# COWSAR Nugget Ice Maker Model Z5825NB Instruction Manual

Your guide to setting up, operating, and maintaining your COWSAR Nugget Ice Maker.

## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the COWSAR Nugget Ice Maker Model Z5825NB. This countertop appliance is designed to produce soft, chewable pellet ice efficiently. With its durable stainless steel construction and automatic cleaning function, it offers convenience for various settings including kitchens, offices, and home bars. Please read this manual thoroughly before operation to ensure safe and optimal performance.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, level surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources.
- Allow the unit to stand upright for at least 2 hours before first use to allow refrigerants to settle.

- Use only potable water.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or other liquids.
- Keep children away from the ice maker during operation.
- Unplug the appliance before cleaning or when not in use.

## SETUP

---

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the ice maker from its packaging. Remove all packing materials, including any tape or protective film.
2. **Placement:** Place the ice maker on a flat, stable surface. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the unit, especially near the fan on the side, to prevent overheating.
3. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker. Remove the ice basket and wash it with mild detergent and warm water. Wipe the interior with a soft cloth.
4. **Water Fill:** Open the lid and fill the water reservoir with potable water up to the "MAX" fill line.
5. **Power Connection:** Plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet.

### OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Start Ice Making:** After filling the water reservoir, press the "Ice/Clean" button briefly to start the ice-making cycle. The indicator light will illuminate.
2. **First Batch:** The first batch of nugget ice will be ready in approximately 8 minutes. The machine can produce up to 35 lbs of ice in 24 hours.
3. **Ice Full Indicator:** The "Ice Full" indicator will light up when the ice basket is full. The machine will automatically pause ice production.
4. **Add Water Indicator:** The "Add Water" indicator will light up when the water reservoir is low. Refill the reservoir to resume ice production.
5. **Dispensing Ice:** Use the provided scoop to retrieve ice from the basket. The ice basket is detachable for convenient serving.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Automatic Cleaning:** The ice maker features a one-click automatic cleaning function. Press and hold the "Ice/Clean" button for five seconds to activate. The cleaning cycle takes approximately 15 minutes. It is recommended to perform this weekly.
- **Manual Cleaning:** For thorough cleaning, unplug the unit. Remove the ice basket. Drain any remaining water from the reservoir using the drain plug located at the bottom of the unit. Clean the interior with a solution of water and vinegar or a mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly.
- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the appliance with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners.

## Self-Cleaning Function

Press and hold the ICE/CLEAN button for 5 seconds to activate the 30mins deep cleaning

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not producing ice.	No water in reservoir; power issue.	Fill water reservoir. Check power connection.
"Add Water" indicator is on.	Water level is low.	Refill the water reservoir to the MAX line.
"Ice Full" indicator is on.	Ice basket is full.	Remove ice from the basket. The machine will resume production.
Ice melts quickly in the basket.	Ice basket is not insulated.	This is normal for countertop ice makers. Transfer ice to a freezer for longer storage.
Unusual noise during operation.	Normal compressor operation; ice falling.	Some noise is normal. If noise is excessive or unusual, contact customer support.
