1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Aeitto Nugget Ice Maker. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your new ice maker. Please read it thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

The Aeitto Nugget Ice Maker is designed to produce up to 42 lbs of soft, chewable nugget ice per day, featuring a 1.5L water tank and a 2 lbs ice basket. It offers rapid ice production in approximately 6 minutes and includes a convenient self-cleaning function.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please observe the following safety precautions to prevent injury or damage to the appliance:

- Ensure the unit is placed on a stable, level surface away from heat sources and direct sunlight.
- Do not immerse the appliance, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Use only potable water in the water tank.
- Keep children away from the appliance during operation.
- Unplug the ice maker before cleaning or when not in use for extended periods.
- Do not operate the unit if the power cord or plug is damaged.
- This appliance uses R600a refrigerant. Handle with care and do not puncture the refrigerant tubing.

4. SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the ice maker from its packaging. Remove all packing materials, including the foam inserts and plastic bags.
2. **Placement:** Place the ice maker on a flat, stable surface. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the unit (at least 5 inches of space on all sides).
3. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker. Refer to the 'Maintenance and Cleaning' section for detailed instructions.
4. **Power Connection:** Plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet.
5. **Add Water:** Open the top lid and pour potable water into the water tank up to the 'MAX' fill line.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Start Ice Production:** After adding water, press the 'On/Off' button. The 'Making Ice' indicator light will illuminate.
2. **Ice Production Cycle:** The ice maker will begin producing nugget ice. The first batch typically takes

about 6-10 minutes.

3. **Ice Full Indicator:** When the ice basket is full, the 'Ice Full' indicator light will turn on, and the machine will pause ice production.
4. **Add Water Indicator:** If the water level is too low, the 'Add Water' indicator light will illuminate, and the machine will pause. Add more water to resume operation.
5. **Continuous Operation:** The ice maker features auto-continuous ice making. Ice production halts when the basket is full and resumes approximately 30 minutes after the ice level drops.
6. **Storing Ice:** The ice maker does not have a refrigeration function for storing ice. It is recommended to transfer ice to a freezer for long-term storage.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and hygiene.

6.1 Self-Cleaning Function

1. Ensure the water tank is filled with clean water.
2. Press and hold the 'Clean' button for 5 seconds to activate the self-cleaning cycle. The machine will circulate water to clean the internal components.
3. Once the cycle is complete, drain the water from the unit.

6.2 Manual Cleaning

1. Unplug the ice maker from the power outlet.
2. Remove the ice basket.
3. For a deeper clean, the innovative design allows for an easy-open back cover. Insert the ice scoop and use the lever principle to open it, providing access for thorough manual cleaning.
4. Clean the interior with a soft cloth and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly.
5. Ensure all parts are dry before reassembling and operating.

6.3 Descaling

To prevent mineral buildup and maintain ice quality, descale your machine every 3-4 months, or if your ice starts appearing cloudy. Use a dedicated ice machine cleaner and descaler. Follow the cleaner's instructions carefully, typically involving running a cleaning solution through the machine and then discarding the first few batches of ice.
