PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The aowoka M6-YTUS-BK is a portable wireless speaker designed for various environments, featuring Bluetooth 5.4 connectivity, IPX7 waterproofing, and dynamic LED lighting. It delivers powerful sound with enhanced bass and offers up to 24 hours of playtime.

Key Features

- **Powerful Bass:** Equipped with a high-power full-range driver and CD grain metal bass cone.
- **Extended Playtime:** Up to 24 hours of battery life from a built-in 1800 mAh rechargeable Li-ion battery.
- **Bluetooth 5.4:** Ensures fast and stable wireless connection.
- **IPX7 Waterproof:** Resistant to rain, dust, snow, splashes, sand, and temporary submersion in water.
- **RGB Lighting:** Seven dazzling colorful glowing modes that sync with music.
- **TWS Function:** Connect two speakers for true wireless stereo sound.
- **Multiple Playback Modes:** Supports Bluetooth, TF/SD card, and AUX input.
- **Hands-free Calling:** Built-in microphone for convenient calls.

SETUP

1. Charging the Speaker

Before first use, fully charge the speaker. Connect the provided USB charging cable to the speaker's DC

5V charging port and the other end to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port. The charging indicator light will show the charging status.

2. Power On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button for approximately 2 seconds. You will hear an audible prompt, and the LED lights will illuminate.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button for approximately 2 seconds. You will hear an audible prompt, and the LED lights will turn off.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the speaker is powered on and in Bluetooth pairing mode (the Bluetooth indicator light will flash).
2. On your device (smartphone, tablet, etc.), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
3. Select "aowoka M6-YTUS-BK" from the list of devices.
4. Once paired, you will hear a confirmation sound, and the Bluetooth indicator light will remain solid.

2. TWS (True Wireless Stereo) Pairing

To achieve stereo sound, you can pair two aowoka M6-YTUS-BK speakers together.

1. Ensure both speakers are powered on and not connected to any Bluetooth device.
2. On one speaker, double-press the TWS button (often indicated by a 'TWS' icon). This speaker will become the primary speaker.
3. The two speakers will automatically search and pair with each other. You will hear a confirmation sound once connected.
4. Once TWS paired, connect your device to the primary speaker via Bluetooth as described in the 'Bluetooth Pairing' section.

3. LED Light Control

The speaker features dynamic RGB lighting. Use the dedicated Light button to cycle through different

lighting modes or turn the lights off.

- **Single Press:** Cycle through various light modes.
- **Press and Hold (approx. 2 seconds):** Turn the LED lights off.

4. Playback Controls

- **Play/Pause:** Press the Play/Pause button once.
- **Volume Up:** Short press the '+' button.
- **Volume Down:** Short press the '-' button.
- **Next Track:** Press and hold the '+' button for 2 seconds.
- **Previous Track:** Press and hold the '-' button for 2 seconds.

5. Hands-free Calling

When connected to your phone via Bluetooth, you can manage calls directly from the speaker.

- **Answer Call:** Press the Call button once.
- **End Call:** Press the Call button once during a call.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Call button for 2 seconds.

6. TF/SD Card Playback

Insert a TF/SD card (up to 32GB, FAT32 format) with audio files into the TF/SD card slot. The speaker will automatically switch to TF/SD card mode and begin playback.

7. AUX Input

Connect an audio device using a 3.5mm AUX cable (not included) to the speaker's AUX port. The speaker will automatically switch to AUX mode. Use your connected device to control playback.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

Wipe the speaker with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or chemical solvents, as these may damage the surface.

Storage

Store the speaker in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. If storing for an extended period, charge the battery every 3 months to maintain its lifespan.

Battery Care

To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the speaker frequently. Charge the speaker using only the provided cable and a compatible 5V USB power source.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Speaker does not power on	Low battery; Power button not pressed long enough	Charge the speaker; Press and hold the Power button for 2 seconds
Cannot pair via Bluetooth	Speaker not in pairing mode; Device Bluetooth off; Too far from device	Ensure speaker is flashing Bluetooth indicator; Enable Bluetooth on device; Move device closer (within 10m)
No sound	Volume too low; Paused playback; Incorrect input mode	Increase volume on speaker and device; Press Play; Check if in correct mode (Bluetooth, TF, AUX)
TWS pairing fails	Speakers already connected to other devices; Too far apart	Disconnect speakers from other devices; Ensure speakers are close to each other during TWS pairing
