1. INTRODUCTION

2. SETUP

2.1 Unpacking and Initial Inspection

2.2 Connecting Power

- **USB Type-A Ports (2):** For connecting standard USB devices like mice, keyboards, or external drives.
- **HDMI Port (1):** For connecting to external displays or projectors.
- **Headphone/Microphone Combo Jack (1):** For connecting headphones, external speakers, or a headset with a microphone.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Power On/Off and Sleep Mode

- **Power On:** Press the power button located on the keyboard deck.
- **Shut Down:** Click the Start button in Windows, then select Power > Shut down.
- **Sleep Mode:** Close the laptop lid or click the Start button, then select Power > Sleep.

3.2 Using the Keyboard and Touchpad

The laptop features a full-size keyboard and a precision touchpad.

- **Backlit Keyboard:** To activate or adjust the keyboard backlight, use the dedicated function key (usually F5 or F4, look for a keyboard icon).
- **Touchpad Gestures:** Refer to Windows 11 settings for customizable touchpad gestures (e.g., two-finger scroll, pinch-to-zoom).

3.3 Wireless Connectivity

3.4 Using the Webcam

The integrated HD webcam can be used for video calls and conferences. Access it through applications like Camera, Microsoft Teams, or Zoom.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning the Laptop

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner for the display.
- For the keyboard and chassis, use a soft cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- Use compressed air to clear dust from vents periodically.

4.2 Battery Care

- Avoid completely draining the battery frequently.
- Store the laptop in a cool, dry place if not used for extended periods.
- For optimal battery health, avoid continuous charging at 100% for prolonged durations.

4.3 Software Updates

Regularly check for and install Windows updates to ensure system stability, security, and performance. Go to Windows Settings > Windows Update.

4.4 Storage Management

Periodically clean up unnecessary files and applications to maintain optimal performance of the 512GB SSD. Use Windows built-in tools like Disk Cleanup or Storage Sense.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your HP Pavilion laptop.

5.1 Laptop Not Powering On

- Ensure the AC adapter is securely connected to both the laptop and a working power outlet.
- Verify the power outlet is functional by plugging in another device.
- If the battery is completely drained, allow it to charge for at least 30 minutes before attempting to power on.

5.2 Wi-Fi Connection Issues

- Check if Wi-Fi is enabled in Windows settings.
- Restart your router and modem.
- Ensure you are within range of the Wi-Fi network.
- Try forgetting the network and reconnecting.

5.3 Keyboard Backlight Not Working

- Press the dedicated keyboard backlight function key (e.g., F5 or F4) to toggle or adjust the brightness.
- Check Windows Mobility Center settings (search for it in the Start menu) for backlight options.

5.4 Slow Performance

- Close unnecessary applications running in the background.
- Ensure Windows is up to date.
- Run a disk cleanup and check for malware.
- Verify that the laptop is not overheating.
