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

# 1. Introduction



# 2.2 Device Layout and Controls

Familiarize yourself with the recorder's physical components and controls:

- **USB Port:** For charging and connecting to a computer for data transfer.
- Headphone Jack: For audio playback.
- Power/Mode Switch (ON VOR OFF): Controls power and recording modes.

# One-click recording Switch between the two modes arbitrarily

Voice control - normal two modes switch, turn on voice control, there is sound without sound pause, save storage space, improve work efficiency

#### 3. SETUP

# 3.1 Charging the Device

Before first use, fully charge the recorder. Connect the device to a computer's USB port or a USB wall adapter using the provided USB cable. The indicator light will show charging status (specific light behavior may vary; refer to device for details).

# 3.2 Time Synchronization

The recorder features a built-in time chip for timestamping recordings. To ensure accurate timestamps, connect the device to a computer and synchronize its internal clock with your computer's time. This process typically involves accessing a time synchronization utility on the recorder's storage when connected to a PC.

#### 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### 4.1 Power On/Off


- To Power On: Slide the 'ON VOR OFF' switch to either 'ON' (Normal Recording) or 'VOR' (Voice Activated Recording) position.
- To Power Off: Slide the switch to the 'OFF' position. This action also saves any active recording.

# 4.2 Normal Recording

For continuous recording, slide the 'ON VOR OFF' switch to the 'ON' position. The device will begin recording immediately and continuously until the switch is moved to 'OFF' or 'VOR', or until memory is full or battery is depleted.

# 4.3 Voice Activated Recording (VOR)

To enable voice-activated recording, slide the 'ON VOR OFF' switch to the 'VOR' position. The recorder will automatically start recording when sound is detected and pause when there is no sound, conserving storage space and battery life.

#### 4.4 Playback

To listen to recordings, connect headphones to the 3.5mm headphone jack. Use the device's controls (if available, or connect to a computer/smartphone) to navigate and play audio files.

## 4.5 Connecting to a Computer

Connect the recorder to your computer using the USB cable. The device will appear as a removable storage drive. You can then access, transfer, and manage your recorded audio files (WAV format) and other supported music files (MP3/WMA/WAV).

# 4.6 Connecting to a Smartphone (OTG)

The L810 supports Mobile OTG (On-The-Go) functionality, allowing direct connection to compatible Android smartphones. An OTG adapter (not included) is required. Once connected, you can play, view, and delete recordings directly from your phone without needing a computer.

#### 5. MAINTENANCE

- Keep the device dry and away from extreme temperatures.
- Clean the exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals.
- Charge the battery regularly, even if not in use, to maintain battery health.
- Avoid dropping the device or subjecting it to strong impacts.

#### 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- Device not turning on: Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to a power source and try again.
- No sound during playback: Check headphone connection. Ensure volume is adequate on connected device (if applicable).
- Cannot connect to computer: Try a different USB port or cable. Ensure the device is powered on.
- **Poor recording quality:** Ensure the microphone is not obstructed. Reduce background noise. Check recording distance (optimal within 60 meters).
- **Voice activation not working:** Ensure the switch is in the 'VOR' position. Adjust sensitivity if possible (not explicitly mentioned, but a common feature).
