1. INTRODUCTION

- **Replacement:** The filter plate is a durable component, but if it becomes cracked, warped, or severely discolored, it should be replaced to maintain microwave efficiency and safety.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Filter plate does not fit.	Incorrect model number or incompatible design.	Verify the filter plate model number (9524285454828) against your microwave oven's requirements. Ensure it is designed for your specific microwave model.
Filter plate is loose after installation.	Improper installation; clips/screws not fully engaged.	Re-check installation steps. Ensure clips are fully engaged or screws are tightened securely (without overtightening).
Microwave performance seems reduced after installation.	Filter plate is dirty or improperly installed, obstructing airflow.	Clean the filter plate if dirty. Re-install the plate, ensuring it is seated correctly and not obstructing any vents. If the issue persists, consult a qualified technician.
