Organize your apps on the Home Screen by dragging them. Add complications to your watch face to display information from your favorite apps, such as weather, activity rings, or calendar events.

With Family Setup, you can set up an Apple Watch for a family member who doesn't have an iPhone, allowing them to make calls, send messages, and share their location. This is managed through your iPhone's Watch app.

For slow performance or app crashes, try restarting your Apple Watch. If issues persist, consider unpairing and re-pairing your watch, or restoring it to factory settings.
