QCOQ Air Tracker Tags TX01 Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

The QCOQ Air Tracker Tag is a Bluetooth 5.3 item finder designed to help you locate your valuable belongings. It integrates seamlessly with the Apple Find My network, allowing iOS users to track items such as wallets, luggage, keys, and backpacks. This manual provides detailed instructions for setup, operation, and maintenance of your Air Tracker Tags.

2. SETUP AND CONNECTION

To begin using your Air Tracker Tag, refer to the detailed instructions included in the packaging. This Smart Tag does not require a separate app download and connects directly to your iOS device via the Apple Find My app.

1. Press and hold the button on the tracker for 2 seconds to activate pairing mode.
2. Open the "Find My" app on your iOS device. Ensure Bluetooth and network functions are enabled.
3. In the "Find My" app, tap the "Items" tab, then select "Add Other Item".
4. Once the "Huthur Tag" appears, tap "Connect" and follow the on-screen prompts to complete the connection. You can then name your item.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Comprehensive Item Tracking

Air Tracker Tags can locate various items. Attach the tag to everyday items like keys, wallets, luggage, or backpacks. Use the Apple "Find My" network to check their real-time location, assisting in preventing loss or theft.

3.2 Proximity Sound Alerts

When the Bluetooth connection between your device and the Air Tracker Tag is within approximately 200 feet (60m in open areas, 30m when obstructed), you can use the "Play Sound" feature in the Find My app. The tag will emit an alert tone of up to 100dB to help you locate the item nearby.

3.3 Lost Mode and Global Tracking

If an item is lost and out of Bluetooth range, enable "Lost Mode" in the Find My app. This will upload the tag's location data to iCloud via Apple's global device network for continuous tracking. You can also leave contact

information, allowing nearby Apple users to anonymously provide the Smart Tag's location, improving item recovery potential.



3.4 Left-Behind Reminders

The "Lost Reminder" feature in the Find My app helps prevent losing important items. When your device moves beyond a set distance or time from your phone, the Find My app automatically triggers alerts. If still disconnected after a timeout, it sends a final "Lost Reminder" with the last known location. To enable this: Bind device → tap its name → scroll to Notifications → turn on "Notify When Left Behind". You can manually set Do Not Disturb zones to avoid unnecessary alerts.

3.5 Sharing Location

You can share the location of your Air Tracker Tag with up to 5 contacts through the Find My app. Both parties must be running iOS 17 or later to utilize this feature.

How to Replace Batteries



4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Battery Replacement

The Air Tracker Tags use a replaceable CR2032 battery, offering a battery life of up to 1 year. The device proactively alerts you when the battery is low. The unique snap design prevents accidental opening by children, making it suitable for home and travel use.

1. Rotate the stainless steel cover counterclockwise to open.
2. Insert the new CR2032 battery with the "+" side facing up.
3. Align the cover and press gently until seated.
4. Rotate clockwise to tighten and secure the cover.


5. FEATURES

This MFi-certified Tracker encrypts all communications anonymously. Location data is never stored on the Air Tracker Tag, ensuring that even the manufacturer cannot access it. Your tracking records for wallets, luggage, and other items remain fully confidential, providing secure item tracking.


How to Activate The Lost Mode?

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your QCOQ Air Tracker Tag, please consider the following:

- **Connection Issues:** Ensure your iOS device's Bluetooth is enabled and the Find My app is updated. Try restarting both the tracker (by removing and reinserting the battery) and your phone.
- **Inaccurate Location:** Location update frequency depends on the number of nearby Apple devices with Bluetooth active. Apple's network has inherent delays, and Find My does not provide real-time GPS positioning. It records the last updated location.
- **Sound Not Playing:** Check if the tracker is within Bluetooth range (approx. 200 feet) of your iOS device. Ensure the volume on your phone is audible.
- **Battery Life:** If the battery drains quickly, ensure the tracker is not constantly searching or playing sounds. Replace the CR2032 battery if the low battery alert is active.
