1. INTRODUCTION

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

4.2 Mounting Hardware and Connection

Utilize the provided mounting brackets and hardware to secure the running board to the vehicle's frame. The design incorporates concealed connectors for a clean, integrated appearance.

1. Identify the factory mounting points on the passenger side of your Ford Transit.
2. Attach the mounting brackets to the vehicle frame using the specified hardware. Do not fully tighten at this stage.
3. Position the running board onto the installed brackets, aligning the mounting holes.
4. Secure the running board to the brackets using the remaining hardware.
5. Once all hardware is in place, progressively tighten all bolts to the manufacturer's recommended torque specifications. Ensure the running board is level and secure.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The running board provides a stable and wide step for easier entry and exit from your Ford Transit van.

5.1 Stepping On and Off

When entering or exiting the vehicle, place your foot firmly on the running board's anti-slip surface. The 8-inch wide surface and ribbed design provide excellent traction.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Damage Check:** Inspect the running board for any signs of corrosion, cracks, or structural damage, especially after off-road use or impacts.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your running board, consider the following:

- **Running Board Feels Loose:** Check all mounting bolts and brackets. Tighten any loose fasteners. Ensure the running board is properly seated on the brackets.
- **Unusual Noises (Rattling/Squeaking):** This often indicates loose hardware. Re-inspect and tighten all bolts. Ensure no foreign objects are lodged between the running board and the vehicle.
- **Difficulty Stepping:** Ensure the anti-slip surface is clean and free of debris, mud, or ice.

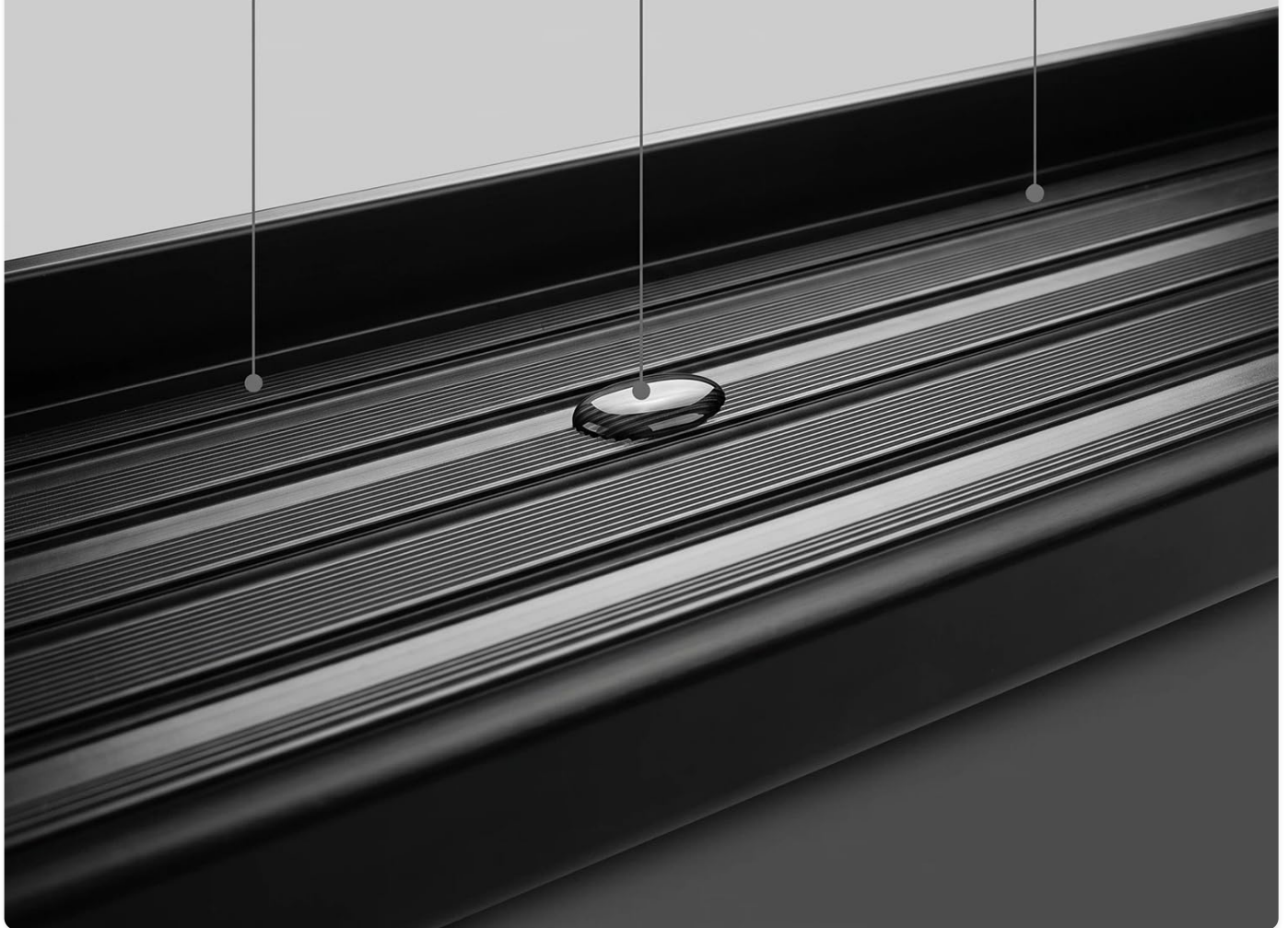


Image 8.2: Details on the durable construction, showing the ribbed anti-slip surface and material properties.
