1. INTRODUCTION

The OTTOCAST Cabin Care CA520 is a versatile device designed to enhance your driving experience by integrating a 1080P HD rear-seat baby camera with wireless CarPlay functionality. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your device to ensure optimal performance and safety.

The system allows you to monitor children or pets in the rear seat directly on your car's existing CarPlay screen, offering various viewing modes including full screen, split screen, and picture-in-picture. It features clear day and no-glow night vision, ensuring visibility without disturbing occupants.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before you begin, please verify that all items are present in your package:

- 1x OTTOCAST Cabin Care Camera (Owl-shaped)
- 1x USB Receiver (Owl-shaped USB dongle)
- 1x USB-A to USB-C Adapter
- 1x Camera Power Cable (3m)
- 1x Mounting Plate (for bracket fixation)
- 1x Bracket (for strap fixation)

- 2x Cable Ties (for strap fixation)
- 1x User Manual

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your OTTOCAST Cabin Care system:

3.1. Mounting the Camera

The camera can be mounted using either the included bracket (for strap fixation) or the mounting plate (for bracket fixation). Choose the method that best suits your vehicle and desired camera position.

1. **Headrest Mounting (Strap Fixation):** Attach the bracket to the camera. Secure the camera and bracket to the headrest using the provided cable ties, ensuring a stable and clear view of the rear seat.
2. **Alternative Mounting (Bracket Fixation):** If using the mounting plate, attach it to a suitable surface in the rear of your vehicle that provides an optimal view. Then, attach the camera to the mounting plate.

3.2. Connecting the Receiver and Camera

1. **Connect the USB Receiver:** Plug the USB receiver into your car's USB port. If your car has a USB-C port, use the provided USB-A to USB-C adapter.
2. **Power the Camera:** Connect the camera to a power source using the 3-meter power cable. This can be a USB port in the rear of your vehicle or a car charger adapter (not included).

3.3. Initial Pairing with CarPlay

Once the receiver and camera are powered on, follow these steps to pair with your car's CarPlay system:

1. On your iPhone, ensure **Bluetooth** and **Wi-Fi** are enabled.
2. On your car's display, select the **CarPlay** icon.
3. Follow the on-screen prompts to connect your iPhone via Bluetooth to the OTTOCAST device (usually named 'CARR-XXXX').
4. Once connected, CarPlay will launch, and you will see an option to access the camera feed.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The OTTOCAST Cabin Care system offers seamless integration with your car's CarPlay display for both navigation and rear-seat monitoring.

4.1. Wireless CarPlay Functionality

The adapter converts your factory wired CarPlay to wireless, allowing you to access all your CarPlay apps, including navigation, music, and calls, without needing to plug in your phone.

4.2. Rear Seat Monitoring

The 1080P HD camera provides a wide-angle view of your rear seat, allowing you to safely monitor children or pets without turning around.

4.3. Viewing Modes

The system supports multiple viewing options on your car's screen:

- **Full Screen:** Displays the camera feed across the entire car screen.

- **Split Screen:** Divides the screen to show both CarPlay navigation/apps and the camera feed simultaneously.
- **Picture-in-Picture (PiP):** Overlays a smaller camera feed window on top of your CarPlay interface, allowing you to keep an eye on the rear seat while using other functions.

4.4. Night Vision and Day/Night Auto-Switch

The camera features 1080P clear no-glow night vision, providing a bright and natural image even in low-light conditions without using infrared glow that could disturb sleeping infants or pets. The system automatically switches between day and night modes to maintain optimal visibility.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your OTTOCAST Cabin Care system, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the camera lens and the USB receiver. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could scratch the surfaces.
- **Cable Management:** Ensure all cables are neatly routed and secured to prevent damage or interference with vehicle operation. The included cable ties can assist with this.
- **Storage:** If storing the device for an extended period, disconnect it from power and store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your OTTOCAST Cabin Care system, please refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Camera Display:** Ensure the camera is properly powered and the power cable is securely connected. Check that the USB receiver is firmly plugged into the car's USB port.
- **CarPlay Connection Issues:** Verify that your iPhone's Bluetooth and Wi-Fi are turned on. Ensure your car's wired CarPlay is compatible with the adapter. You can check compatibility at <https://check.adaptermanual.com/AMZ/>.
- **Intermittent Connection:** Ensure there are no obstructions between the camera, receiver, and your iPhone. Avoid placing other wireless devices too close to the system that might cause interference.
- **Poor Image Quality:** Check the camera lens for any smudges or dirt and clean if necessary. Ensure the camera is securely mounted and not vibrating.
- **Device Not Recognized:** Try plugging the USB receiver into a different USB port in your vehicle, if available. Restart your car's infotainment system and your iPhone.


