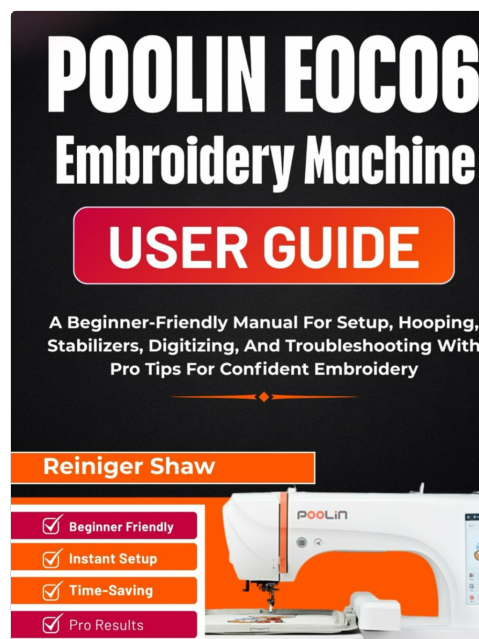

1. SETUP AND FIRST USE

- **Alignment Marks:** Use hoop alignment marks to center your fabric.
- **Baste-in-the-Hoop:** Utilize the machine's basting function to secure fabric and stabilizer.
- **Floating Methods:** For items difficult to hoop, use floating techniques with adhesive stabilizers.

2.4 On-Screen Editing and Digitizing Basics

- **Load Designs:** Transfer designs from a USB drive.
- **Edit Functions:** Resize, rotate, mirror, and combine design elements directly on the touchscreen.
- **Color Sequence:** Preview and adjust the color sequence before stitching.
- **Digitizing Concepts:** Understand basic stitch types like run, satin, and fill stitches. Apply density, underlay, and pull compensation for optimal results.

3. MAINTENANCE

3.1 Cleaning

- **Lint Removal:** Regularly remove lint and thread debris from the bobbin area, needle plate, and tension discs using a small brush or vacuum.
- **Surface Cleaning:** Wipe down the machine's exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals.

3.2 Lubrication

Refer to your machine's specific lubrication points and schedule in the detailed guide. Use only recommended sewing machine oil.

3.3 Needle Replacement

Replace needles frequently, especially after 8 hours of sewing or if you notice skipped stitches or fabric damage.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

Symptom	Possible Cause	Solution
Bird's Nesting (thread tangles on underside)	Incorrect upper threading, improper bobbin insertion, tension issues.	Re-thread the upper thread path, re-insert the bobbin, adjust upper tension.
Skipped Stitches	Bent or dull needle, incorrect needle type, improper threading, fabric movement.	Replace needle, ensure correct needle for fabric, check threading, re-hoop fabric securely.
Thread Breaks	Poor quality thread, incorrect tension, burrs on needle plate, old needle.	Use quality thread, adjust tension, inspect machine for rough spots, replace needle.
Puckering or Fabric Distortion	Insufficient stabilization, improper hooping, design density too high.	Use appropriate stabilizer, re-hoop fabric without stretching, adjust design density if possible.

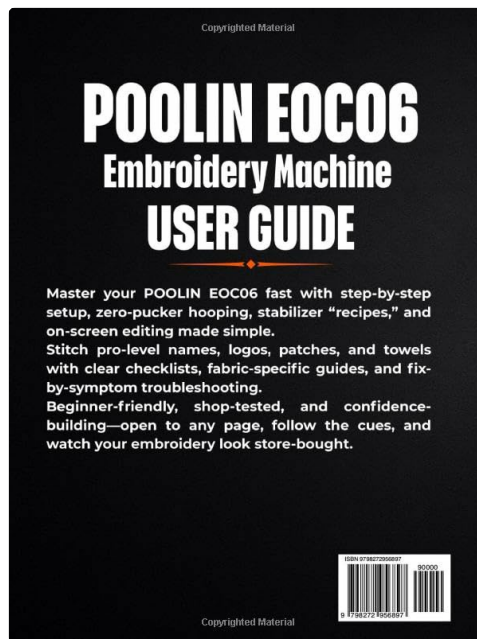
