1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your EUHOMY 01205A Series Ice Maker. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the appliance and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury. Ensure the appliance is properly grounded. Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug. Keep children away from the appliance. Do not open the lid during the ice-making process.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper setup is crucial for optimal performance and longevity of your ice maker.

3.1 Unboxing and Placement

- Remove all packaging materials and accessories from the unit.
- Place the ice maker upright in its desired location. It is essential for the unit to stand upright for at least 24 hours before connecting to power for the first time. This allows the refrigerant to settle.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit.

3.2 Water Connection

Connect the water tap and filter according to the manual's instructions. Ensure all connections are secure to prevent leaks.

3.3 Initial Cleaning

Before first use, clean the inside walls of the water box and ice mold with a mild detergent. Replace the filter element as instructed.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Familiarize yourself with the control panel for efficient ice production.

4.1 Control Panel Overview

The control panel features indicators for ice making, reservation, add water, ice full, melting, stoppage, and clean. It also includes ON/OFF, plus (+), and minus (-) buttons for various settings.

4.2 Ice Making Process

1. Press the **ON/OFF** button to start the ice making process. The "ice making" indicator will illuminate.
2. The unit produces approximately 120 lbs of ice per day. Each ice-making cycle lasts between 1 to 30 minutes, producing 40 pieces (5x8) of ice per cycle, depending on ambient and water temperatures.
3. **Important:** Do not open the lid during the ice-making process.

4.3 Adjusting Ice Thickness

To change the thickness of the ice cubes, use the +/- buttons on the control panel. Adjusting the time setting will alter the ice thickness.

4.4 Forced Ice Harvest

If the unit is currently making ice and you need to force an ice harvest, press the **"Reservation/Clean"** button (labeled "HOT" in some models) for more than 5 seconds. The unit will switch to the ice harvest process by force.

4.5 Reservation Mode

To activate the reservation mode, short press the **"Reservation/Clean"** button. Use the +/- buttons to set the desired reservation time.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance ensure the longevity and hygiene of your ice maker.

5.1 Cleaning Mode

To activate the cleaning mode, long press the **"Reservation/Clean"** button (labeled "Clean" in some models). The "clean" indicator will illuminate, and the unit will begin its cleaning cycle.

5.2 Routine Cleaning

- Clean the water tank once per month.

- Clean the condenser once every three months.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ice maker, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Ice Production:** Check water supply, ensure the unit is powered on, and verify no error indicators are lit (e.g., "No Water").
- **Ice Full Indicator On, but Bin Not Full:** The sensor might be obstructed or require cleaning.
- **Water Leakage:** Check all water connections and drain hose for proper installation and tightness.
- **Unusual Noise:** Ensure the unit is on a stable, level surface. Check for any obstructions in the fan or ice-making mechanism.
- **Poor Ice Quality:** Adjust ice thickness settings. Ensure the water filter is clean and replaced regularly.
