INTRODUCTION

The OneOdio Solocaster is a versatile 5-channel audio mixer designed for streaming, podcasting, karaoke, and general audio production. It features 48V phantom power for XLR microphones, Bluetooth connectivity, RGB lighting, and multiple input/output options for compatibility with PC, Mac, and mobile devices. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Solocaster audio mixer.

SETUP GUIDE

Follow these steps to connect and prepare your OneOdio Solocaster for use.

1. Unboxing and Initial Inspection

- Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
- Verify that all accessories are present: Solocaster mixer, USB-C cable, and user manual.
- Inspect the device for any signs of physical damage.

2. Connecting to Power and Device

1. Connect the provided USB-C cable to the 'TYPE-C' port on the rear of the Solocaster.
2. Connect the other end of the USB-C cable to your computer (PC/Mac) or a compatible USB power adapter (5V).

The device will power on automatically.

3. For mobile devices, use an appropriate adapter (not included) to connect the USB-C cable.

Zero-Latency Direct Monitoring

Direct monitor activation delivers seamless, real-time audio control. Thoughtfully placed power switches ensure smooth and effortless operation.

3. Audio Input Connections

- **XLR Microphone:** Connect your XLR microphone to the XLR/1/4" combo jack. If using a condenser microphone requiring phantom power, press the '48V' button on the mixer.
- **3.5mm Microphone/Headset:** Connect a 3.5mm microphone or a gaming headset to the 'HEADSET' or 'HEADPHONE' jacks as appropriate.
- **Line In:** Use the 'LINE IN' 3.5mm port to connect external audio sources like smartphones or other audio players.
- **Bluetooth:** Activate Bluetooth on the Solocaster by pressing the 'BT' button. Pair with your mobile device to stream background music wirelessly.

4. Audio Output Connections

- **Headphones:** Connect your monitoring headphones to the 'HEADPHONE' 3.5mm jack.
- **Line Out:** Use the 'LINE OUT' 3.5mm port to connect to external speakers or another recording device.

