INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the Generic replacement remote control designed for the Excelvan RD-802 LED Mini Portable Pocket Projector. This remote control offers a convenient way to operate your projector. Please note that as a replacement unit, some functions may differ from your original remote control.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The remote control is designed for simple operation and features a compact size. It is constructed from durable ABS material for comfortable handling and longevity.

SETUP

- Battery Installation:** Open the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote control. Insert two AAA batteries (not included), ensuring correct polarity (+/-). Close the battery compartment cover securely.
- No Programming Required:** This replacement remote control does not require any programming or setup. Once batteries are installed, it is ready for use with your Excelvan RD-802 LED Mini Projector.
- Compatibility Note:** As a replacement remote, some advanced or specific functions of your original projector remote may not be supported. This is not indicative of a defective product.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Point the remote control directly at the infrared receiver on your Excelvan RD-802 LED Mini Projector. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the projector. The remote offers stable performance and a farther transmitting distance compared to some standard remotes.

- **Power Button:** Press the power button (usually red) to turn the projector on or off.
- **Navigation Buttons:** Use the directional arrow buttons (Up, Down, Left, Right) to navigate through menus and options.
- **OK/Enter Button:** Press the 'OK' or 'Enter' button in the center of the navigation pad to confirm selections.
- **Volume Control:** If available, use the volume buttons to adjust the audio output of the projector.
- **Menu/Source Buttons:** Use dedicated buttons to access the projector's menu or switch input sources.

Refer to your projector's user manual for specific functions and menu navigation details.

MAINTENANCE

- **Battery Replacement:** Replace batteries when the remote's performance degrades or it stops responding. Always use new batteries of the specified type (AAA).

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Remote Not Responding:**
 - Check if the batteries are inserted correctly with the right polarity.
 - Replace old batteries with new ones.
 - Ensure there is a clear line of sight between the remote control and the projector's infrared receiver.
 - Confirm the remote is pointed directly at the projector.
- **Some Functions Not Working:** This remote is a replacement unit. It may not support all functions of the original projector remote. This is expected behavior and not a defect.
