1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the BOUDECH Manny Workbench. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new workbench. Please read these instructions carefully before assembly and retain them for future reference.

The BOUDECH Manny Workbench is designed for use in workshops, garages, and other work environments, offering a robust and organized workspace. It features a durable work surface, a convenient tool drawer, a storage cabinet with a door, and an open shelf.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Read all instructions:** Ensure you understand all assembly and safety instructions before beginning.
- **Wear appropriate safety gear:** Use gloves and eye protection during assembly to prevent injury.
- **Assemble on a flat, stable surface:** This prevents damage to components and ensures stability.
- **Do not overtighten fasteners:** Tighten screws and bolts securely, but avoid overtightening which can strip threads or damage components.
- **Distribute weight evenly:** Do not overload the workbench, drawer, or shelves. Distribute weight evenly to maintain stability. The maximum load capacity is 200 kg.
- **Keep children and pets away:** During assembly and use, keep children and pets at a safe distance.
- **Regularly inspect:** Periodically check all fasteners and connections to ensure they remain tight and secure.
- **Use as intended:** This workbench is designed for general workshop and garage use. Do not use it for purposes other than its intended function.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before assembly, verify that all components are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support.

- Workbench frame components (legs, crossbars)
- Work surface panel
- Drawer assembly (drawer, slides, handle)
- Cabinet assembly (door, hinges, handle, lock)
- Open shelf panel
- Fasteners (bolts, nuts, screws)
- Assembly tools (usually an Allen key or wrench, not always included)

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly is required for this workbench. Follow the steps below carefully. It is recommended to have two people for assembly.

Step 1: Assemble the Frame

Begin by assembling the main frame of the workbench. Connect the legs to the crossbars using the provided bolts and nuts. Ensure all connections are secure but do not fully tighten until the entire frame is assembled.

