INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides detailed guidance for the installation, maintenance, and replacement of components in the MUSM 13-piece maintenance kit, compatible with Rovus robot vacuum cleaners. Regular replacement of these parts is crucial for maintaining optimal cleaning performance and extending the lifespan of your robot vacuum.

Kit Contents

The 13-piece maintenance kit includes the following components:

- Main Roller Brush
- Side Brushes
- HEPA Filters
- Mop Cloths

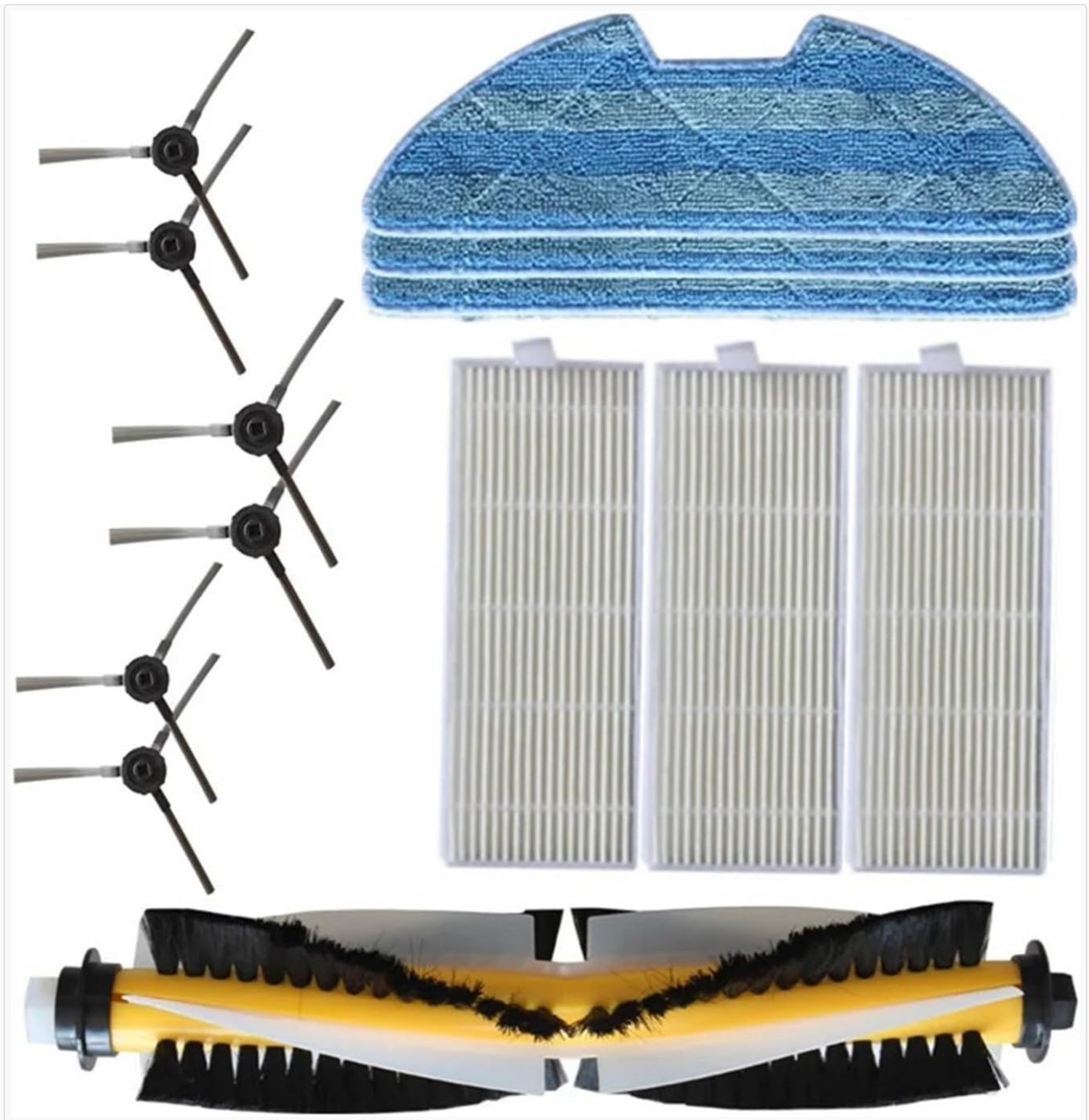


Image: Overview of the 13-piece MUSM maintenance kit, including all replacement parts.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to correctly install the replacement parts into your Rovus robot vacuum cleaner. Ensure the vacuum is powered off and unplugged before beginning any installation or maintenance.

1. Main Roller Brush Installation

1. Turn the robot vacuum cleaner upside down.
2. Locate the brush guard cover, usually secured by clips or screws. Open or remove it.
3. Carefully remove the old main roller brush. Clean any debris from the brush compartment.
4. Insert the new main roller brush, ensuring the ends align with the slots in the vacuum.
5. Close or reattach the brush guard cover securely.

2. Side Brush Installation

1. Turn the robot vacuum cleaner upside down.
2. Locate the side brushes. They are typically held in place by a single screw.
3. Unscrew and remove the old side brush.
4. Place the new side brush into position, aligning the screw hole.
5. Secure the new side brush with the screw. Repeat for all side brushes.

3. HEPA Filter Installation

1. Open the dustbin compartment of your robot vacuum cleaner.
2. Remove the dustbin.
3. Locate the filter housing within the dustbin. Remove the old HEPA filter.
4. Insert the new HEPA filter into the filter housing, ensuring it fits snugly.
5. Close the dustbin and reinsert it into the vacuum cleaner.

4. Mop Cloth Installation

1. Locate the mop cloth attachment on your robot vacuum cleaner. This may be a separate water tank or a dedicated mop plate.
2. Remove the old mop cloth, if present.
3. Attach the new mop cloth to the designated area, typically using Velcro or a sliding mechanism. Ensure it is securely fastened.
