INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Devoko 6x8 FT Plastic Storage Shed. Please read these instructions carefully before beginning assembly or use to ensure safe and proper installation and long-term performance of your storage shed.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Devoko storage shed is designed for straightforward, tool-free assembly. For optimal results and safety, it is recommended that 2-3 people participate in the assembly process.

- 1. Preparation:** Ensure you have a level and stable surface for the shed installation. Unpack all components and verify against the parts list provided in the color-coded instruction manual. The shed is shipped in 4 separate boxes.
- 2. Component Identification:** All components are pre-labeled for easy identification. Use the provided assembly gloves to protect your hands during handling.
- 3. Panel Assembly:** Follow the color-coded instruction manual for step-by-step guidance on interlocking the plastic panels. Ensure all panels are securely fitted to create a rainproof and dustproof barrier.
- 4. Frame and Floor Installation:** Install the steel-reinforced frame and the thick resin floor base. Ensure the anti-slip surface of the floor is correctly oriented.
- 5. Door and Roof Installation:** Attach the single hinged, lockable door and the weather-resistant peak roof. The sloped roof design is crucial for preventing water pooling.
- 6. Stabilization:** Utilize the integrated anchoring points for optional ground stabilization. This is

recommended to enhance security and stability, especially in windy conditions.

7. **Final Check:** After assembly, inspect all connections to ensure they are tight and secure. Confirm that the door operates smoothly and locks correctly.

OPERATION

- **Door Usage:** The shed features a single hinged, lockable door. To open, turn the handle and pull. To close, push the door firmly until it latches.
- **Locking Mechanism:** For security, use a padlock (not included) with the integrated lockable door mechanism. Ensure the door is fully closed before engaging the lock.
- **Storage Capacity:** The shed offers 331.28 cubic feet of storage. Organize items efficiently to maximize space. Avoid placing excessively heavy items directly against the walls.
- **Ventilation:** The shed includes ventilation to help reduce condensation. Ensure these vents are not obstructed.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life and appearance of your Devoko storage shed.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the shed periodically with mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the plastic panels. Rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- **Inspection:** Annually inspect the shed for any signs of wear or damage, particularly after severe weather conditions. Check all panel connections, the roof, and the door for proper alignment and sealing.
- **Door Mechanism:** Lubricate the door hinges and locking mechanism annually with a silicone-based lubricant to ensure smooth operation.
- **Anchoring:** If anchored, periodically check the ground anchors for security and tightness.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Issue:** Panels appear loose or shed feels unstable.
Solution: Ensure all interlocking panels are fully engaged and secured according to the assembly instructions. Verify that all screws are tightened appropriately without overtightening, which can damage plastic. Consider using the integrated anchoring points for additional ground stabilization.
- **Issue:** Water leakage inside the shed.
Solution: Check all roof and wall panel seams to ensure they are properly interlocked and sealed. Verify that the sloped roof design is correctly installed to prevent water pooling. Inspect the door seal for any gaps or damage.
- **Issue:** Door does not close or lock properly.
Solution: Check for any obstructions around the door frame or hinges. Ensure the shed is on a level surface, as uneven ground can cause door misalignment. Adjust hinges if necessary, following the manual's guidance.
- **Issue:** Difficulty with screw insertion or stripped holes during assembly.
Solution: Ensure you are using the correct screws for each step. Apply gentle, consistent pressure when screwing into plastic to avoid stripping. Do not overtighten. If a hole is stripped, consider using a slightly larger screw or a plastic anchor if appropriate and not compromising structural integrity.
