SAFETY INFORMATION

Important Safety Precautions:

- Always assemble this product on a flat, stable surface.
- Secure the gazebo to a stable foundation to prevent tipping.
- Keep children and pets away from the gazebo during assembly and disassembly.
- Do not use the gazebo in windy conditions or during severe weather.
- Ensure all connections are tight and secure before and after each use.
- Regularly inspect the gazebo for any signs of wear or damage.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

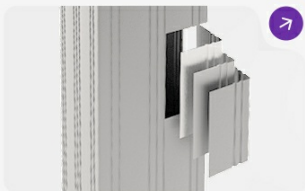
Assembly of this gazebo requires at least two adults. Follow the step-by-step instructions in the dedicated assembly manual provided with your product. Ensure you have adequate space and all necessary tools before starting.

Key Assembly Considerations:




- **Frame Construction:** The gazebo features a sturdy, powder-coated aluminum frame. Assemble the frame components according to the numerical and alphabetical labels.
- **Post Stability:** The 4.7" x 4.7" thick posts provide enhanced stability. Ensure they are correctly oriented and securely fastened.
- **Roof Installation:** The double galvanized steel roof panels are designed for durability. Pay close attention to the alignment and sealing of each panel to ensure waterproof performance.
- **Water Gutter System:** The integrated water gutter design directs rainwater efficiently through the four corners, preventing accumulation and protecting curtains.
- **Secure Fastening:** Utilize the provided stainless steel screws for all connections to resist corrosion and ensure long-term stability. The pre-drilled base allows for secure anchoring to your patio or lawn.

