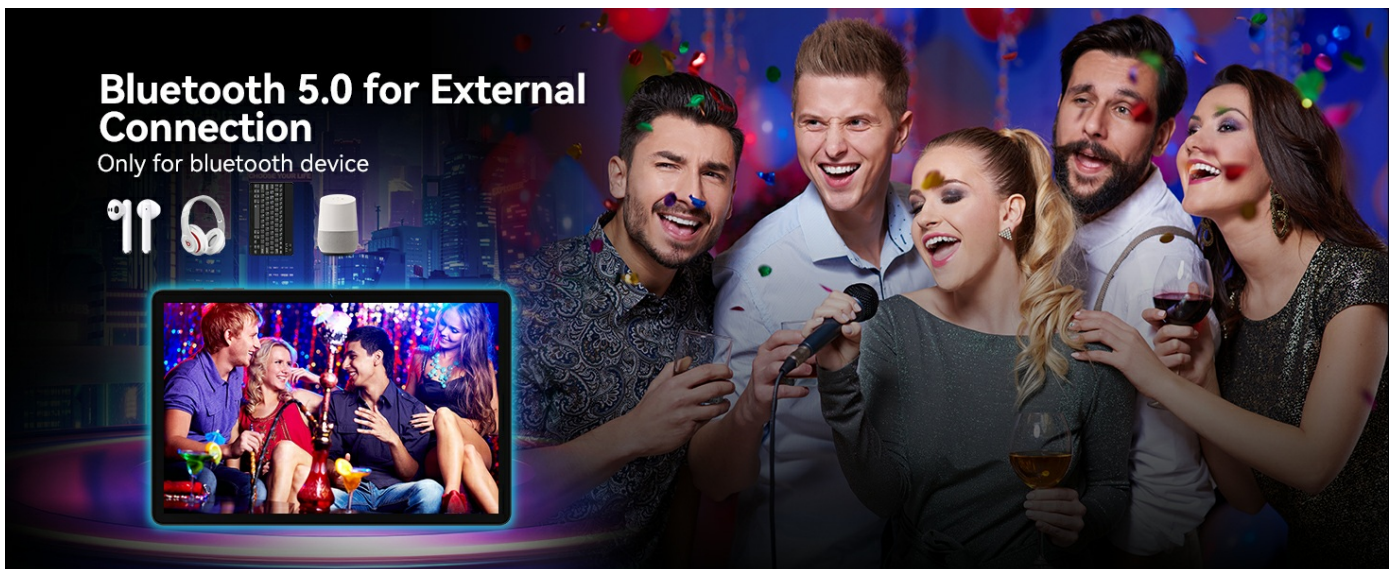


Figure 5.2: Wi-Fi and Bluetooth connection indicators.

5.3. Bluetooth Connectivity

To connect to Bluetooth devices (e.g., headphones, speakers):

1. Go to **Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth**.
2. Turn on Bluetooth.
3. Ensure your Bluetooth device is in pairing mode.
4. Select the device from the list and follow any on-screen pairing instructions.

5.4. Using the Cameras

The tablet features a 21MP rear camera and a 13MP front camera.

1. Open the Camera app.
2. Tap the camera switch icon to toggle between front and rear cameras.
3. Tap the shutter button to take a photo or start/stop video recording.

