Aeitto Countertop Ice Maker User Manual

1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Aeitto Countertop Ice Maker. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new appliance. Please read these instructions thoroughly before first use and retain them for future reference.

This ice maker is designed to produce bullet-shaped ice cubes quickly and conveniently for home, office, RV, or small gathering use.

2. Important Safety Instructions

- Read all instructions before operating the appliance.
- Ensure the voltage matches the rating label on the appliance.
- Do not immerse the power cord, plug, or any part of the appliance in water or other liquids.
- Unplug the appliance from the outlet when not in use, before cleaning, and before servicing.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner. Contact customer service for assistance.
- Do not use outdoors. This appliance is for indoor household use only.
- Do not let the cord hang over the edge of a table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Use only potable (drinkable) water in the ice maker.
- Do not clean your ice maker with flammable fluids. The fumes can create a fire hazard or explosion.
- Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant in this appliance.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

4. Product Overview

The Aeitto Countertop Ice Maker is designed for convenience and efficiency, producing bullet-shaped ice cubes rapidly. Key features include:

- **Fast Ice Production:** Produces 9 ice cubes in approximately 6 minutes.
- **High Capacity:** Up to 26 lbs of ice per 24 hours.
- **Two Ice Sizes:** Choose between small and large bullet ice cubes.
- **Dual Viewing Windows:** Monitor the ice-making process and ice level without opening the lid.
- **Self-Cleaning Function:** Simplifies maintenance and ensures hygiene.
- **Compact Design:** Space-saving and portable for various settings.

5. Setup Guide

1. **Unpack the Appliance:** Carefully remove the ice maker from its packaging. Remove all packing materials, including tape and labels.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker. Refer to the "Maintenance" section for detailed cleaning instructions.
3. **Placement:** Place the ice maker on a flat, stable surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources (e.g., stoves, furnaces, radiators). Ensure there is at least 4 inches (10 cm) of space around the unit for proper ventilation.
4. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.
5. **Add Water:** Open the lid and fill the water reservoir with potable water up to the "MAX" fill line. Do not overfill.

6. Operating Instructions

1. **Power On:** Press the **ON/OFF** button to turn on the ice maker. The "POWER" indicator light will illuminate.
2. **Select Ice Size:** Press the **SELECT** button to choose between small (S) or large (L) ice cubes. The corresponding indicator light will illuminate.

3. **Ice Making Cycle:** The ice maker will begin its first ice-making cycle. This typically takes about 6-10 minutes depending on the selected ice size and ambient temperature.
4. **"ADD WATER" Indicator:** If the "ADD WATER" indicator light illuminates, it means the water reservoir is low. Add more potable water up to the MAX fill line and the ice maker will resume operation automatically.
5. **"ICE FULL" Indicator:** When the ice basket is full, the "ICE FULL" indicator light will illuminate, and the ice maker will automatically pause production. Remove ice from the basket to resume operation.
6. **Power Off:** To stop ice production, press the **ON/OFF** button again.

7. Maintenance and Cleaning

Regular cleaning and maintenance ensure the longevity and hygienic operation of your ice maker.

7.1 Self-Cleaning Function

1. **Add Water:** Ensure the water reservoir is filled with clean, potable water.
2. **Activate Self-Clean:** With the ice maker powered on, press and hold the **ON/OFF** button for 5 seconds. The "CLEAN" indicator light will illuminate, and the self-cleaning cycle will begin.
3. **Cycle Duration:** The self-cleaning process typically runs for 15 minutes.
4. **Drain Water:** After the cycle completes, drain the water from the reservoir by removing the drain plug located at the bottom of the unit.
5. **Rinse:** Rinse the interior with fresh water and drain again.

7.2 General Cleaning

- **Exterior:** Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Interior:** For thorough cleaning, unplug the unit, remove the ice basket, and drain any remaining water. Wipe down the interior surfaces with a soft cloth dampened with a mild detergent solution. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and dry.
- **Air Vent:** Periodically clean the air vent on the side of the unit to ensure proper airflow.
- **Storage:** If storing the ice maker for an extended period, ensure it is completely dry, then store it in a cool, dry place.

Recommendation: For optimal performance and hygiene, we recommend performing the self-cleaning function at least once a week.

8. Troubleshooting Guide

Before contacting customer service, please refer to the following table for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not working.	No power.	Check if the power cord is securely plugged into a grounded outlet. Ensure the outlet is functional.
"ADD WATER" indicator light is on.	Water reservoir is empty or low.	Fill the water reservoir with potable water up to the MAX fill line.
"ICE FULL" indicator light is on.	Ice basket is full.	Remove ice from the ice basket. The ice maker will resume production.
Ice cubes are too small or cloudy.	Water temperature is too high; ambient temperature is too high.	Use colder water. Place the ice maker in a cooler environment. Ensure proper ventilation.
Ice maker is making unusual noise.	Normal operation sounds (compressor, water pump); unit not level.	Ensure the unit is on a flat, stable surface. If noise is excessive or unusual, contact customer service.
Ice has an odd taste or smell.	Unit needs cleaning; stale water.	Perform the self-cleaning function. Drain and replace water regularly. Clean the interior thoroughly.
