3. DETERMINING THE CORRECT SIZE FOR YOUR DOG

To ensure your dog's comfort and safety, it is crucial to select the appropriate crate size. Refer to the diagram below for guidance on measuring your dog.

- **Measure Length:** Dog should be standing on all four feet. Measure from the tip of the nose to the top of their tail. Add 4 inches for all dogs.
- **Measure Height:** Keep in mind: Dog should be sitting. To the tallest point of the dog. Measure upright from the floor. Add 4 inches for all dogs.
- **Warm Tips:** If you want your dog to stay comfortable, please measure them when lying down and sprawled out like they would normally sleep.

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

This dog crate furniture is designed for user-friendly assembly with pre-drilled and numbered components. Follow these general steps for a smooth setup. It is recommended to have a second person assist with assembly.

4.1. Unpacking and Part Identification

Carefully unpack all components and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches. Verify that all parts listed in the included hardware and parts list are present. Refer to the assembly diagram for part identification.

4.2. Frame Assembly

Begin by assembling the main wooden frame components. Connect the side panels to the base and top using the provided fasteners. Ensure all connections are secure but do not overtighten until the entire frame is aligned.

4.3. Door and Mesh Panel Installation

Attach the metal mesh panels and doors to the designated openings. Ensure the hinges are correctly aligned and the sturdy door latches operate smoothly. The metal mesh provides ventilation and visibility.

4.4. Drawer and Cabinet Assembly

Assemble the drawers and side cabinets according to the instructions. Install drawer slides and cabinet hinges. These

provide organized storage for pet supplies.

4.5. Final Tightening and Placement

Once all components are in place, carefully tighten all fasteners. Attach the protective floor pads to safeguard your home surfaces. Position the assembled crate in its desired location.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Using the Crate Doors

The crate features hinged doors with secure latching mechanisms. To open, lift the latch and pull the door outwards. To close, push the door shut and ensure the latch engages securely to prevent accidental opening.

5.2. Utilizing Storage Drawers and Cabinets

The integrated drawers and side cabinets can be used to store pet food, toys, leashes, and other accessories. Pull drawers open and push to close. Cabinet doors open outwards to reveal storage space.

5.3. Removable Tray

The crate includes a removable tray for easy cleaning. Slide the tray out from the bottom of the crate when needed for cleaning or to adjust bedding.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

6.1. Cleaning the Crate

Regularly clean the crate to maintain hygiene. The removable tray can be easily taken out and washed with mild soap and water. Wipe down wooden surfaces with a damp cloth and mild cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the finish or harm your pet.

6.2. Metal Mesh Care

The reinforced anti-rust iron mesh panels can be wiped clean. Inspect the mesh periodically for any signs of damage or wear.

6.3. Wooden Surface Care

The rustic white wood finishes are designed for durability. Avoid prolonged exposure to moisture. For spills, wipe immediately. The tabletop surface is load-bearing, but avoid placing excessively heavy items or hot objects directly on it without protection.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

7.1. Crate Instability

If the crate feels unstable after assembly, check all fasteners to ensure they are securely tightened. Ensure the crate is placed on a flat, level surface. Adjust the protective floor pads if necessary to balance the unit.

7.2. Doors Not Latching Properly

If a door is not latching correctly, inspect the latch mechanism for any obstructions or misalignment. Ensure the door hinges are properly installed and not bent. Minor adjustments to hinge screws may be needed.

7.3. Drawers Sticking

If a drawer is difficult to open or close, check the drawer slides for proper alignment and ensure no objects are obstructing the mechanism. Lubricating the slides with a silicone-based spray can improve movement.

8. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always ensure the crate doors are securely latched when your pet is inside.
- Do not allow children to play inside or on the crate.
- Place the crate on a stable, level surface away from heat sources or direct sunlight.

- Regularly inspect the crate for any loose parts, sharp edges, or damage that could harm your pet.
- Ensure adequate ventilation for your pet at all times.
