Safety Information

- Keep all electrical outlets dry and away from liquids.

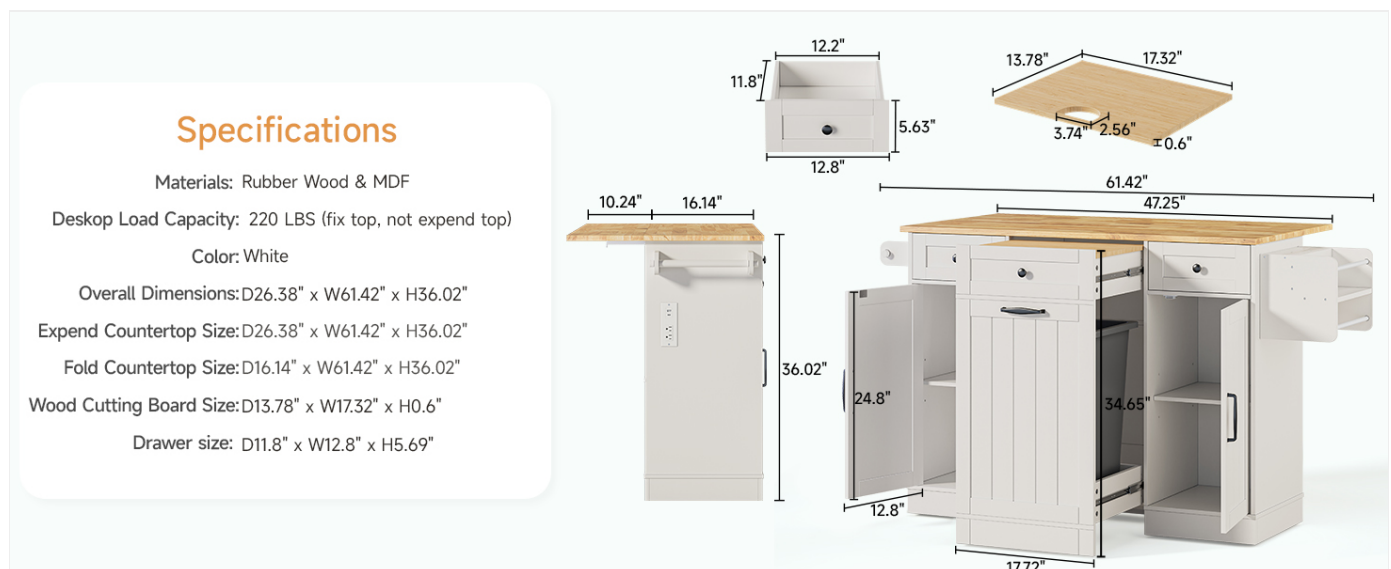

Operating Instructions

Movable Wood Cutting Board & Hidden Trash Bin

The movable wood cutting board is designed for convenient food preparation. During meal prep, peels and vegetable scraps can be effortlessly swept through the integrated opening directly into the hidden trash bin located below. This design helps maintain a clean workspace. After use, the cutting board can be easily removed and rinsed clean under running water.

Solid Wood Drop Leaf Countertop

The solid wood drop leaf countertop provides an expandable surface for dining or additional workspace. It can extend from its regular 16.14 inches to 26.38 inches when needed. When not in use, it can be easily folded away to free up more space in your kitchen. Ensure the metal brackets are properly engaged when extended for stability.

The drop leaf countertop design supported by 2 metal brackets is more stable

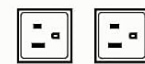


Image: The drop leaf countertop shown in both its folded and extended positions, highlighting its space-saving design.

Multipurpose Power Outlet

The kitchen island is equipped with a multipurpose power outlet featuring dual 3-hole sockets, a Type-C port, and a USB port. This 1500W high-load power system allows you to simultaneously power kitchen appliances such as coffee makers, microwaves, or toasters, and fast-charge multiple devices like phones and tablets. Always ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a wall outlet.

Maintenance

Proper maintenance will ensure the longevity and appearance of your ONBRILL Kitchen Island.

- **General Cleaning:** Regularly wipe all surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Wood Cutting Board:** Clean the movable wood cutting board thoroughly after each use. To maintain its condition and prevent drying or cracking, apply food-grade mineral oil periodically.
- **Electrical Outlets:** Ensure the power outlet area is kept dry and free from liquid spills. Disconnect from power before cleaning the outlet area.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Retighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Missing or Damaged Parts	Shipping damage or packaging error.	Contact ONBRILL customer support immediately with your purchase details.
Drop Leaf is Stiff or Won't Fold/Extend	Obstruction in the mechanism or misaligned brackets.	Check for any objects blocking the movement. Ensure the metal support brackets are correctly aligned and engaged.
Power Outlet Not Working	Not plugged into a wall outlet, circuit breaker tripped, or internal wiring issue.	Verify the island's power cord is securely plugged into a functional wall outlet. Check your home's circuit breaker. If the issue persists, contact a qualified electrician or customer support.
Island Wheels Don't Lock (if applicable)	Locking mechanism not engaged or faulty.	Ensure the wheel locks are fully pressed down. If the wheels are designed without locks, the island will not be stationary.
