1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your WDYQJE R36MAX Retro Gaming Console. Please read it thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your device.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

2.1 Key Features

- **High-Performance System:** Equipped with a 1.5GHz 64-bit RK3326 CPU and ARM64bit quad-core Cortex-A35 CPU, running on an Open Source Linux system for a smooth gaming experience.
- **Ample Storage:** Includes 64GB of built-in storage, expandable via TF card for extensive game libraries.
- **Vibrant Display:** Features a 4.0-inch IPS screen with scratch-resistant tempered glass and 720x720 resolution for crisp graphics and true-to-life colors.
- **Portable Design:** Lightweight and travel-friendly, powered by a 4000mAh rechargeable battery offering up to 10 hours of gameplay.
- **Audio Options:** Built-in speakers and a 3.5mm headphone jack for versatile audio output.

2.3 Console Layout and Controls

- **Power Button:** Located on the top left side. Press and hold to power on/off.
- **Reset Button:** Small button near the power button for system reset.
- **Volume Keys (+/-):** Located on the top right side to adjust audio volume.
- **TF-Game Slot:** MicroSD card slot for game storage.
- **TF1-OS Slot:** MicroSD card slot for the operating system.
- **D-Pad (Directional Pad):** For directional input in games and menu navigation.
- **FN (Function) Button:** Special function button, often used in combination with others.
- **Select Button:** Used for various in-game functions or menu selections.
- **Start Button:** Used to start games or confirm selections.

- **A/B/X/Y Buttons:** Standard action buttons for gameplay.
- **Left/Right Rockers (Analog Sticks):** For analog control in supported games.
- **Charging Port (Type-C):** For charging the device.
- **OTC Headset (3.5mm Jack):** For connecting headphones.
- **R1/R2/L1/L2 Buttons:** Shoulder buttons for additional in-game controls.

3. SETUP

3.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the R36MAX console using the provided Type-C cable and a compatible 5V/1.5A or 2A charger. The charging indicator light will typically show red while charging and turn green or off when fully charged.

3.2 Inserting TF Cards

The console uses two TF (MicroSD) card slots:

- **TF1-OS:** This slot contains the operating system card. Do not remove or modify this card unless performing a system update or reinstallation.
- **TF-Game:** This slot is for your game library card. The console comes with a pre-loaded 64GB TF card in this slot. You can replace this with a larger card if desired, ensuring it is properly formatted and contains compatible game ROMs.

Ensure both cards are securely inserted before powering on the device.

3.3 Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button on the top left side until the screen illuminates.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until a shutdown menu appears, then select 'Shutdown'. Alternatively, a quick press of the Power button may put the device into sleep mode.
- **To Reset:** Use the small Reset button if the device becomes unresponsive.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Navigating the Menu

The R36MAX uses an Open Source Linux system with a user-friendly interface. Use the D-Pad or Left/Right Rockers to navigate through the main menu options, which typically include categories for different gaming systems (emulators) and an 'All Games' section.

- **A Button:** Confirm selection or enter a menu/game.
- **B Button:** Go back to the previous menu or cancel an action.
- **Select/Start Buttons:** May have various functions depending on the menu or game.

4.2 Selecting and Playing Games

1. From the main menu, select your desired gaming system (e.g., PlayStation, Super Nintendo, Game Boy).
2. Navigate through the list of available games using the D-Pad or analog sticks. Game previews may be displayed.

3. Press the **A button** to launch the selected game.
4. Once in a game, use the D-Pad, analog sticks, and A/B/X/Y/R1/R2/L1/L2 buttons for gameplay. Refer to the specific game's controls if needed.

4.3 Saving and Loading Game Progress

The R36MAX supports in-game saving and loading, often referred to as 'save states'.

- **To Save:** During gameplay, press a specific button combination (often FN + Select or FN + Start) to access the emulator's quick menu. From there, select 'Save State' and choose a slot.
- **To Load:** To resume from a saved point, access the quick menu (FN + Select/Start), select 'Load State', and choose the corresponding slot.

Note: Always save your progress before exiting a game to avoid losing data.

4.4 Exiting a Game

To exit a game and return to the main menu, typically press a combination of buttons (e.g., Select + Start simultaneously, or FN + Start>Select twice) to bring up the emulator menu, then select 'Quit' or 'Exit'.

4.5 Connecting External Devices

The console may support external controllers via its USB ports (using an OTG adapter if necessary) or Bluetooth, depending on the specific firmware. Consult the system settings for pairing instructions.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the console's exterior. For the screen, use a microfiber cloth specifically designed for electronics. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the device regularly, even if not in use for extended periods. Do not operate the device while charging if the TF card is being accessed, as this may cause data corruption.
- **Storage:** Store the console in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and humidity. Use the provided case for protection during travel.
- **Software Updates:** Periodically check the manufacturer's official website or community forums for firmware updates to improve performance and add features. Follow update instructions carefully.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your R36MAX console, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Console does not power on.	Low battery; faulty power button; TF card issue.	Charge the device for at least 30 minutes. Ensure TF cards are correctly inserted. Try a hard reset using the Reset button.
Games are not loading or crashing.	Corrupted game files; incompatible ROM; TF card issue.	Ensure game ROMs are compatible with the emulator. Check the TF-Game card for corruption. Try re-downloading the game.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Poor sound quality or no sound.	Volume too low; faulty headphones; software glitch.	Adjust volume. Test with different headphones. Restart the console.
Screen flickering or display issues.	Software issue; hardware fault.	Restart the console. Ensure firmware is up to date. If persistent, contact support.
Controls are unresponsive.	Software freeze; hardware issue.	Perform a hard reset. Check if any buttons are stuck.