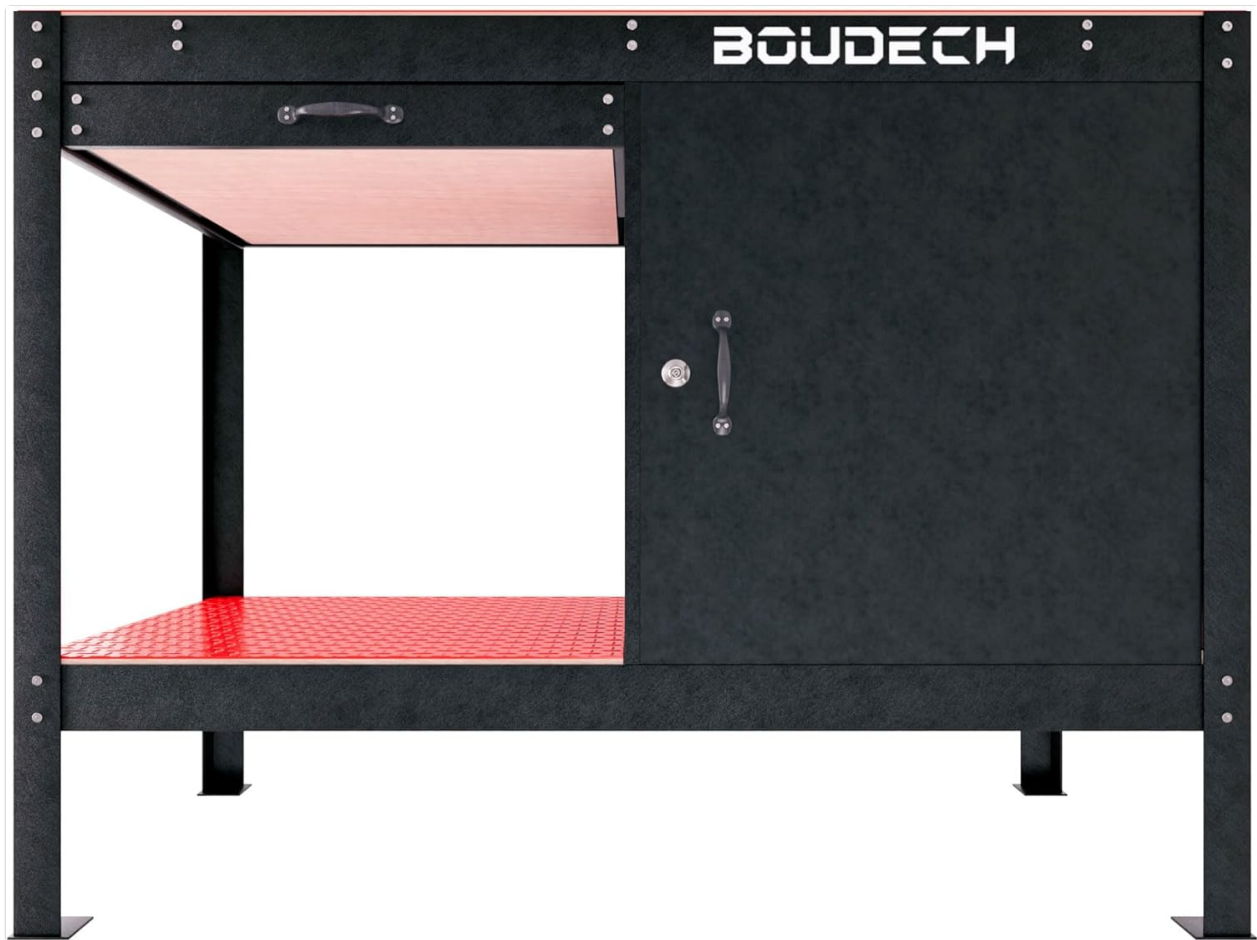

Step 2: Install the Work Surface and Open Shelf

Place the main work surface panel onto the top frame. Secure it using the designated fasteners. Then, install the open shelf panel at the lower section of the frame, ensuring it is level and firmly attached.

Step 3: Assemble the Drawer

Assemble the drawer components according to the diagram in your specific assembly guide. Attach the drawer slides to the drawer and the workbench frame. Carefully slide the assembled drawer into its position. Attach the handle to the drawer front.

Step 4: Install the Cabinet

Attach the hinges to the cabinet door and then to the workbench frame. Ensure the door opens and closes smoothly. Install the cabinet handle and lock mechanism if provided.

