## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides detailed instructions for the DUDUPET Automatic Cat Feeder with Water, Model F13. This 2-in-1 smart pet feeder and water dispenser is designed to automate your pet's feeding and hydration needs, offering convenience and ensuring a balanced diet. It features a 4L food storage capacity, a 3L water tank, 5G/2.4G WiFi connectivity for app control, voice recording, and precise portion control. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper setup and operation.

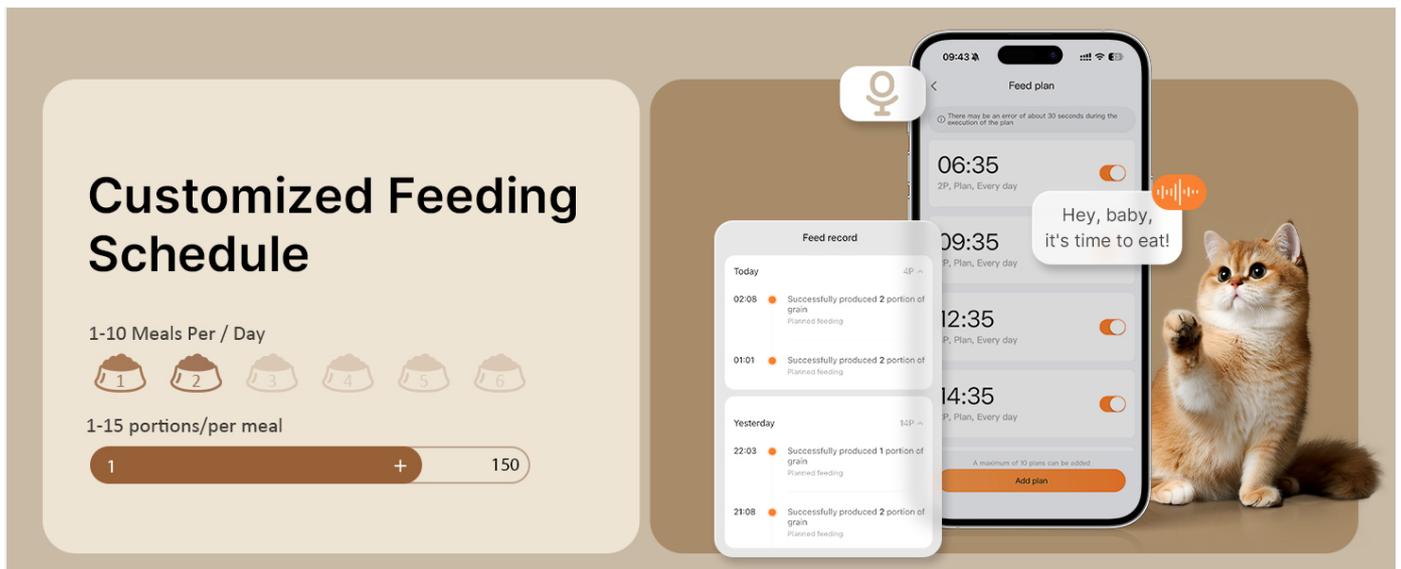

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 1. Placement and Power Supply

Place the feeder on a flat, stable surface indoors, away from direct sunlight or heat sources.

- Connect the power adapter to the feeder and plug it into a wall outlet.
- For uninterrupted operation during power outages, install 3 D-cell batteries (not included) into the battery compartment at the bottom of the unit. Note that remote control features are not available in battery-only mode, but scheduled feedings will continue.

## 2. App Installation and WiFi Connection

Download the DUDUPET app from your smartphone's app store (iOS or Android).



