1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Read and understand all safety instructions before operating the MAXLANDER Electric Wood Chipper Shredder. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or property damage.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- **Eye Protection:** Always wear safety glasses or goggles to protect against flying debris.
- **Hearing Protection:** Wear earplugs or earmuffs, as the machine can be loud during operation.
- **Hand Protection:** Use heavy-duty work gloves to protect hands when handling branches and operating the machine.
- **Respiratory Protection:** A breathing mask is recommended to avoid inhaling dust generated during shredding.
- **Appropriate Clothing:** Wear long pants and closed-toe shoes. Avoid loose clothing or jewelry that could get caught in moving parts.

Electrical Safety

- Ensure the power outlet and extension cord are rated for the 15-Amp motor. A 12-gauge extension cord is recommended for lengths up to 100 feet.
- Do not operate the chipper in wet conditions or on damp surfaces.
- Always disconnect the power before performing any maintenance, cleaning, or if the machine jams.

Operational Safety

- Keep hands and feet away from the feeding chute and discharge opening. Always use the provided feeding paddle to guide materials.
- Ensure the collection bin is securely in place before operation. The machine features an auto shut-off if the bin is removed.
- The unit is equipped with overload protection, which automatically cuts power to prevent motor damage. If activated, disconnect power, clear any blockage, and allow the motor to cool before restarting.

- Maintain a stable footing and balance when operating the chipper.

2. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The MAXLANDER Electric Wood Chipper Shredder requires some assembly before first use. Follow these steps carefully.

Unpacking and Component Identification

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Verify that all parts listed in the packing list are present. A Phillips head screwdriver may be required for some assembly steps.

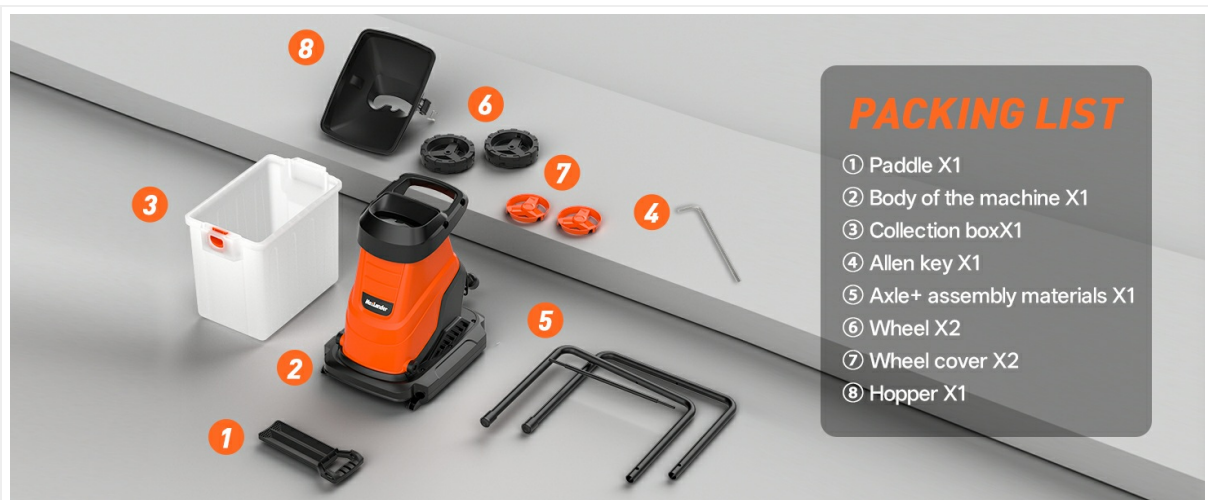

Assembly Steps

1. **Attach the Stand:** Secure the metal stand to the main body of the chipper.
2. **Install Wheels:** Attach the wheels to the axle on the stand. Ensure they are securely fastened, bending pins if necessary to prevent detachment.
3. **Mount the Hopper:** Place the feeding hopper onto the top of the chipper body and secure it according to the instructions.
4. **Position the Collection Bin:** Slide the 50L collection bin into its designated slot at the bottom of the chipper. Ensure it clicks into place for the safety interlock to engage.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these guidelines for efficient and safe operation of your wood chipper shredder.

Pre-Operation Checklist

- Ensure all safety gear (eye, ear, hand, respiratory protection) is worn.
- Check that the collection bin is correctly installed and secured.
- Inspect the chipper for any loose parts or damage.
- Verify the power cord and extension cord are in good condition and properly connected.