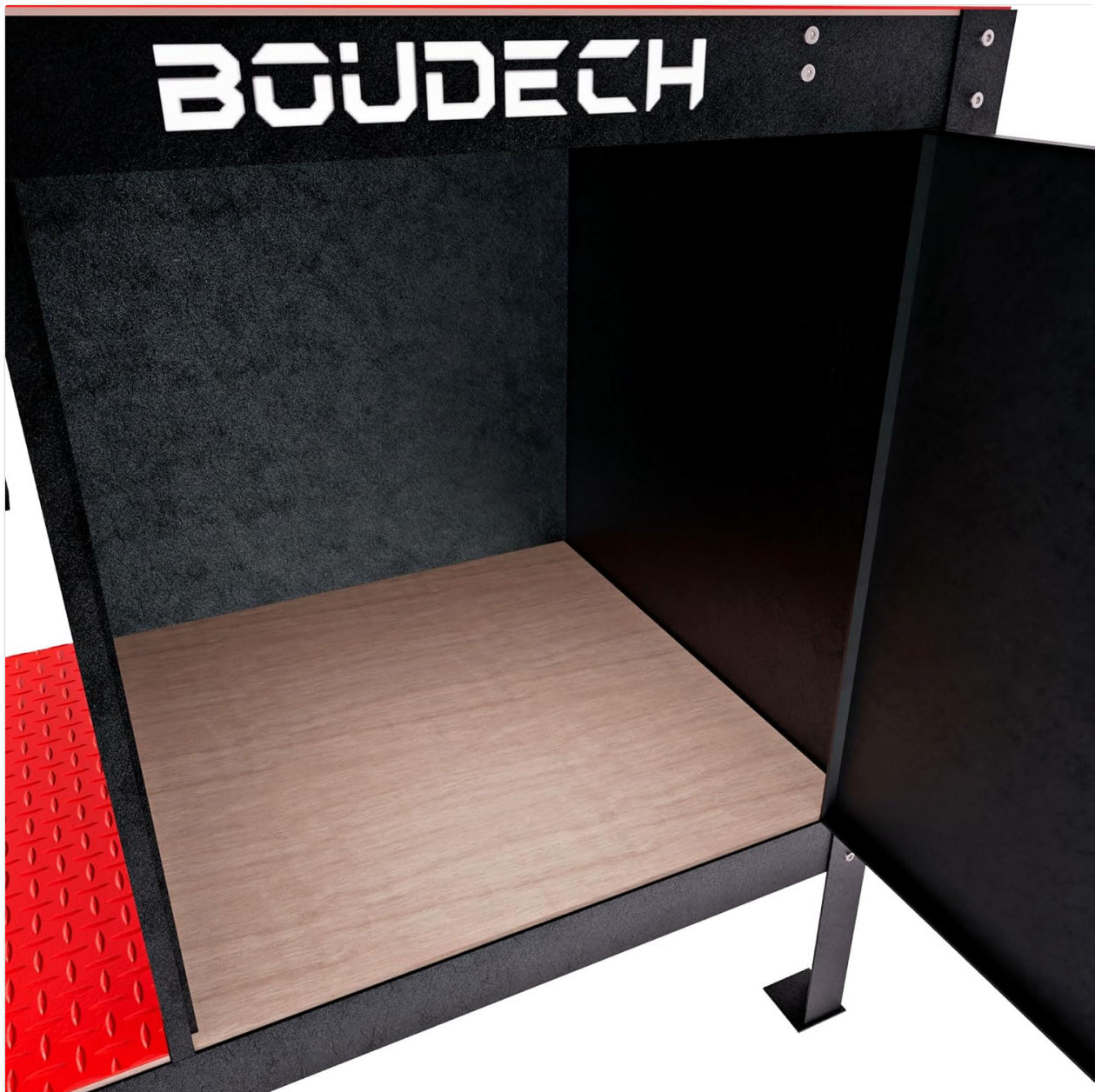


Image: An interior shot of the workbench's storage cabinet, with the door open, showing the ample space for storing larger items.

Step 5: Final Tightening and Inspection

5. USAGE

The BOUDECH Manny Workbench provides a versatile platform for various tasks. Its 120x60 cm work surface is suitable for projects requiring ample space. The sliding drawer is ideal for storing frequently used tools, keeping them organized and easily accessible. The cabinet with a door offers secure storage for larger items or supplies, while the open shelf provides additional space for materials or equipment.

