1. SETUP

This section guides you through the initial setup of your Roku 65-Inch Select Series 4K QLED Smart TV. Ensure all components are present before beginning.

1.1 What's in the Box

- Roku Select Series 65" 4K TV
- Stands and screws
- Remote Control
- User Manual (this document)

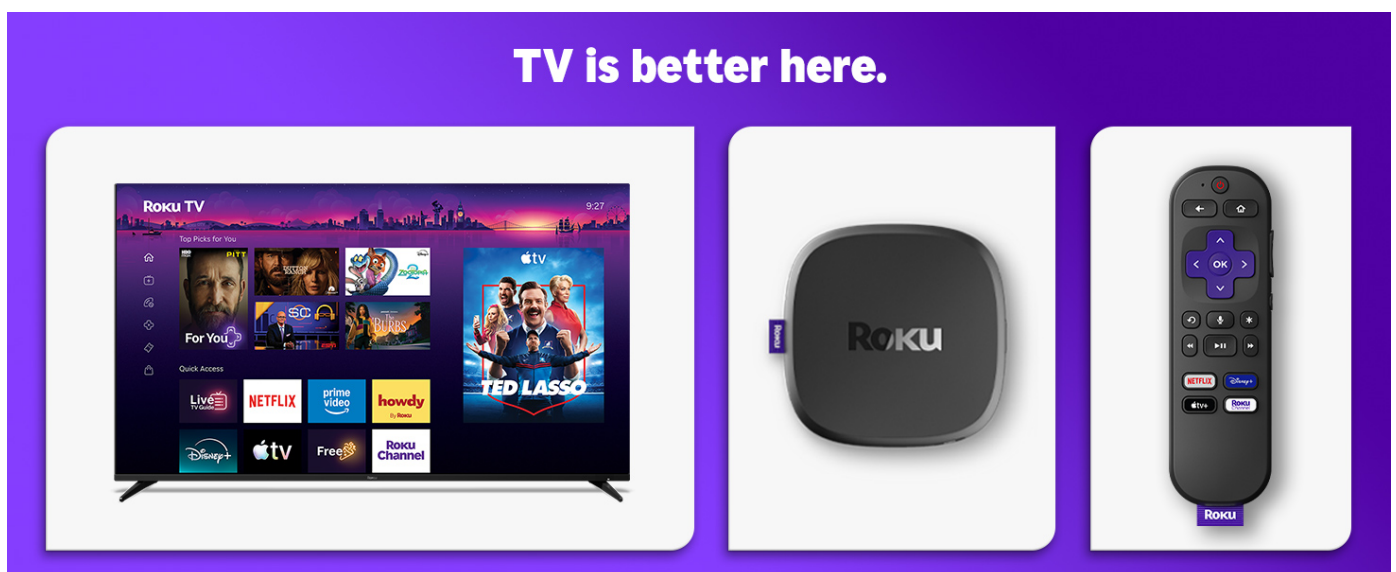


Figure 1.1: Included components with your Roku TV.

1.2 Attaching the TV Stands

1. Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent damage.

2. Align each stand with the corresponding screw holes on the bottom of the TV.
3. Secure the stands using the provided screws. Ensure they are tightened firmly.

1.3 Connecting Power and Initial Power On

1. Connect the power cord to the TV's power input and then to a wall outlet.
2. Insert two AAA batteries into the remote control.
3. Press the power button on the remote or the TV to turn it on.

1.4 Network Connection and Roku Account Setup

Follow the on-screen prompts to connect your TV to your home Wi-Fi network. You will be guided to create or log in to a Roku account. This account is essential for accessing streaming services and features.

2. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Navigating the Home Screen

The Roku Home Screen provides quick access to your streaming channels, inputs, and settings. Use the directional pad on your remote to move between options and the 'OK' button to select.

