INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Mingdaln G136 Smartwatch. This manual provides essential information and instructions to help you set up, operate, and maintain your device. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the smartwatch to ensure proper function and to avoid damage.

- Do not attempt to disassemble or modify the smartwatch. This may void the warranty and cause damage.
- Keep the device away from extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, and moisture.
- Use only the provided charging cable. Using unauthorized chargers may damage the device or pose a safety risk.
- Avoid exposing the smartwatch to strong impacts or drops.
- Consult a medical professional before using the heart rate monitor if you have a pacemaker or other internal electronic medical device.

SETUP

1. Charging the Smartwatch

Before first use, fully charge your Mingdaln G136 Smartwatch. Connect the provided charging cable to the charging port on the back of the smartwatch and plug the other end into a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port. The watch display will indicate charging status.

Note: The charger uses a magnetic connection. Ensure it is securely attached to prevent accidental disconnection during charging.

2. SIM Card Insertion

The Mingdaln G136 Smartwatch supports 4G Vo-LTE calling via a Nano-SIM card. Follow these steps to insert the SIM card:

1. Locate the SIM card slot on the side of the smartwatch.
2. Carefully open the SIM card tray.
3. Insert a Nano-SIM card into the tray, ensuring the gold contacts face downwards and the notched corner aligns correctly.
4. Gently push the SIM card tray back into the slot until it clicks into place.
5. Power on the smartwatch. The device will automatically detect the SIM card.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Basic Navigation

The Mingdaln G136 features a 1.92-inch TFT touchscreen with HD resolution (240*282 px) for intuitive interaction. Swipe left, right, up, or down to navigate through menus and applications. Tap to select items.

2. Making and Receiving Calls

With a properly inserted and activated SIM card, you can make and receive calls directly from your smartwatch.

- **To Make a Call:** Access the "Dial" application or select a contact from your "Contacts" list. Enter the number or select the contact and tap the call icon.

- **To Receive a Call:** When a call comes in, the smartwatch will display the caller ID. Tap the green answer icon to accept or the red hang-up icon to decline.

MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Smartwatch does not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the smartwatch for at least 30 minutes.
Cannot make/receive calls.	SIM card not inserted correctly or not activated. No network signal.	Ensure SIM card is properly inserted and activated. Check for network coverage. Restart the smartwatch.
Charging issues.	Charging cable not connected properly. Faulty cable or adapter.	Ensure the magnetic charger is securely attached. Try a different USB port or power adapter.
Screen unresponsive.	Software glitch.	Restart the smartwatch by holding down the power button.