# App Remote Control Feeding

You can feed your pets through the App anytime and anywhere

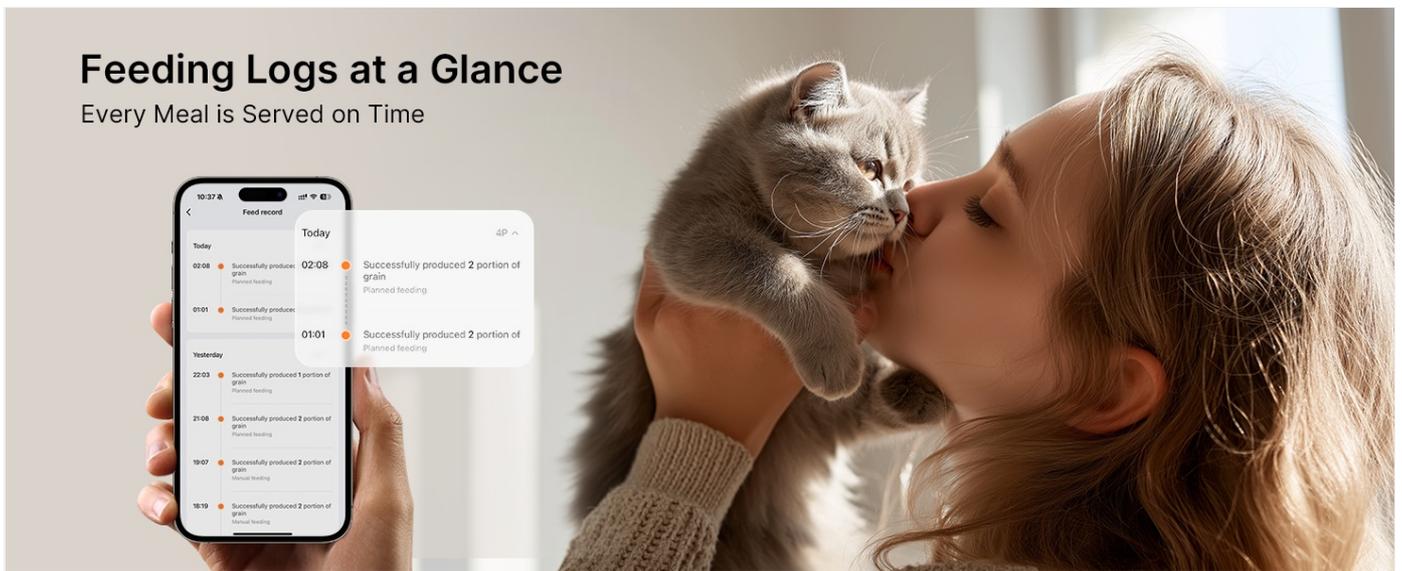

1. Open the app and create an account or log in.
2. Follow the in-app instructions to add your DUDUPET feeder. Ensure your phone is connected to a 2.4GHz or 5GHz WiFi network during the pairing process.
3. The feeder will connect to your home WiFi, enabling remote control and monitoring.

Every Meal is Served on Time

- **Food:** Open the lid of the food storage compartment. Pour dry pet food into the 4L container. Ensure the food kibble size is appropriate (up to 0.55 inches / 14mm in diameter) to prevent clogging. Close the lid securely to maintain freshness.
- **Water:** Remove the water tank from the base. Fill the 3L tank with clean water. Ensure the water filter is properly installed in the tank. Reattach the water tank to the base, ensuring it is seated correctly for the gravity siphon system to function.

## 4. Desiccant Installation

# Offreshness Protection

Silicone ring and built-in desiccant help keep the food fresh and crunchy.

Fold Down the

Note: The silicone ring is flexible and may loosen. If it becomes loose or comes off, reposition it as shown.

The feeder includes a built-in desiccant box to keep food fresh and crispy. If not already installed, place the desiccant bag into its designated compartment under the lid. Ensure the 360° sealed silicone ring is properly positioned around the lid for optimal freshness. Replace the desiccant bag periodically (e.g., monthly) for best results.

To dispense food immediately outside of the scheduled times, use the manual feed option available in the DUDUPET app. This allows you to provide an extra meal or snack as needed.

## MAINTENANCE

---

### 1. Cleaning the Feeder and Water Dispenser

# Easy to Clean

Provide a clean feeding environment for your pet

- **Food Feeder:** The food storage tank and dispensing components are hand-wash only. Separate the tank from the base, rinse with cold water, and dry thoroughly before reassembling. **Do not submerge the main base unit in water or place it in a dishwasher.**
- **Water Dispenser:** The water tank can be separated and rinsed with cold water.
- **Stainless Steel Bowls:** The two included stainless steel bowls are dishwasher-safe for easy cleaning.
- Regular cleaning ensures a hygienic feeding environment for your pet.

## 2. Water Filter Replacement

The water dispenser includes a filter to improve water quality. Replace the filter regularly (e.g., every 2-4 weeks, depending on water quality and usage) to ensure optimal filtration. Replacement filters can be purchased separately.

## 1. Food Dispensing Issues

# Smart Anti-stuck Algorithm

Designed with Smart Infrared Detection monitor the status of food dispensing, ensure your pet is fed properly

- **Clogging:** Ensure the kibble size does not exceed 0.55 inches (14mm). Larger kibble or wet food can cause blockages. The feeder has a smart infrared detection system to monitor dispensing and alert you to abnormal conditions.
- **No Food Dispensed:** Check if the food hopper is empty. Verify that the feeder is powered on and connected to WiFi. Check the app for any error notifications (e.g., "Dispensing Error").
- **Incorrect Portions:** Review your feeding schedule settings in the app to ensure the correct portion sizes are programmed.

## 2. WiFi Connection Problems

- **Unable to Connect:** Ensure your home WiFi network is 2.4GHz or 5GHz. Check your router and internet connection. Try restarting the feeder and your router.
- **App Not Responding:** Close and reopen the DUDUPET app. Ensure your smartphone has a stable internet

connection.

### 3. Power Issues

- **Feeder Not Turning On:** Verify the power adapter is securely plugged into both the feeder and a working wall outlet. If using batteries, ensure they are correctly installed and not depleted.
- **Scheduled Feedings Not Working in Battery Mode:** Remote app control is not available in battery-only mode, but scheduled feedings will continue. If scheduled feedings are not occurring, check battery levels.

- Do not immerse the main base unit in water.
- Ensure the power cord is not chewed by pets.