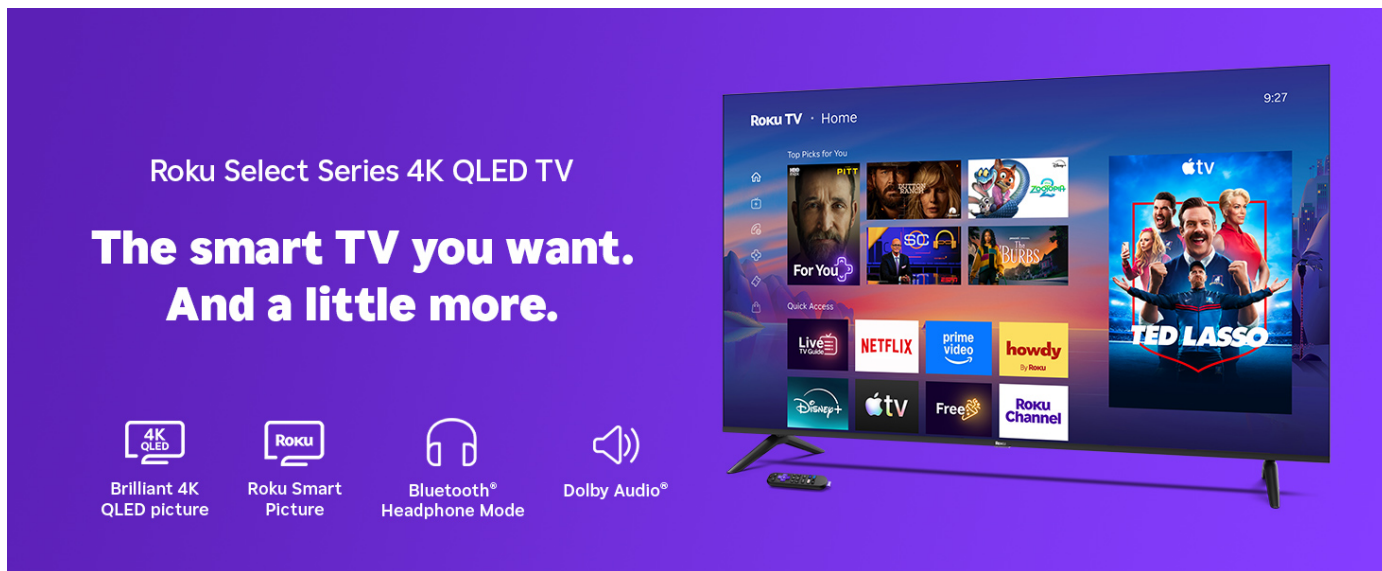


Figure 2.1: The Roku TV Home Screen, showing streaming apps and content.

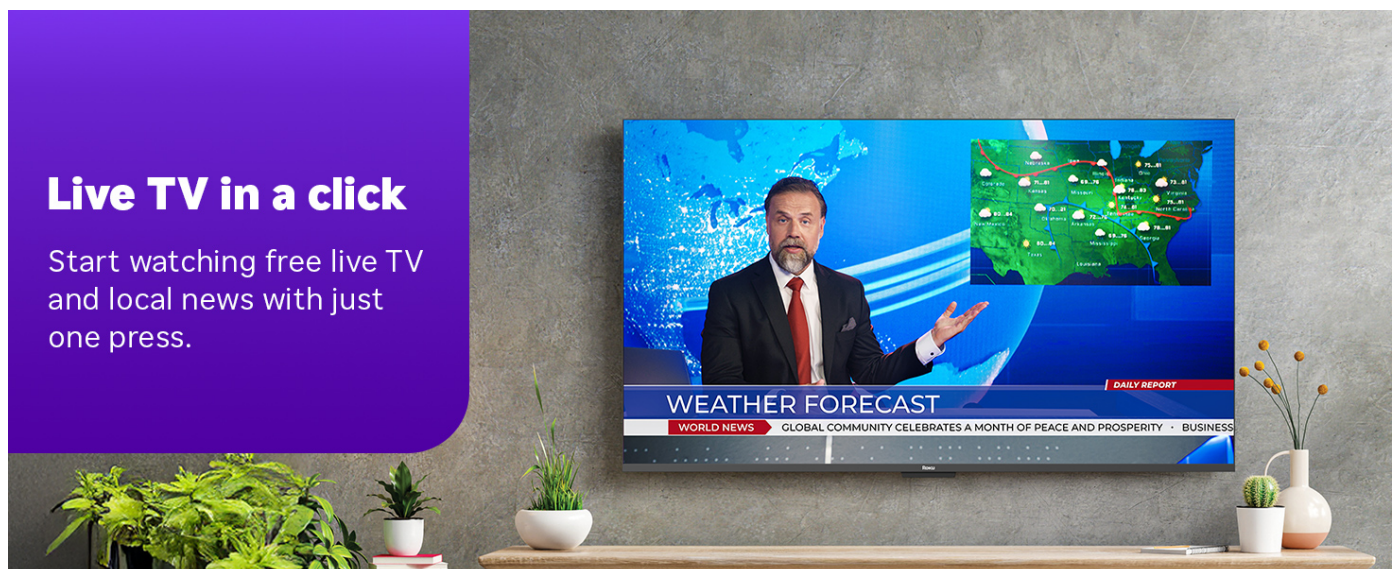


Figure 2.3: Live TV streaming on Roku TV.