Material Preparation

- The chipper is designed to process branches and twigs up to 1.78 inches in diameter.
- For optimal performance and to prevent clogging, feed dry wood and branches. Moist or green material may cause jams.
- Remove any foreign objects like rocks, metal, or dirt from the material before feeding.

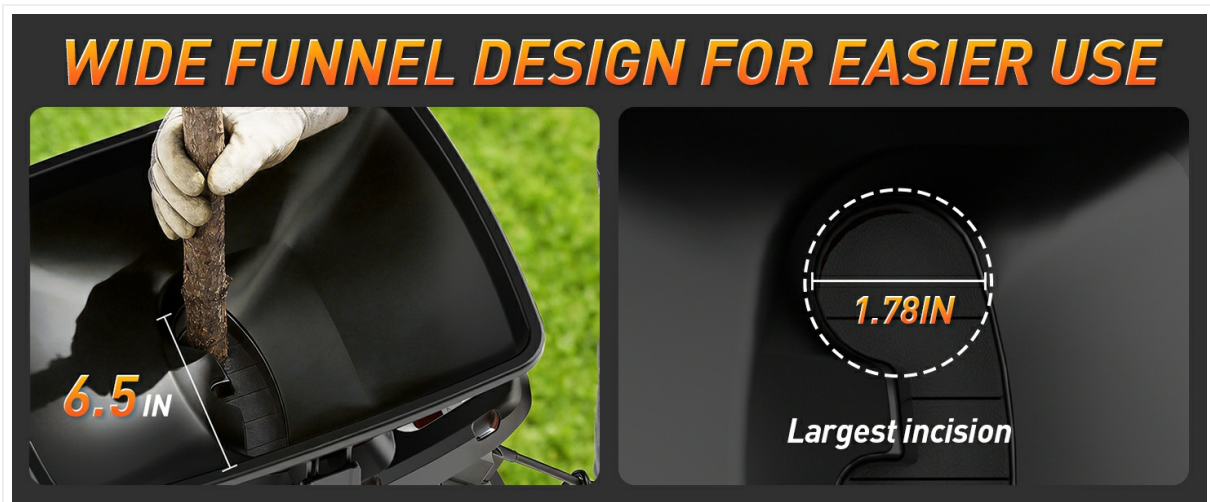

Feeding Material

- Turn on the chipper. Allow the motor to reach full speed (up to 4000 RPM) before feeding.
- Feed branches and twigs into the hopper one at a time. Do not force material into the chute.
- Always use the provided feeding paddle to push material into the blades, keeping hands clear of the opening.
- Avoid over-packing the hopper, as this can strain the motor and reduce efficiency.

Collection and Reduction

The chipper features a 15:1 reduction ratio, converting large volumes of yard waste into fine mulch. The processed material collects in the integrated 50L collection bin.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your MAXLANDER Wood Chipper Shredder.

Cleaning

- After each use, disconnect the power supply.
- Clear any remaining debris from the hopper, chute, and collection bin. A leaf blower can be used to clean the interior.
- Wipe down the exterior surfaces with a damp cloth.
- Ensure the side intake air vent is free of dust and debris to maintain proper airflow and prevent overheating.

Blade Inspection and Replacement

- Periodically inspect the SK5 dual-edge steel blades for sharpness and damage. Dull or damaged blades can reduce efficiency and increase motor strain.
- Refer to the manufacturer's guidelines for blade replacement. Always use original replacement parts to ensure compatibility and safety.

Storage

- Store the chipper in a dry, secure location, away from direct sunlight and moisture.
- If storing for extended periods, ensure the machine is thoroughly cleaned and blades are in good condition.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter during operation.

Machine Does Not Start

- **Power Connection:** Ensure the power cord and extension cord are securely plugged into a functional outlet.
- **Collection Bin:** Verify the 50L collection bin is correctly seated and engaged with the safety interlock. The machine will not start if the bin is not properly in place.
- **Overload Protection:** Check if the overload protection has been activated. If so, disconnect power, clear any blockages, and allow the motor to cool before attempting to restart.

Jams or Clogs During Operation

- **Material Type:** Jams often occur when feeding moist, green, or excessively fibrous material. Try to feed drier wood.
- **Overfeeding:** Avoid pushing too much material into the hopper at once. Feed gradually, using the paddle.
- **Clearing a Jam:** Immediately disconnect power. Wait for all moving parts to stop. Carefully remove the hopper and clear the blockage using a tool, never your hands. Reassemble and restart.

Reduced Shredding Performance

- **Dull Blades:** Inspect the blades for sharpness. Replace dull blades as needed.
- **Air Vent Blockage:** Ensure the side air vent is clear of debris to prevent motor overheating, which can affect performance.
