## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Bellemave Queen Over Queen Bunk Bed is designed for versatile use in various room settings, including children's rooms, adult bedrooms, dorms, or guest rooms. This bed features a sturdy construction of pine wood and MDF, ensuring durability and stability. Its design allows for use as a stacked bunk bed or can be detached into two separate queen-sized platform beds, offering flexibility to suit your space and needs. The lower bunk is designed close to the floor, enhancing safety for younger users. Full-length guardrails and an inclined ladder are integrated for secure access and use.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

---

- **Guardrails:** Always ensure guardrails are securely installed on the upper bunk to prevent falls.
- **Ladder Use:** Use the inclined ladder for entering and exiting the upper bunk. Do not jump on or off the bunk bed.
- **Weight Capacity:** The bunk bed is designed to support a maximum weight of 650 lbs. Distribute weight evenly.
- **Mattress Thickness:** For the upper bunk, a mattress thickness of approximately 6 inches is recommended to maintain adequate guardrail height.
- **Age Recommendation:** The upper bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the bed.
- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check all bolts and connections to ensure they remain tight.

## 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

---

Your Bellemave Queen Over Queen Bunk Bed will arrive in two separate packages. Please ensure both packages are received before beginning assembly. Carefully unpack all components and verify against

the parts list provided in the separate assembly instructions document.

### Using the Bunk Bed:

- **Sleeping:** The bunk bed provides two queen-sized sleeping surfaces. Ensure mattresses are properly placed on the slats.
- **Ladder Access:** Use the inclined ladder to safely access the upper bunk. Always face the ladder when climbing up or down.
- **Detached Beds:** If configured as two separate beds, ensure they are placed on a flat, stable surface.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

---

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the bed frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that may damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) inspect all bolts, screws, and connections. Tighten any that have become loose to maintain structural integrity and safety.
- **Wood Care:** Protect the wood from extreme temperature changes and direct sunlight to prevent warping or fading.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Wobbly Frame:** If the bed feels unstable, re-check all connections and ensure all bolts are fully tightened. Ensure the bed is on a level surface.
- **Difficulty Assembling:** Refer to the detailed assembly instructions. Ensure all parts are correctly oriented and that you are using the correct hardware for each step. If a part seems ill-fitting, double-check the part number against the manual.