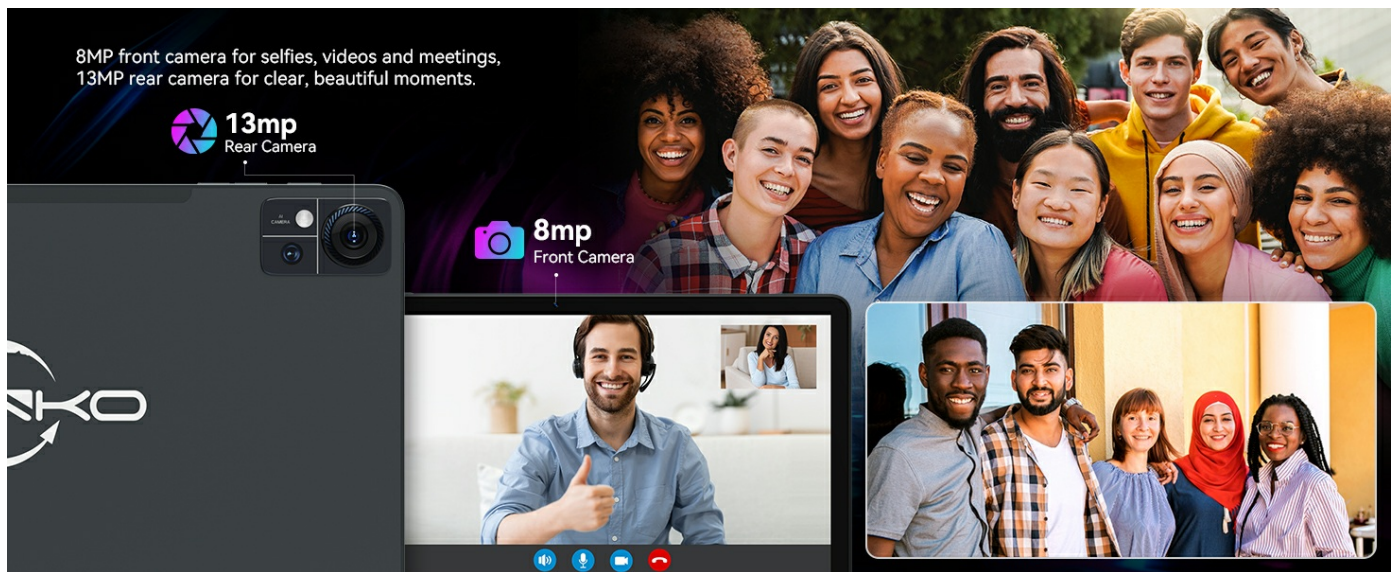


Figure 5.3: Tablet camera in use, showing both front and rear camera capabilities.

5.5. Storage Management

Your tablet comes with 128GB of internal storage and supports up to 1TB microSD card expansion. It also has 16GB RAM (8GB physical + 8GB virtual) for smooth operation.

- To check storage: Go to **Settings > Storage**.
- To manage files: Use the pre-installed Files app or download a file manager from the Google Play Store.

5.6. GPS Functionality

The built-in GPS allows for navigation and location-based services.

- Ensure Location services are enabled in **Settings > Location**.
- Use pre-installed map applications or download others from the Google Play Store.

5.7. Google Play Store

As a GMS certified device, you can download and install a wide variety of applications from the Google Play Store.

1. Open the **Play Store** app.
2. Search for apps, games, movies, or books.
3. Tap "Install" to download and install your chosen content.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1. Battery Care

- Avoid exposing the tablet to extreme temperatures.
- Do not let the battery drain completely regularly. Charge it when the battery level is low.
- Use only the provided charger and cable to prevent damage.

6.2. Cleaning the Device

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the tablet.
- For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen cleaner designed for electronics.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

6.3. Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure optimal performance and security.

1. Go to **Settings > System > System update**.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to download and install any available updates.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your tablet, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Solution
Tablet does not power on.	Ensure the tablet is charged. Connect it to the charger for at least 30 minutes, then try powering on again.
Wi-Fi connection issues.	Restart your Wi-Fi router and the tablet. Check if other devices can connect to the Wi-Fi. Ensure you have entered the correct password.
Apps are crashing or freezing.	Close the problematic app and reopen it. Clear the app's cache in Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache . Restart the tablet.
Tablet is slow or unresponsive.	Close unnecessary background apps. Clear cached data. Consider performing a factory reset (back up your data first).
Accessories (keyboard/mouse) not connecting.	Ensure accessories are charged and in pairing mode. Re-pair them via Bluetooth settings.
