INTRODUCTION

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The WORX WA0828 Garage is designed for quick and easy installation without the need for specialized tools. Assembly can be completed in a few minutes.

2. **Position the Base:** Place the garage base in the desired location, ensuring it is level and stable. The garage should be positioned to cover the robotic lawnmower's charging station.
3. **Assemble the Structure:** Follow the visual instructions provided with the product to connect the main structural components. Use the provided metal screws and Allen key to secure the parts firmly.
4. **Secure to Ground (Optional but Recommended):** For added stability, especially in windy conditions, secure the garage to the ground using appropriate anchors (not included) through the designated holes in the base.
5. **Final Check:** Ensure all connections are tight and the garage is stable. Confirm that the robotic lawnmower can enter and exit the garage freely without obstruction.



OPERATING THE GARAGE (PROTECTION FUNCTION)

The WORX WA0828 Garage operates passively by providing a protective shelter for your robotic lawnmower. Once installed, it continuously shields the mower from environmental elements.

- **Rain Protection:** The garage's roof design prevents rain from directly reaching the robotic lawnmower and its charging station, reducing the risk of water damage.
- **Sun and UV Protection:** It blocks direct sunlight and harmful UV rays, which helps to prevent fading of the mower's plastic components and protects its internal electronics and battery from overheating.
- **Wind and Debris Shield:** The sturdy structure offers protection against strong winds and flying debris, such as leaves or small branches, which could otherwise damage the mower.

This garage is compatible with all WORX Vision Cloud robotic lawnmower models, including both 2WD and 4WD versions:

- **2WD Models:** WR303E, WR304E, WR305E, WR306E, WR365E, WR308E, WR312E, WR318E, WR330E
- **4WD Models:** WR340E, WR341E, WR342E, WR344E