2.4 Picture and Sound Settings

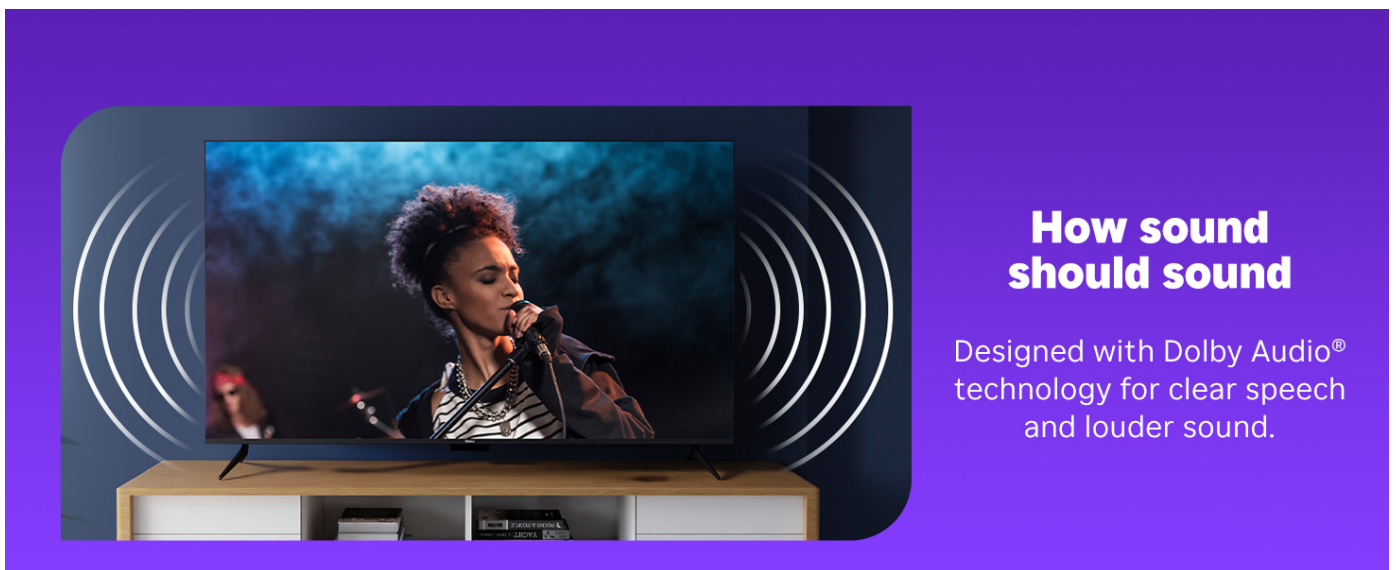

Connect your Bluetooth headphones to the TV for private listening. This feature allows you to enjoy your entertainment without disturbing others.

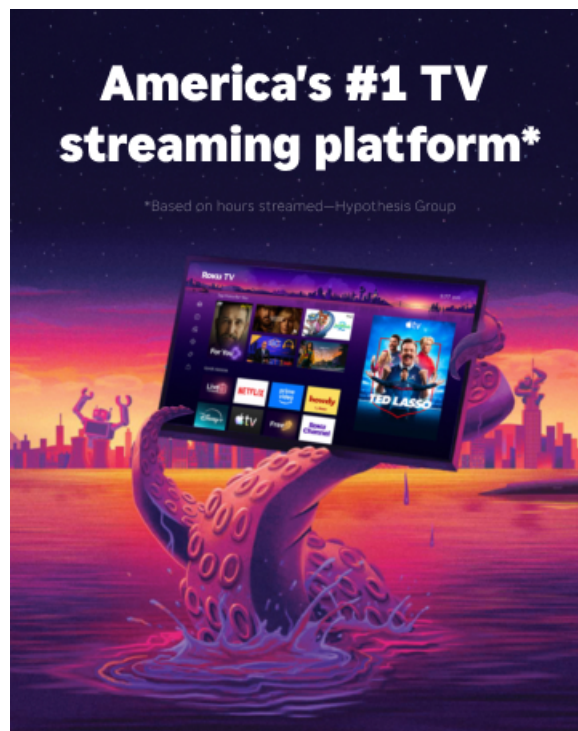


Figure 2.6: Using Bluetooth Headphone Mode.

2.6 Smart Home Integration

Your Roku TV is compatible with Roku Voice, Siri, Alexa, and Google Assistant for easy voice control. You can also share videos, photos, and music from your Apple devices to the TV using Apple AirPlay.

3. MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Roku TV.

3.1 Cleaning the TV Screen

- Always turn off and unplug the TV before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry microfiber cloth to gently wipe the screen.
- For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-safe cleaning solution (avoid harsh chemicals).
- Do not spray liquid directly onto the screen.

3.2 General Care

- Keep the TV in a well-ventilated area, away from direct sunlight and heat sources.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on the TV or remote.
- Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure optimal performance and access to the latest features.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Roku TV, refer to the following common solutions.

4.1 No Power

- Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the TV and a working electrical outlet.
- Check if the outlet is receiving power by plugging in another device.
- Try pressing the power button on the TV itself, not just the remote.

4.2 No Picture / Black Screen

- Verify the correct input source is selected (e.g., HDMI 1, TV).
- Ensure all cables connected to the TV (HDMI, antenna) are securely attached.
- Restart the TV by unplugging it from the power outlet for 60 seconds, then plugging it back in.

4.3 Network Connection Issues

- Go to **Settings > Network > Check connection** to diagnose the issue.
- Restart your Wi-Fi router and modem.
- Ensure the TV is within range of your Wi-Fi signal.

4.4 Remote Not Responding / Lost Remote

- Replace the batteries in the remote control.
- Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV.
- If your remote is lost, use the free Roku Mobile app on your smartphone to control the TV and activate the 'lost remote finder' feature.
