INTRODUCTION

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to install the ACM M05 Multimedia Center on your motorcycle:

1. **Attach the Mounting Bracket:** Secure the handlebar mounting bracket to a suitable position on your motorcycle's handlebar. Ensure it is tightened firmly to prevent movement during operation. The bracket features an anti-theft design for added security.
2. **Mount the Multimedia Unit:** Slide the ACM M05 Multimedia Center onto the mounting bracket until it clicks securely into place. Adjust the viewing angle as needed.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Powering On/Off

- **Power On:** Turn on your motorcycle's ignition. The multimedia center should power on automatically.
- **Power Off:** Turn off your motorcycle's ignition. The multimedia center will power off.

Bluetooth Connectivity

Media Playback (TF Card)

- Insert a TF card (microSD) containing audio files into the designated slot.
- Access the "Media" or "Music" application from the home screen to browse and play your files.

Anti-Theft System

The integrated anti-theft system provides an additional layer of security. Refer to the on-screen prompts or specific

settings within the device for activation and management of this feature.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the display and exterior. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check the mounting bracket and cable connections for tightness and wear.
- **Software Updates:** Check the manufacturer's website or device settings for available software updates to ensure optimal performance and new features.

TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|----------------------------|--|--|
| Device does not power on. | No power connection; Blown fuse; Ignition off. | Check power cables and connections. Verify motorcycle ignition is on. Check vehicle's fuse box. |
| Bluetooth not connecting. | Bluetooth off on device/phone; Device not in pairing mode; Interference. | Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on both devices. Put the multimedia center in pairing mode. Move closer to the device. Restart both devices. |
| No audio output. | Volume too low; Incorrect audio source selected; Loose audio cables. | Increase volume. Select the correct audio source (e.g., Bluetooth, TF card). Check audio cable connections. |
| Touch screen unresponsive. | Temporary software glitch; Screen dirty. | Restart the device by cycling the motorcycle ignition. Clean the screen with a soft cloth. |
