Generic Replacement Water Tank User Manual

For Dreame H15 Pro, H15 Pro HEAT, and T40 Wet and Dry Robot Vacuum Cleaners

INTRODUCTION

This document provides essential instructions for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your new Generic replacement dirty water tank. This tank is designed to be compatible with Dreame H15 Pro, Dreame H15 Pro HEAT, and Dreame T40 wet and dry robot vacuum cleaners. Its primary function is to collect and store sewage, stains, and debris mixtures generated during the cleaning process, preventing recontamination of cleaned surfaces.

Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The replacement water tank is designed for easy removal and installation as part of routine maintenance. Follow these steps to install the new tank:

1. **Power Off:** Ensure your Dreame wet and dry robot vacuum cleaner is powered off and unplugged before beginning installation.
2. **Remove Old Tank:** Locate the existing dirty water tank on your vacuum cleaner. Depending on your specific Dreame model, there may be a release button or latch. Carefully detach and remove the old tank.
3. **Inspect Area:** Clean any debris or residue from the vacuum's tank compartment to ensure a proper seal for the new tank.
4. **Install New Tank:** Align the new Generic replacement dirty water tank with the compartment on your vacuum cleaner. Gently slide or click it into place until you hear a secure click or feel it firmly seated. Ensure all connection points are properly engaged.

After installation, ensure the tank is firmly in place and there are no gaps that could lead to leaks.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This replacement tank is a dirty water collection container. It works in conjunction with your vacuum cleaner's mopping function to collect used water and debris.

1. **During Cleaning:** The tank automatically collects dirty water, stains, and garbage mixtures as your vacuum operates.
2. **Monitoring Capacity:** The tank features a generous capacity, allowing for longer cleaning sessions. However, it is recommended to periodically check the tank's fill level.
3. **Emptying the Tank:** After each cleaning session, or when the tank is full, remove it from the vacuum cleaner. Open the designated emptying port (if applicable) or carefully pour out the collected dirty water and debris into a drain.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of the dirty water tank is crucial for maintaining your vacuum cleaner's efficiency and hygiene.

- **Cleaning the Tank:** After emptying, rinse the inside of the tank thoroughly with clean water. Use a soft brush if necessary to remove any stubborn residue. Ensure all internal surfaces are clean to prevent odor and bacterial growth.
- **Filter Maintenance:** This tank is compatible with HEPA filtration systems. If your vacuum uses a filter in conjunction with the dirty water tank, remove and clean the filter according to your vacuum cleaner's specific instructions. Filters should be rinsed under running water and allowed to air dry completely before reinstallation. Do not use the vacuum without a dry filter.
- **Drying:** Allow the water tank and any associated filters to air dry completely before reassembling and reinstalling them into the vacuum cleaner. This prevents mold and mildew formation.
- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically inspect the tank for any signs of wear, cracks, or damage. Replace the tank if any significant damage is observed to prevent leaks and ensure proper function.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Leaks from the Tank:** Verify that the tank is installed correctly and securely. Inspect the tank for any visible cracks or damage. Ensure any rubber seals are clean and properly seated.
- **Poor Dirty Water Collection:** Check if the tank is full and needs emptying. Ensure the filter (if applicable) is clean and not clogged. Confirm that the vacuum's suction and mopping functions are operating correctly, as this tank is a passive collection unit.
- **Unpleasant Odors:** Thoroughly clean and dry the tank after each use. Ensure no debris is left inside. Clean or replace the filter as recommended.
