INTRODUCTION

SAFETY INFORMATION

Important Safety Warnings:

- Always use the provided ladders carefully to avoid falls.
- Ensure both boxes have arrived before starting assembly to prevent incorrect setup.
- Be cautious around sharp edges to avoid injury during assembly and use.
- The top bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- Ensure all connections are tightened securely before use and periodically check for looseness.
- Do not allow jumping on the bed.
- Use only mattresses that comply with the recommended dimensions for Queen size beds.

Your Bellemave Queen Over Queen Bunk Bed ships in two separate boxes. Please ensure you have received both packages and all components are present before beginning assembly. The package should include:

- Upper Bed Frame Components
- Lower Bed Frame Components
- Bed Slats for Upper and Lower Beds
- Two Ladders
- Guardrails for Upper Bed
- Hardware Pack (screws, bolts, plastic stoppers, Allen wrench)
- Assembly Instructions Manual

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Bellemave Queen Over Queen Bunk Bed is designed to be straightforward. Follow these general steps, referring to the detailed instructions included in your package for specific diagrams and part numbers.

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully unpack all components from both boxes. Lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches. Identify each part using the provided parts list in your instruction manual.
2. **Assemble Lower Bed Frame:** Begin by assembling the main frame of the lower bed. Connect the side rails to the headboard and footboard using the provided hardware. Do not fully tighten screws until all parts are aligned.
3. **Install Lower Bed Slats:** Place the bed slats onto the lower bed frame. Secure them using the plastic stoppers and any additional hardware as instructed. Ensure slats are evenly spaced and firmly in place to prevent movement and noise.
4. **Assemble Upper Bed Frame:** Repeat the process for the upper bed frame, connecting the side rails to the headboard and footboard.
5. **Attach Guardrails:** Securely attach the full-length guardrails to the upper bed frame as per the instructions.
6. **Mount Ladders:** Attach the two wide side ladders to the designated points on the bunk bed frame. Ensure they are firmly secured and stable for safe climbing.
7. **Connect Upper and Lower Beds:** Carefully lift and position the assembled upper bed frame onto the lower bed frame. Securely connect the two sections using the specified bolts and connectors. This step may require two people.
8. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are assembled and aligned, go back and fully tighten all screws and bolts. Do not overtighten.

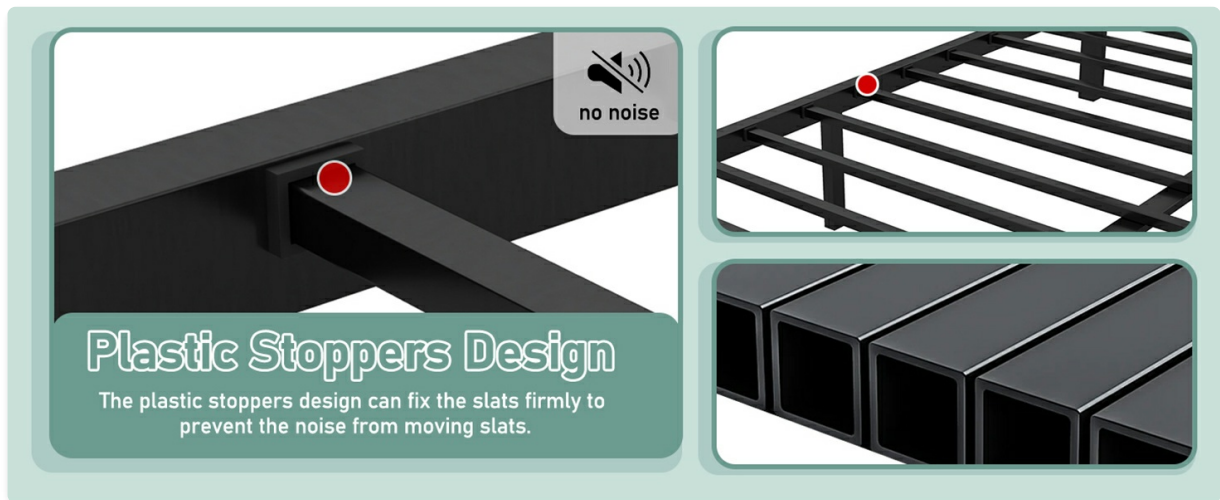


Image: Close-up view of the plastic stoppers designed to secure slats and prevent noise.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To ensure safe and proper use of your Bellemave Bunk Bed:

- **Weight Capacity:** Adhere to the maximum weight capacity for each bunk as specified in the product manual. Overloading can compromise structural integrity and safety.
- **Ladder Use:** Always use the provided ladders for climbing to and from the top bunk. Face the ladder when ascending or descending. Ensure the ladder is stable before use.
- **Guardrails:** The top bunk is equipped with full-length guardrails for safety. Do not remove or modify these guardrails. Ensure mattresses used on the top bunk are not so thick that they reduce the effective height of the guardrails.
- **Mattress Placement:** Place mattresses securely on the slat bases. Ensure they fit snugly within the frame to prevent shifting.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life and ensure the safety of your bunk bed:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the metal frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) inspect all bolts, screws, and connections. Tighten any that have become loose. Do not overtighten.
- **Slat Inspection:** Ensure all plastic slat stoppers are in place and the slats are not damaged or bent. Replace any damaged slats immediately.
- **Stability Check:** Gently shake the bed to check for any wobbling or instability. If detected, re-check all connections.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

- **Bed is Wobbly:**
Solution: Ensure all bolts and screws are fully tightened. Check that the bed is placed on a level surface. If the issue persists, disassemble and reassemble, paying close attention to each connection.
- **Squeaking Noise:**
Solution: The bed is designed with plastic stoppers to minimize noise. Check that all plastic stoppers are correctly installed and securing the slats. Tighten any loose connections on the frame.
- **Missing Parts:**
Solution: Verify that both shipping boxes have arrived. Compare the received parts with the parts list in your manual. If parts are still missing, contact customer support with your model number and a description of the missing parts.
- **Difficulty Assembling:**
Solution: Review the assembly instructions carefully, paying attention to diagrams. Ensure you are using the correct hardware for each step. Do not force parts together. If needed, seek assistance from another person.
