AECOJOY 16' x 8' Hard Top Lean-to Gazebo Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your AECOJOY 16' x 8' Hard Top Lean-to Gazebo. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference. Proper installation and care will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your gazebo.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The AECOJOY 16' x 8' Hard Top Lean-to Gazebo is designed for attachment to a wall, providing enhanced stability. Assembly typically requires at least two individuals. All necessary accessories for wall attachment are provided.

Preparation:

- Unpack all components and verify against the parts list (not included in this document, refer to packaging).
- Ensure you have adequate space for assembly.
- Gather necessary tools, including a power screw gun for efficiency.

Assembly Steps:

1. Begin by assembling the main frame structure according to the provided diagrams (refer to the separate assembly guide).
2. **Important:** Install the curtains and mosquito netting onto the frame **before** installing the roof panels. Attempting to install them after the roof is in place may be difficult or impossible.
3. Position the gazebo against the desired wall. The rear posts include attachments for secure fastening to the wall.
4. Once the main structure is stable, proceed with installing the roof panels. Exercise care during insertion and positioning of the plastic roofing sheets; a wooden block and rubber mallet may assist in avoiding damage.
5. Securely fix and stabilize the gazebo to the ground as instructed. For concrete surfaces, heavy-duty concrete screws are recommended for the front posts to ensure adequate anchoring. The gazebo is designed to withstand winds of approximately 70 mph when properly anchored.
6. **Note:** The structure may feel less rigid until it is fully anchored to both the wall and the ground.

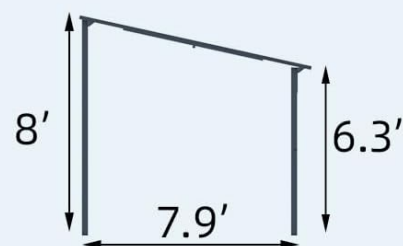
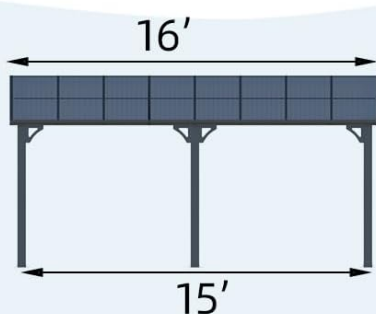
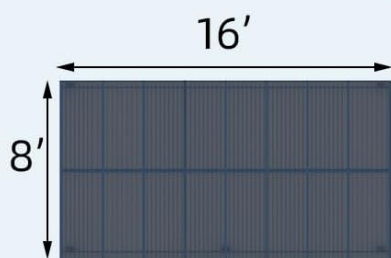
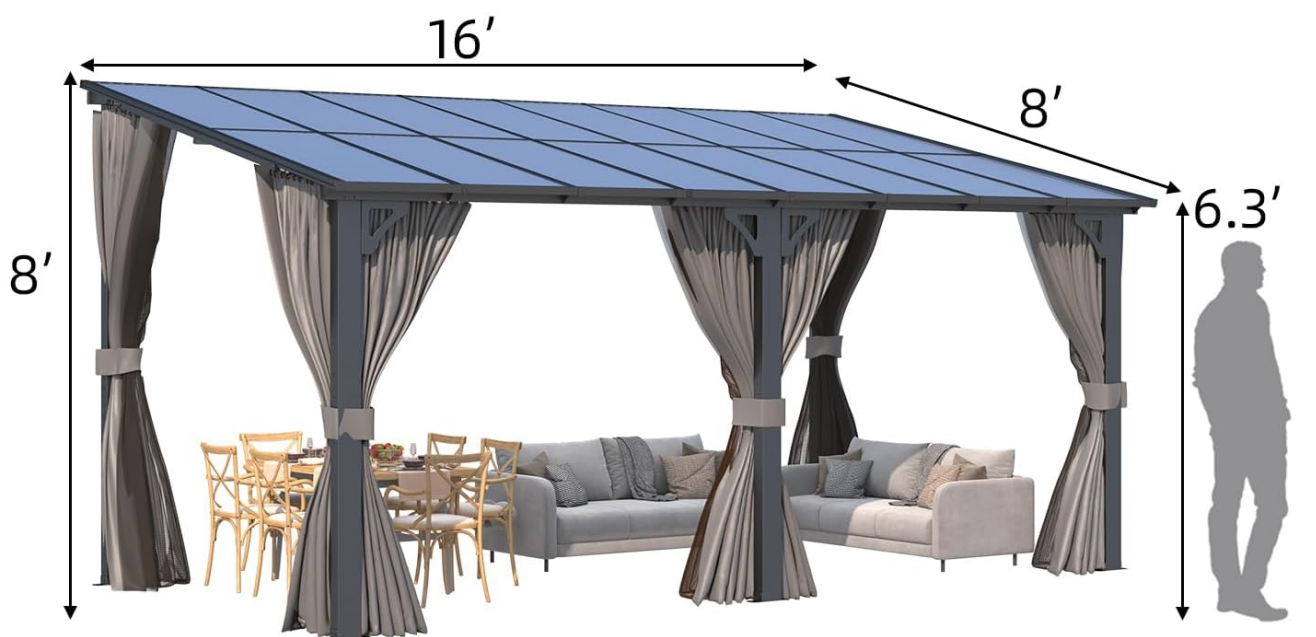


