SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps carefully to assemble your YATINEY 10-Tier Shoe Rack. All necessary tools are included.

- 1. Prepare the Area:** Clear a spacious, clean, and flat area for assembly. Lay out all parts and hardware, referring to the package contents list.
- 2. Attach Adjustable Feet:** Screw the adjustable feet into the bottom of the two side frames. Ensure they are tightened but allow for minor adjustments later to level the rack.
- 3. Assemble Side Frames and Shelves:** Attach the metal mesh shelves to the side frames using the provided screws. Start from the bottom shelf and work your way up, ensuring each shelf is securely fastened. Do not overtighten screws until all shelves are in place.
- 4. Install Cross Frames:** Attach the X-shaped cross frames to the back of the shoe rack using the designated screws. These frames enhance the overall stability of the unit.
- 5. Attach Top Panel:** Place the particleboard top panel onto the assembled frame and secure it with screws from underneath.
- 6. Final Tightening and Leveling:** Once all parts are assembled, go back and tighten all screws securely. Adjust the feet as needed to ensure the shoe rack stands level and stable on your floor.
- 7. Install Anti-Tip Kit:** This is a critical safety step.
 - Position the assembled shoe rack in its desired location.
 - Mark the wall through the mounting holes on the anti-tip strap bracket.

- Drill pilot holes if necessary (refer to your wall type for appropriate drill bit and anchors).
- Secure the bracket to the wall using the provided screws and wall anchors.
- Attach the other end of the strap to the back of the shoe rack, typically to the top frame.
- Ensure the strap is taut to prevent tipping.

OPERATING AND USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

- **Shoe Placement:** Each of the 10 tiers is designed to hold approximately 4 pairs of standard adult shoes, accommodating a total of up to 40 pairs. Place shoes evenly across the shelves to maintain balance.
- **Top Shelf Usage:** The sturdy top panel can be used for placing bags, helmets, decorative items, or other belongings. Ensure the weight does not exceed 44 lbs (20 kg).
- **Adjustable Feet:** If the rack feels wobbly, adjust the individual feet by rotating them until the unit is stable and level on your floor.
- **Versatile Storage:** This rack is suitable for various spaces such as entryways, closets, hallways, or mudrooms. Its open design allows for easy access and visibility of your stored items.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.

- **Check Fasteners:** Periodically inspect all screws and bolts to ensure they are tight. Retighten as necessary to maintain stability.
- **Avoid Moisture:** Keep the shoe rack in a dry environment. Prolonged exposure to moisture can damage the particleboard and metal components.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Rack is wobbly/unstable.	Uneven floor; loose fasteners; anti-tip kit not installed.	Adjust the leveling feet. Tighten all screws and bolts. Ensure the anti-tip kit is correctly installed and taut.
Parts do not fit together.	Incorrect orientation of parts; wrong parts used.	Review the assembly instructions carefully, paying attention to part orientation. Ensure you are using the correct parts for each step.
Missing hardware or damaged parts.	Packaging error; shipping damage.	Do not proceed with assembly. Contact YATINEY customer support immediately for replacement parts.
Shoes slide off shelves.	Rack is not level; shoes are too large for shelf depth.	Adjust the leveling feet to ensure the rack is perfectly horizontal. Ensure shoes are placed fully on the shelves.