4. If applicable, fill the water tank before reattaching the mop module to the vacuum.

OPERATING GUIDELINES

Once the replacement parts are installed, your Rovus robot vacuum cleaner is ready for operation. These parts are designed to work seamlessly with your device to provide efficient cleaning.

- Ensure all parts are correctly installed before starting a cleaning cycle.

- For optimal mopping results, ensure the mop cloth is clean and adequately moistened (if using a wet mop function).
- Monitor the vacuum's performance after replacing parts to confirm proper function.

MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and timely replacement of these components are essential for maintaining your robot vacuum's suction power and overall cleaning efficiency.

Cleaning Frequency

- **Main Roller Brush:** Clean weekly, or more frequently if pets are present, to remove tangled hair and debris.
- **Side Brushes:** Inspect weekly for tangled hair and debris. Clean as needed.
- **HEPA Filters:** Tap gently to remove dust weekly. Do not wash with water unless specified by your vacuum's manual.
- **Mop Cloths:** Wash after each use to prevent odor and maintain cleaning effectiveness.

Replacement Schedule

The lifespan of each component can vary based on usage and environment. General recommendations are:

- **Main Roller Brush:** Replace every 6-12 months.
- **Side Brushes:** Replace every 3-6 months, or when visibly worn or bent.
- **HEPA Filters:** Replace every 2-3 months.
- **Mop Cloths:** Replace every 1-3 months, or when they show signs of wear or reduced cleaning ability.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues after replacing parts, consider the following common solutions:

- **Reduced Suction Power:**
Check if the HEPA filter is clogged. Ensure the dustbin is empty and properly seated. Verify the main roller brush is free of obstructions.
- **Poor Cleaning Performance:**
Inspect main and side brushes for wear or entanglement. Ensure mop cloths are clean and correctly attached.
- **Unusual Noise:**
Check the main roller brush for foreign objects or hair. Ensure all parts are securely installed and not loose.
- **Side Brushes Not Spinning:**
Ensure they are correctly screwed in and free from hair or debris that might impede rotation.
