LIFE SKY Twin Over Full Bunk Bed Instruction Manual

1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions before assembling and using this bunk bed. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Maximum Weight Capacity:** The top bunk is designed for a maximum weight of 175 lbs (79 kg). The bottom bunk is designed for a maximum weight of 350 lbs (159 kg).
- **Age Restriction:** The top bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- **Guardrails:** Always use the guardrails on the top bunk. Ensure they are properly installed and secured.
- **Ladder Safety:** Always use the ladder for entering and exiting the top bunk. Do not use the bed as a climbing frame.
- **Mattress Size:** Use only mattresses that are 75 inches long and 39 inches wide for the top bunk, and 75 inches long and 54 inches wide for the bottom bunk. The maximum mattress thickness for the top bunk should not exceed 6 inches to ensure proper guardrail height.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the bed.
- **No Horseplay:** Prohibit horseplay on or under the bed.
- **Assembly:** This product requires assembly by at least two adults. Ensure all connections are tight before use.

2. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

This bunk bed requires assembly. It is recommended that two adults perform the assembly process to ensure safety and efficiency. Please refer to the separate detailed assembly instructions and hardware package included with your purchase for step-by-step guidance.

2.1 Unpacking and Part Identification

Carefully unpack all components and hardware. Lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches. Verify that all parts listed in the assembly guide are present before beginning.

2.2 Assembly Steps Overview

1. Assemble the headboards and footboards for both the twin and full beds.
2. Attach the side rails to form the bed frames.
3. Install the wooden slats for mattress support on both frames.
4. Connect the top twin bed frame to the bottom full bed frame using the provided support posts and hardware.
5. Install the safety guardrails on the top bunk.
6. Attach the ladder securely to the top bunk.
7. Assemble and insert the two storage drawers beneath the bottom bunk.

Ensure all bolts, screws, and connectors are tightened securely at each step. Do not overtighten.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Using the Bunk Bed

The LIFE SKY Twin Over Full Bunk Bed provides two sleeping surfaces: a twin-sized bed on top and a full-sized bed on the bottom. The ladder is designed for safe access to the top bunk. Always use the ladder facing forward, maintaining three points of contact (two hands and one foot, or two feet and one hand).

3.2 Utilizing Storage Drawers

Two integrated storage drawers are located beneath the bottom bunk. These drawers are ideal for storing clothes, toys, bedding, or other personal items. Pull the handles gently to open and push to close. Avoid overloading the drawers to ensure smooth operation and prevent damage.

3.3 Convertible Design

This bunk bed can be separated into two individual beds: one twin bed and one full bed. To convert, carefully disassemble the connecting hardware between the top and bottom bunks. Ensure all components are stored safely if you plan to reassemble as a bunk bed later. Refer to the assembly guide for detailed instructions on separation and reassembly.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life and safety of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or polishes that may damage the wood finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (every 3-6 months) check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity and prevent squeaking.
- **Wood Care:** Protect the wood from extreme temperature changes and direct sunlight, which can cause fading or cracking.
- **Drawer Maintenance:** Keep drawer tracks clean and free of debris for smooth operation.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your bunk bed, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable	Loose hardware connections.	Carefully inspect all bolts and screws. Tighten any loose connections using the appropriate tools.
Squeaking noises	Loose hardware or friction between wood components.	Tighten all hardware. If squeaking persists, apply a small amount of paraffin wax or silicone spray to contact points between wood components (avoiding areas that bear weight).
Drawers stick or do not slide smoothly	Debris in tracks, misaligned drawers, or overloaded.	Clear any debris from the drawer tracks. Ensure drawers are not overloaded. Check if the drawer slides are properly aligned and secured.
Missing parts during assembly	Packaging error or lost during unpacking.	Double-check all packaging materials. Contact customer support with your model number and a list of missing parts.