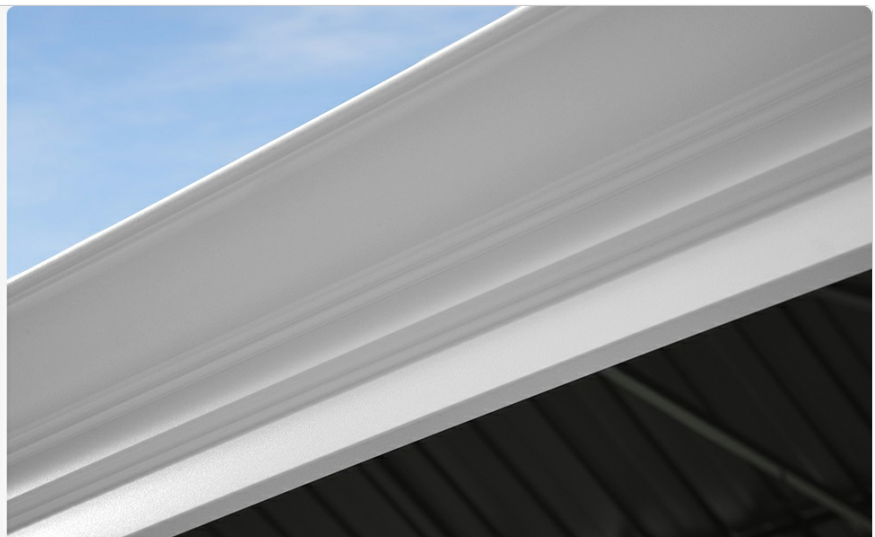

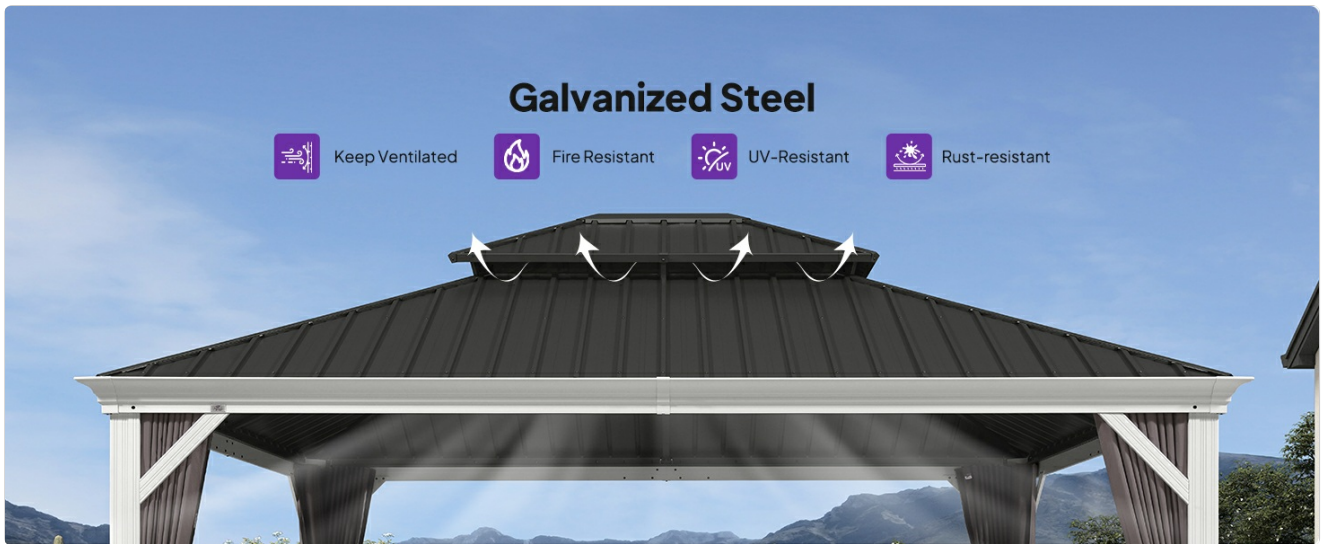


Image: Detail showing the stainless steel screws used for assembly, emphasizing their corrosion resistance compared to ordinary iron screws.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Curtains and Mesh Screens:

The gazebo includes 160g/sqm PU fire-retardant curtains and 260 GSM Textilene mesh screens. These can be adjusted to provide shade, privacy, or insect protection.

