# SETUP

# 1. Unboxing and Initial Inspection

## 2. SIM Card and Memory Card Installation

Locate the SIM card tray on the side of the device. Use the provided SIM ejector tool (if included) to open the tray. Insert your Nano-SIM card(s) and/or microSD card into the designated slots. Ensure the tray is securely closed to maintain water and dust resistance.

## 3. Initial Charge

Before first use, fully charge the device using the provided USB cable and a compatible power adapter. The device supports 120W fast charging.

# **OPERATING YOUR DEVICE**

#### 1. Power On/Off and Restart

To power on, press and hold the Power button until the Blackview logo appears. To power off, press and hold the Power button, then select "Power off" from the options. To restart, select "Restart".

# 2. Display Features

The XPLORE 2 features a 6.73-inch 3.2K AMOLED display with a 120Hz dynamic refresh rate. Adjust brightness and display settings in the "Display" menu within Settings for optimal viewing.

# 3. Camera Usage

• **Device is slow or freezing:** Close background applications, uninstall unused apps, and restart the device.

- Water/Dust ingress: Ensure all port covers are securely closed. If water or dust enters, follow the

cleaning instructions and allow the device to dry completely before use.