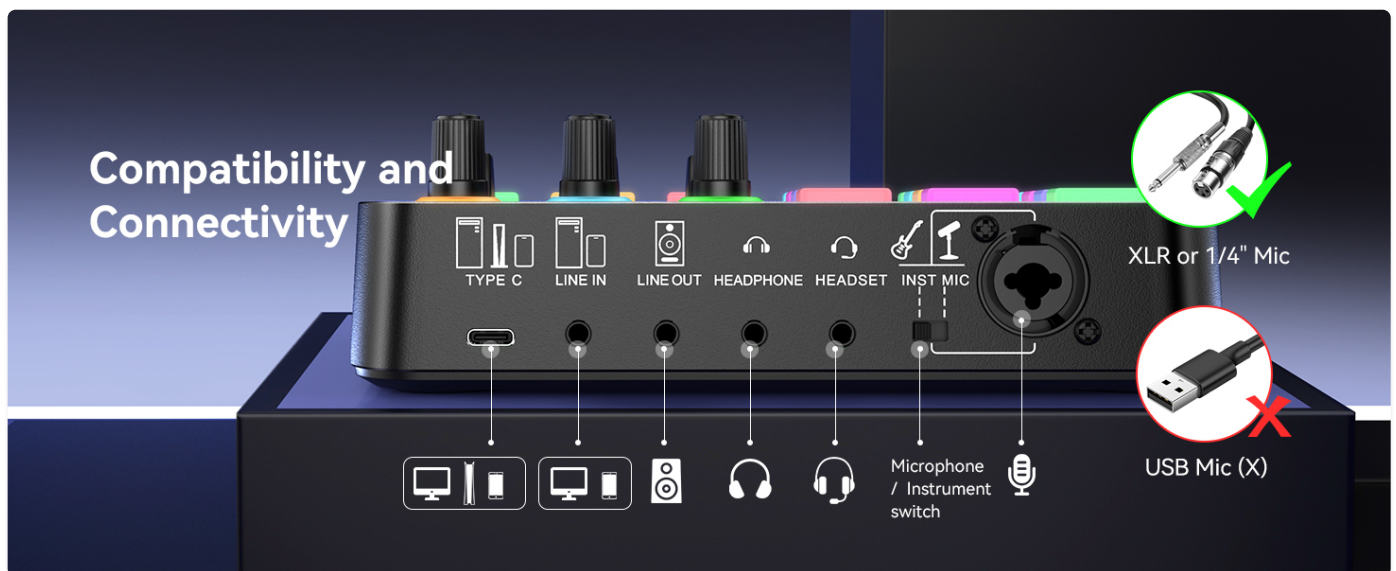


Image: Comprehensive diagram of the Solocaster's compatibility and connectivity ports.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Understand the controls and features of your Solocaster mixer.

1. Basic Controls

- **Faders:** Adjust the volume levels for Microphone (Mic), Background Music (Music), and Headphones independently.
- **Knobs:** Control Echo, X-Volume (overall output volume), and Line Out volume.
- **Mute Buttons:** Individual mute buttons for Mic, Music, and Headphone channels provide instant silence.

2. Voice Effects and Sound Pads

- **Voice Changer:** Press the 'Voice Changer' button to cycle through 6 different voice modes: Female, Male, Kid, Old Man, Beast, and Robot.
- **Sound Pads:** The four customizable sound pads can be programmed with your own audio clips (e.g., jingles, sound effects). Refer to the software instructions (if applicable) or device manual for programming details.

- **Direct Monitor:** The 'Direct Monitor' feature allows for zero-latency monitoring of your audio input through headphones, ensuring real-time feedback without delay.
- **Auto Ducking:** When enabled, this feature automatically lowers background music volume when you speak, ensuring your voice remains clear.

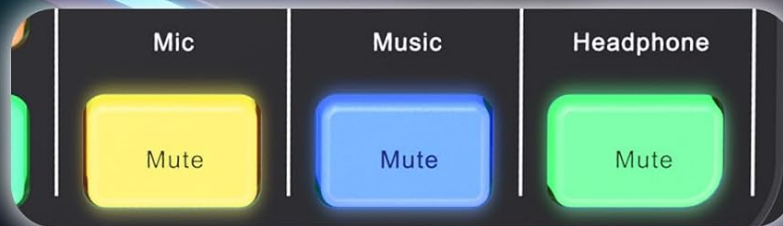

MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Solocaster mixer.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the surface of the mixer. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Dust Protection:** Keep the mixer in a clean environment and consider using a dust cover when not in use.
- **Storage:** Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Cable Management:** Ensure cables are not kinked or strained to prevent damage to ports and connectors.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	USB-C cable not connected or faulty; power source issue.	Ensure USB-C cable is securely connected to both the mixer and a working power source. Try a different USB port or power adapter.
No microphone sound	Microphone not connected; Mic fader down; Mic mute active; 48V phantom power off (for condenser mics).	Check microphone connection. Raise the Mic fader. Deactivate Mic mute. Press the '48V' button if using a condenser mic.
Audio distortion or noise	Input gain too high; ambient noise; faulty cable.	Lower input gain. Activate 'Denoise' feature. Try different cables. Ensure proper grounding.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bluetooth not connecting	Bluetooth not activated on mixer; device not in pairing mode; interference.	Press the 'BT' button on the mixer. Ensure your device's Bluetooth is on and in pairing mode. Move closer to the mixer.
No sound from headphones	Headphones not connected; Headphone fader down; Headphone mute active.	Check headphone connection. Raise the Headphone fader. Deactivate Headphone mute.
Sound pads not working	Sound pads not programmed or incorrectly programmed.	Refer to the programming instructions for the sound pads. Ensure audio files are correctly loaded.
