OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The SUNSMAI S65 Roller Brush operates as an integral part of your SUNSMAI 4-in-1 Steam Vacuum Mop. Once installed, its operation is controlled by the main appliance. Refer to your steam vacuum mop's primary user manual for detailed instructions on how to:

- Fill the water tank and detergent dispenser.
- Select appropriate cleaning modes (vacuum, steam, mop, or combined).
- Start and stop the cleaning process.
- Engage self-cleaning functions.

The roller brush will activate automatically with the appliance's cleaning cycles, ensuring thorough scrubbing and debris collection.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance of the roller brush is essential for its performance and lifespan. Follow these guidelines:

- **Regular Cleaning:** After each use, or as recommended by your main appliance's manual, remove the roller brush for cleaning. Rinse it under running water to remove any trapped hair, debris, or cleaning solution residue.
- **Drying:** To prolong the service life and cleaning effect of the roller brush, it is recommended to take it out and air dry or sun dry it after self-cleaning, avoiding placing it in a damp and enclosed space. Ensure the brush is completely dry before reinstalling it or storing it.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the bristles for wear, damage, or excessive matting. A worn brush may reduce cleaning effectiveness.
- **Replacement:** Replace the roller brush every 3-6 months, or sooner if significant wear or damage is observed, to maintain optimal cleaning performance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues related to the roller brush, consider the following:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Brush not rotating	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Improper installation• Debris caught in brush• Worn brush motor (main unit issue)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reinstall brush, ensuring it clicks into place.• Remove brush and clear any obstructions.• Consult your main appliance's manual or contact SUNSMAI support.
Reduced cleaning performance	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clogged or dirty brush• Worn bristles	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clean the brush thoroughly and dry completely.• Replace the roller brush.
Unusual noise from brush area	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Debris caught in brush or compartment• Improperly installed brush	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Remove brush and inspect for obstructions.• Reinstall brush, ensuring it is seated correctly.
