1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Budan Coffee Espresso Machine Cleaning Brush is designed for effective maintenance of espresso machines. It features strong nylon bristles and a specialized design to reach difficult areas, ensuring thorough cleaning of your machine's components.

Key Features:

- Durable nylon bristles with heat resistance.
- Ergonomic design for cleaning espresso machine group heads.
- Water-deflecting fins to keep hands cool and dry during use.
- Integrated spoon for measuring cleaning chemicals.
- Inclined head for easy removal of coffee grounds from outlets.




Image 1.1: The Budan Coffee Espresso Machine Cleaning Brush, showing its white bristles and black handle.

2. SETUP

The Budan Coffee Espresso Machine Cleaning Brush requires no assembly. It is ready for immediate use upon removal from its packaging.

Unpacking:

1. Carefully remove the cleaning brush from its packaging.
2. Inspect the brush for any visible damage. If damaged, contact customer support.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This brush is designed for cleaning various parts of semi-automatic espresso machines and coffee grinders.

Cleaning the Espresso Machine Group Head and Shower Screen:

1. Ensure the espresso machine is turned off or in a safe state for cleaning.
2. Position the brush with its elbow design to access the group head and shower screen.
3. Gently scrub the shower screen and the interior of the group head to remove coffee grounds and residue. The water-deflecting fins help protect your hands from hot water.
4. For deeper cleaning, use the integrated spoon at the end of the handle to measure and apply appropriate espresso machine cleaning chemicals as per the chemical manufacturer's instructions.
5. Perform a backflush cycle if recommended by your espresso machine's manufacturer after chemical cleaning.

Cleaning Coffee Outlets and Other Areas:

1. Use the inclined head of the brush to easily sweep away coffee grounds from the coffee outlet and other hard-to-reach crevices.
2. The brush is also suitable for cleaning coffee filter nets and other small components.

4. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance of your cleaning brush ensures its longevity and effectiveness.

Cleaning the Brush:

1. After each use, rinse the brush bristles thoroughly under warm running water to remove all coffee grounds and residue.
2. If necessary, use a mild soap to clean the bristles, then rinse completely.
3. Shake off excess water and allow the brush to air dry completely before storing.
4. Store the brush in a clean, dry place.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your cleaning brush.

Issue: Brush not cleaning effectively.

- **Solution 1:** Ensure the bristles are clean and free of old coffee residue. Clean the brush as described in the Maintenance section.
- **Solution 2:** For stubborn residue, consider using an appropriate espresso machine cleaning chemical in conjunction with the brush, following the chemical's instructions.
- **Solution 3:** Verify you are using the correct technique to reach all areas of the group head and shower screen. The elbow design is specifically for this purpose.
