1. INTRODUCTION

- Kydex Sheath with adjustable belt clip

4. SETUP

The Sitivien ST38 knife comes with a Kydex sheath designed for secure and versatile carry.

4.1 Attaching the Kydex Sheath

The Kydex sheath features an adjustable clip for secure belt attachment, allowing for both vertical and horizontal carry. To attach the sheath:

1. Identify the adjustable clip on the back of the Kydex sheath.
2. Loosen the screws securing the clip to the sheath.
3. Adjust the clip to your desired orientation (vertical or horizontal) and belt width.
4. Securely tighten the screws to ensure the clip is firmly in place.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning

- After each use, especially after contact with food, dirt, or corrosive materials, clean the blade and handle with mild soap and water.
- Dry thoroughly with a clean cloth to prevent rust or corrosion.
- For the Kydex sheath, wipe it clean with a damp cloth.

6.2 Sharpening

The AEB-L steel blade is designed for ease of sharpening and maintaining a sharp edge. Use a quality sharpening system appropriate for knife blades. Maintain the original blade angle for best results.

6.3 Storage

Store the knife in its Kydex sheath in a dry environment. Avoid storing in humid conditions or direct sunlight for extended periods.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Sitivien ST38 knife, consider the following:

- **Dull Blade:** The blade may require sharpening. Refer to Section 6.2.
- **Loose Sheath Clip:** Check if the screws securing the adjustable clip are tightened. Refer to Section 4.1.
- **Corrosion/Rust:** Ensure the knife is cleaned and dried thoroughly after each use and stored in a dry environment. Refer to Section 6.1.