Image: A detailed diagram illustrating the dimensions of the 16' x 8' hardtop gazebo, including height and width measurements for the roof and overall structure.

OPERATION AND USAGE

Your AECOJOY gazebo is designed to provide a comfortable outdoor space, offering protection from various weather conditions.

Weather Protection:

- **Roof Capacity:** The hard top roof is engineered to withstand approximately 7 inches of heavy snow (equivalent to 6 lbs/sq.ft).
- **Waterproof Design:** The inclined roof design and meticulous detailing ensure complete water resistance, protecting the area beneath from rain.
- **UV Protection:** The awning roof provides protection against harmful UV rays with a UPF 50++ rating, blocking 99% of UV radiation.

Curtains and Netting:

The gazebo includes 3-sided curtains and mosquito netting. Both feature smooth zippers for a complete seal, allowing you to enclose the space for privacy, insect protection, or additional shelter from wind and sun.

3-SIDED CURTAINS AND MOSQUITO NETTING

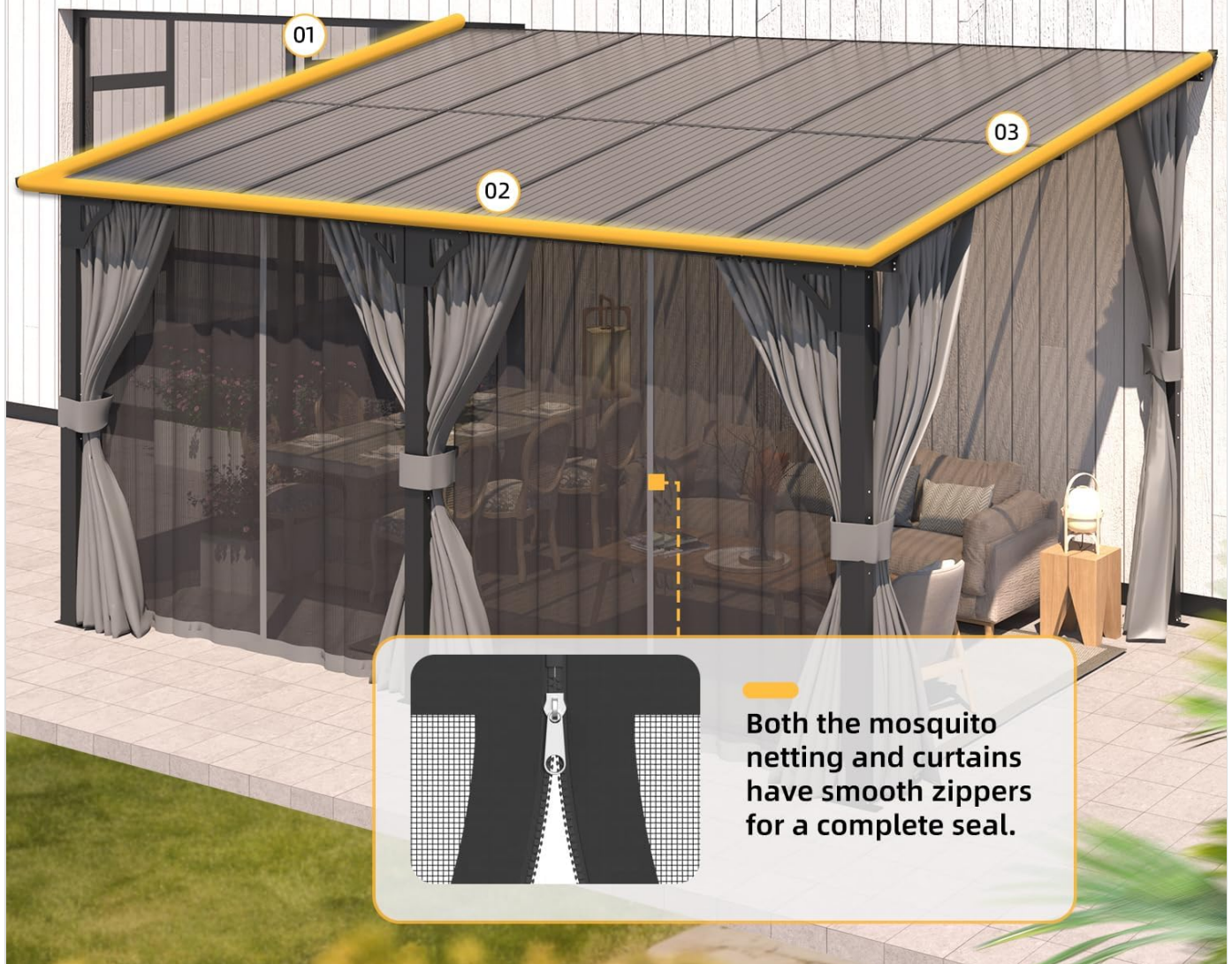


Image: An overhead view of the gazebo highlighting the 3-sided curtains and mosquito netting, with an inset showing the smooth zipper mechanism for a complete seal.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps preserve the appearance and functionality of your gazebo.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the metal frame and roof panels with mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners. The curtains and netting can be spot cleaned or removed for gentle washing as needed.
- **Fasteners:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and anchoring points to ensure they remain tight and secure. Retighten as necessary.