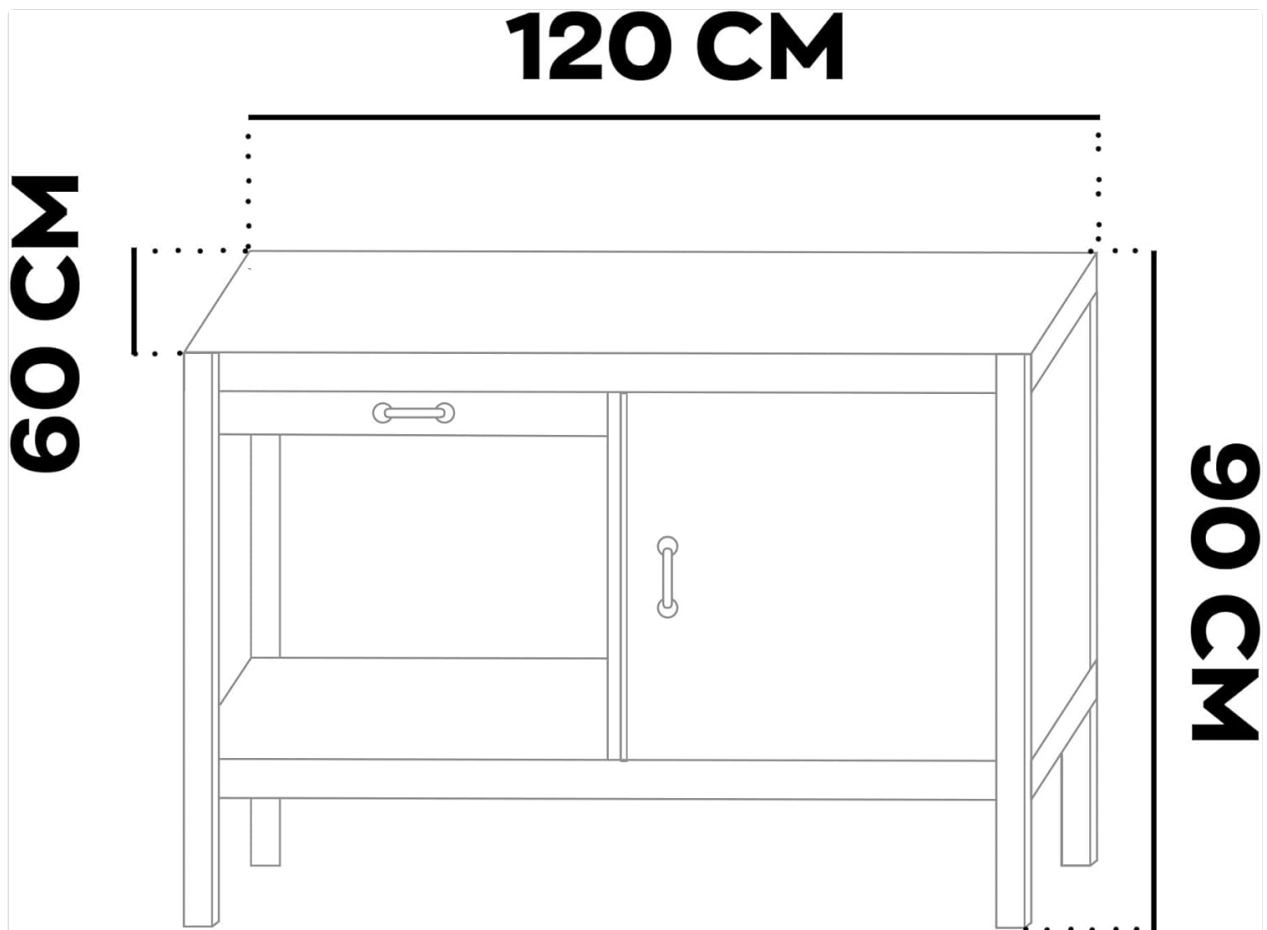

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the work surface and frame with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- **Fastener Check:** Periodically check all bolts and screws for tightness. Retighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Drawer Slides:** If the drawer becomes stiff, apply a small amount of silicone lubricant to the slides.
- **Rust Prevention:** The steel frame is resistant, but in humid environments, consider applying a rust-inhibiting spray to exposed metal parts if signs of rust appear.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Wobbly Workbench:** Ensure all fasteners are securely tightened. Check that the workbench is on a level surface. Adjust leg levelers if present.
- **Drawer Sticks:** Check for obstructions in the drawer slides. Clean the slides and apply lubricant if needed. Ensure the drawer is correctly aligned.
- **Door Does Not Close Properly:** Check hinges for proper installation and alignment. Adjust hinges if necessary. Ensure no items are obstructing the door's path.
