1. INTRODUCTION

3. SETUP AND FITTING

Proper fitting and setup are crucial for comfort and performance.

1. Lacing:

Insert your foot into the cleat. Begin lacing from the bottom eyelets, ensuring the laces are snug but not overly tight across the forefoot. Work your way up, pulling the laces evenly through each eyelet.

2. Midfoot Strap Adjustment:

Once laced, secure the midfoot strap. This strap provides additional lockdown and support. Adjust it to a comfortable tension that holds your foot firmly in place without restricting circulation.

3. Fit Check:

Walk around and perform some light movements to ensure the cleats fit properly. Your toes should not touch the very end of the cleat, and your heel should feel secure with minimal slippage.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

These cleats are designed for football activities on appropriate playing surfaces.

- **Intended Use:** Use these cleats for football on natural grass or artificial turf fields.
- **Surface Compatibility:** The stud configuration is optimized for traction on soft to firm ground conditions. Avoid using on hard surfaces like concrete or asphalt, as this can damage the cleats and reduce their lifespan.
- **Break-in Period:** Allow for a short break-in period during light activities to adapt the cleats to your foot shape and movement patterns.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning After Use:**

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common issues and their potential solutions.

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Discomfort or Blisters	Improper fit, new cleats not broken in, incorrect sock choice.	Ensure proper lacing and strap adjustment. Allow for a break-in period. Wear appropriate athletic socks.

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Reduced Traction	Mud or debris accumulated on studs, worn studs, unsuitable playing surface.	Clean studs thoroughly after each use. Inspect studs for wear; replace cleats if studs are significantly worn. Ensure cleats are used on appropriate surfaces.
Odor	Moisture retention, lack of proper drying.	Ensure cleats are thoroughly air-dried after each use. Use shoe deodorizers if necessary.