- **Roof Panels:** Inspect roof panels for any debris accumulation, especially after heavy winds or storms. Clear snow accumulation from the roof to prevent excessive load, although the roof is designed for up to 7 inches of snow.
- **Waterproofing:** If minor leaks occur over time, applying a silicone sealant to the affected areas can restore waterproofing.
- **Curtain Longevity:** To extend the life and prevent fading of the curtains, consider removing them during periods of

non-use or extreme weather conditions.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Gazebo feels unstable or flimsy during assembly.	The structure is designed to gain full rigidity once completely anchored to both the wall and the ground.	Ensure all wall attachments and ground anchors are securely fastened as per the assembly instructions. Do not use the gazebo until it is fully stabilized.
Water leakage from the roof.	Minor gaps or wear in seals over time.	Inspect the roof panels and seams. Apply a suitable outdoor silicone sealant to any areas where water may be penetrating.
Difficulty installing curtains/netting after roof is on.	Curtains/netting were not installed at the recommended stage.	The assembly instructions recommend installing curtains and netting before the roof panels. If the roof is already installed, carefully try to maneuver them into place, or consider partially disassembling the roof section if necessary.
Damage to components (e.g., dents, bent parts).	Shipping damage or improper handling during assembly.	Inspect all parts upon receipt. If components are damaged, contact AECOJOY customer support immediately for assistance or replacement parts.