- **Fully Open:** Tie back the curtains and mesh screens to enjoy an unobstructed outdoor space.
- **Semi-Open:** Use the mesh screens to maintain ventilation while keeping insects out.
- **Fully Closed:** Close the curtains for maximum privacy and sun protection.
- **Removal:** Curtains can be removed for cleaning or storage as needed.

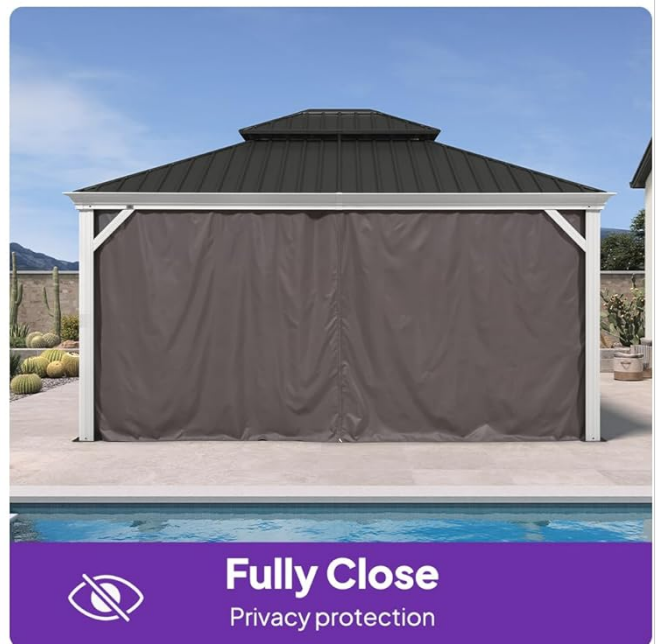
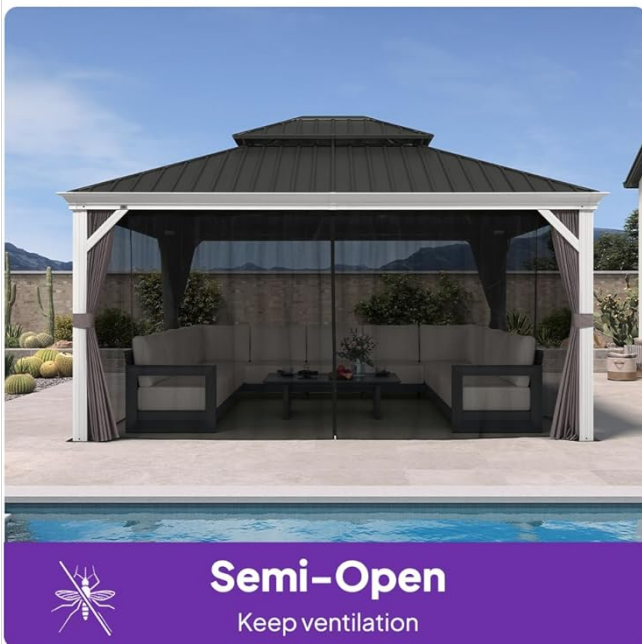
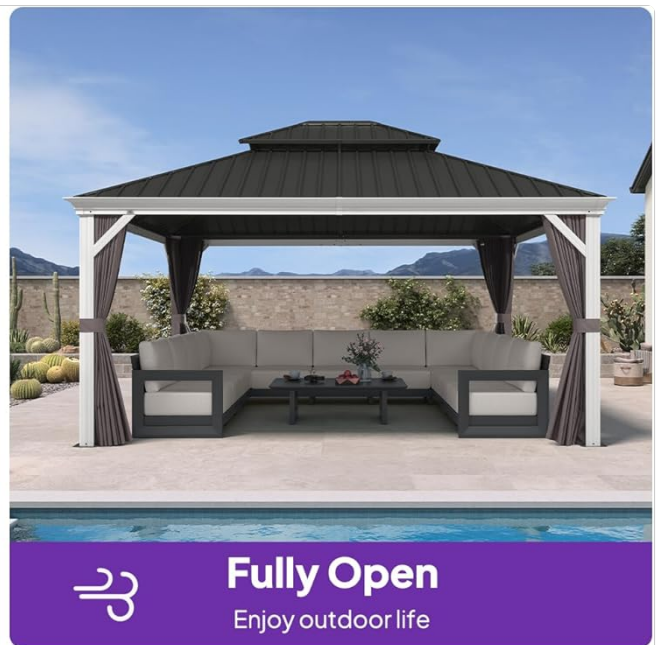
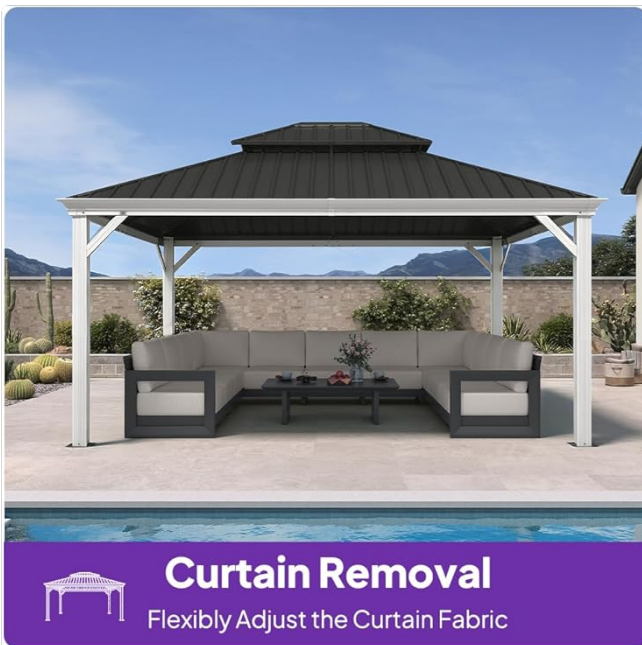

