3. SETUP GUIDE

1. **Connect the Mouse:** Plug the USB connector of the Redragon M619 mouse into an available USB port on your computer.
2. **Driver Installation:** Your operating system should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers.
3. **Software Installation (Optional but Recommended):** For full customization of DPI, button assignments, and RGB lighting, download the official Redragon M619 software from the Redragon official website.




Image: The Redragon M619 RGB Gaming Mouse, showing its wired USB connection ready for use.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. DPI Adjustment

The M619 mouse features 5 default DPI levels for quick sensitivity adjustments. These can be cycled through using the dedicated DPI buttons located behind the scroll wheel.

- **Default DPI Levels:** 400 / 800 / 1600 / 2400 / 3200
- **Custom DPI:** Using the Redragon software, you can customize DPI settings from 50 to 12800 DPI.

4.2. Programmable Buttons

The mouse is equipped with 8 programmable buttons, allowing for custom keybinds and macros. This includes a dedicated "Fire Key" for rapid actions.

- **Total Buttons:** 8 (Left Click, Right Click, Scroll Wheel Click, 2 Side Buttons, 2 DPI Buttons, Fire Key)
- **Customization:** All 8 buttons can be reassigned using the Redragon software to suit your gaming or work needs.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Redragon M619 mouse, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the mouse surface. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Sensor Care:** Keep the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse clean and free from dust or debris to ensure accurate tracking.
- **Cable Management:** Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling on the USB cable to prevent damage.
- **Storage:** Store the mouse in a clean, dry environment when not in use.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
Mouse is not responding.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Ensure the USB cable is securely plugged into a working USB port. ◦ Try plugging the mouse into a different USB port. ◦ Restart your computer.
DPI/Sensitivity issues.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Press the DPI buttons to cycle through sensitivity levels. ◦ Check the Redragon software for custom DPI settings and ensure they are applied correctly. ◦ Clean the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse.
Buttons are not working or feel mushy.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Verify button assignments in the Redragon software. ◦ Ensure no physical obstructions are preventing button presses. ◦ If a button feels consistently unresponsive, contact customer support.

Problem	Solution
RGB lighting is not working or incorrect.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Check lighting settings within the Redragon software. ◦ Ensure the software is running and the correct profile is active.
