




Image: Contents of the HP OmniDesk M03 package, including the desktop PC, wireless keyboard, and wireless mouse.

4. SETUP

4.1 Initial Setup

- 1. Unpack: Carefully remove the HP OmniDesk M03 PC and all accessories from the packaging.
- 2. Connect Monitor: Connect your monitor to one of the DisplayPort or HDMI outputs on the rear panel of the PC.
- 3. **Connect Peripherals:** Plug in the wireless keyboard and mouse. Ensure they are powered on and paired according to their respective instructions.
- 4. Connect Power: Connect the power cable to the PC's power input and then to a grounded electrical outlet.
- 5. Power On: Press the power button located on the front panel of the PC.
- 6. **Windows Setup:** Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup of Windows 11 Home. This may include setting up your user account, network connection, and privacy settings.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Power On/Off

- To Power On: Press the power button on the front panel of the PC.
- To Shut Down: In Windows 11, click the Start button, then select Power, and choose Shut down.
- To Restart: In Windows 11, click the Start button, then select Power, and choose Restart.

5.2 Connecting Peripherals and Network

- **USB Devices:** Use the available USB Type-A and Type-C ports on both the front and rear panels to connect external devices such as external hard drives, printers, or webcams.
- Wireless Connectivity: The HP OmniDesk M03 supports Wi-Fi 6 (802.11ax) with MU-MIMO and Bluetooth 5.4 for wireless network and peripheral connections. Access these settings via the Windows Settings menu.
- Wired Network: Connect an Ethernet cable to the RJ45 port on the rear panel for a wired network connection.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning

- Exterior: Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the exterior surfaces of the PC. Avoid using liquid cleaners directly on the components.
- Ventilation: Ensure that the ventilation openings are clear of dust and obstructions to maintain proper airflow.

6.2 Software Updates

- Windows Updates: Regularly check for and install Windows updates to ensure your operating system has the latest security patches and features. Go to Settings > Windows Update.
- **Driver Updates:** Keep your device drivers, especially for graphics and chipset, updated for optimal performance and compatibility. These can often be found on the HP support website or through Windows Update.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

7.1 Common Issues and Solutions

No Power:

Symptom: The PC does not turn on when the power button is pressed.

Solution: Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the PC and a functional electrical outlet. Test the outlet with another device.

. No Display:

Symptom: The monitor shows no signal or remains black.

Solution: Verify that the monitor is powered on and the video cable (DisplayPort or HDMI) is securely connected to both the PC and the monitor. Try connecting the monitor to a different video output port on the PC.

Keyboard/Mouse Not Responding:

Symptom: The wireless keyboard or mouse does not function.

Solution: Check the batteries in the keyboard and mouse. Ensure they are properly paired with the PC. For wired peripherals, verify USB connections.

• No Internet Connection:

Symptom: Unable to access the internet.

Solution: For Wi-Fi, check network settings in Windows and ensure you are connected to the correct network. For wired connections, verify the Ethernet cable is properly connected to both the PC and the router/modem. Restart your
