Deryan 14-inch Kids' Bicycle Instruction Manual

Model: 14-inch | Brand: Deryan

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Deryan 14-inch Kids' Bicycle. Please read all instructions carefully before use to ensure your child's safety and the longevity of the product. The Deryan 14-inch Kids' Bicycle is designed as a versatile 3-in-1 bicycle, adaptable for different stages of a child's development, functioning as a balance bike, a pedal bike with training wheels, or a standard pedal bike.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always ensure the child wears a helmet and appropriate safety gear.
- Supervise children at all times while riding.
- Regularly check all bolts, nuts, and quick releases to ensure they are securely fastened.
- Ensure brakes are functioning correctly before each ride.
- The steering limiter is designed for added safety, helping the child maintain control.
- The fully enclosed chain guard prevents clothing from getting caught and protects from moving parts.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Deryan 14-inch Kids' Bicycle comes partially assembled. Follow these steps for final assembly and configuration.

3.1. Handlebar Installation and Adjustment

Insert the handlebar stem into the fork tube. Adjust the handlebar height to a comfortable position for the rider, ensuring the minimum insertion mark is not visible. Tighten the handlebar clamp bolt securely. The handlebar features soft rubber grips for comfort and a secure hold.

3.2. Seat Height Adjustment

Adjust the saddle height to ensure the child can comfortably touch the ground with their feet. Loosen the seat post clamp, adjust the seat to the desired height, and then securely tighten the clamp. The synthetic leather saddle with soft padding provides maximum comfort.

3.3. Pedal Installation (for Pedal Bike Mode)

Identify the left (L) and right (R) pedals. The right pedal screws in clockwise, and the left pedal screws in counter-clockwise. Ensure pedals are fully tightened to prevent loosening during use.

3.4. Training Wheel Installation/Removal (Optional)

For beginners, attach the extra-large training wheels to the rear axle. Ensure they are securely fastened and provide stable support. As the child gains confidence, the training wheels can be removed to transition to a standard pedal bike.

3.5. Chain Guard

The bicycle features a fully enclosed chain guard for enhanced safety, preventing clothing entanglement and protecting the chain from debris.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Before each ride, perform a quick safety check:

- **Brakes:** Squeeze both brake levers to ensure they engage smoothly and stop the wheels effectively.
- **Tires:** Check tire pressure. The 14-inch pneumatic tires are suitable for asphalt and dirt roads, offering stability and comfort.
- **Steering:** Ensure the handlebar turns freely without excessive play and that the steering limiter functions as intended.
- **Seat & Handlebar:** Confirm that the seat and handlebar are at the correct height for the rider and are securely tightened.
- **Pedals & Chain:** Ensure pedals are securely attached and the chain is clean and lubricated (if applicable for pedal mode).

Encourage your child to practice riding in a safe, open area away from traffic. Start with the balance bike mode if they are new to cycling, then introduce training wheels, and finally transition to a standard pedal bike as their skills develop.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Clean the bicycle regularly with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid high-pressure washers.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically lubricate the chain (if in pedal mode) and other moving parts with bicycle-specific lubricant.
- **Tire Pressure:** Maintain recommended tire pressure as indicated on the tire sidewall.
- **Brake Adjustment:** If brakes feel loose or too tight, adjust the brake cable tension at the lever or caliper. Consult a bicycle mechanic if unsure.
- **Storage:** Store the bicycle in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures, to prevent rust and material degradation.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are some common issues and their solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Brakes not engaging effectively	Loose brake cable, worn brake pads	Adjust brake cable tension; replace worn brake pads.
Pedals feel loose	Pedals not fully tightened during assembly	Re-tighten pedals, ensuring correct left/right threading.
Tires losing air quickly	Puncture, loose valve stem	Inspect for punctures and repair; tighten valve stem.
Handlebar or seat slipping	Clamp not tightened sufficiently	Securely tighten the respective clamp bolts.