Ventilation:

The double-layer roof design promotes improved airflow, helping to dissipate heat and maintain a comfortable environment within the gazebo.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your gazebo.

- **Cleaning the Frame:** Wipe the aluminum frame with a damp cloth and mild soap. Rinse thoroughly and dry. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- **Cleaning the Roof:** The galvanized steel roof can be cleaned with water and a soft brush to remove debris. Ensure the water gutter system is clear of leaves and other blockages.
- **Curtain and Mesh Care:** The yarn-dyed fabric curtains are fade-resistant and water-repellent. Clean them with mild soap and water. Allow them to air dry completely before folding or storing. The Textilene netting is thick and durable; clean as needed with a damp cloth.

- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all screws and bolts to ensure they remain tight. Tighten any loose fasteners to maintain structural integrity.
- **Winter Storage:** In areas with heavy snow, it is recommended to remove roof panels or clear snow accumulation regularly to prevent structural damage. Store curtains and mesh indoors during harsh winter conditions.

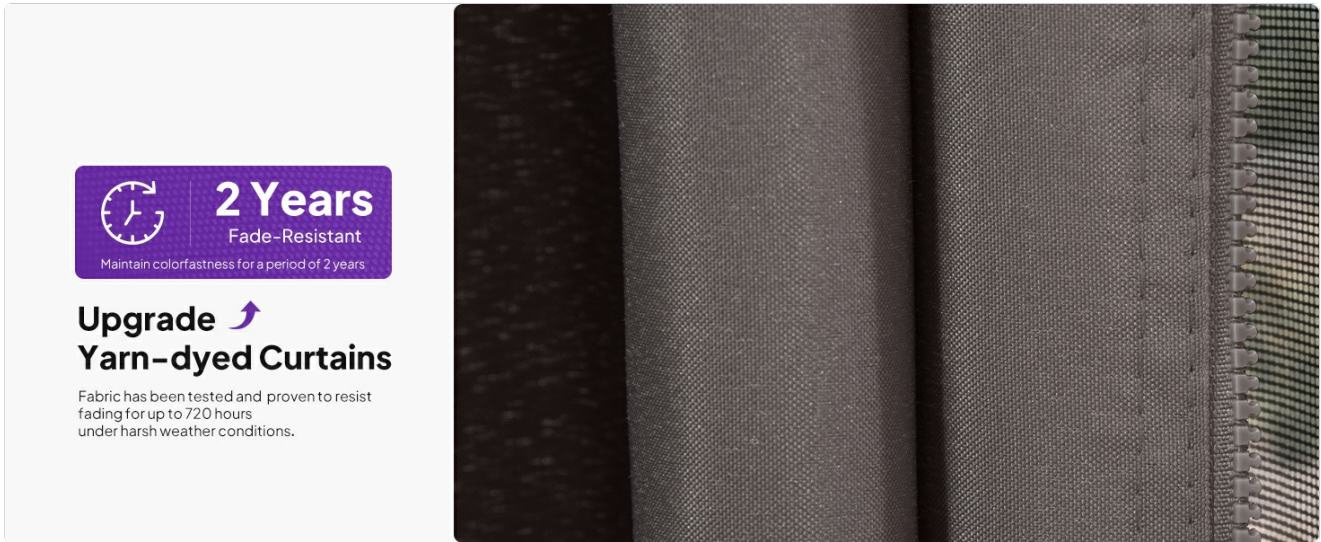

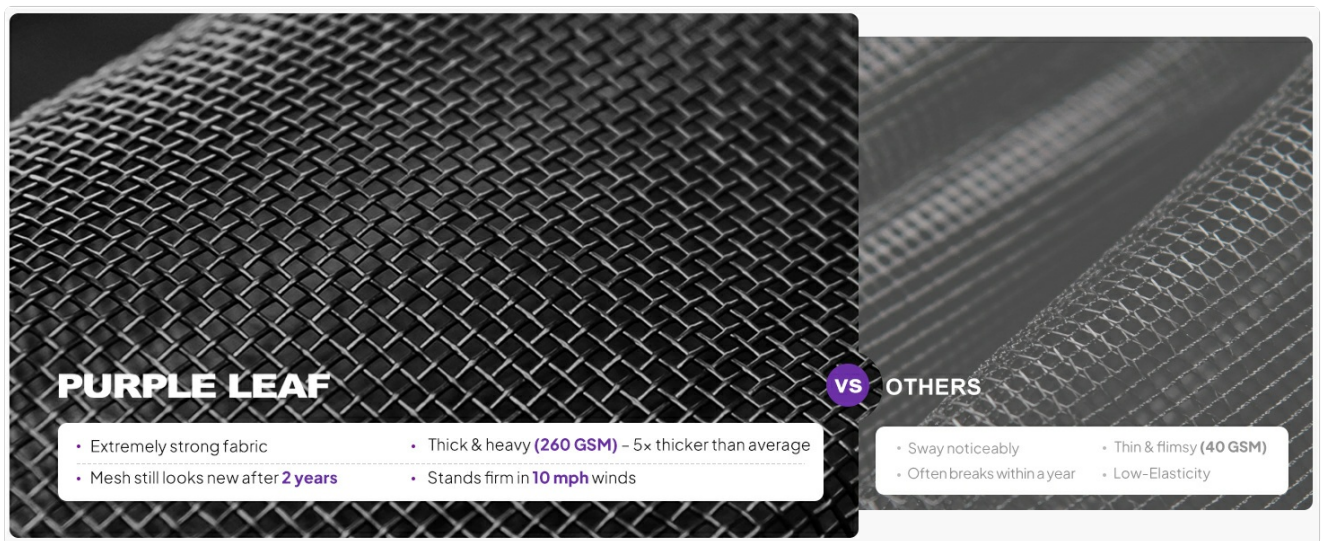

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water leakage from roof	Improperly installed roof panels; loose screws; clogged gutters.	Ensure roof panels are correctly overlapped and sealed. Tighten all roof screws. Clear debris from the water gutter system.
Gazebo feels unstable	Loose frame connections; not anchored to the ground.	Check and tighten all frame bolts and screws. Ensure the gazebo is securely anchored to a stable foundation using appropriate hardware.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Curtains/mesh not moving smoothly	Track obstruction; damaged runners.	Inspect tracks for debris and clean. Check curtain runners for damage and replace if necessary.

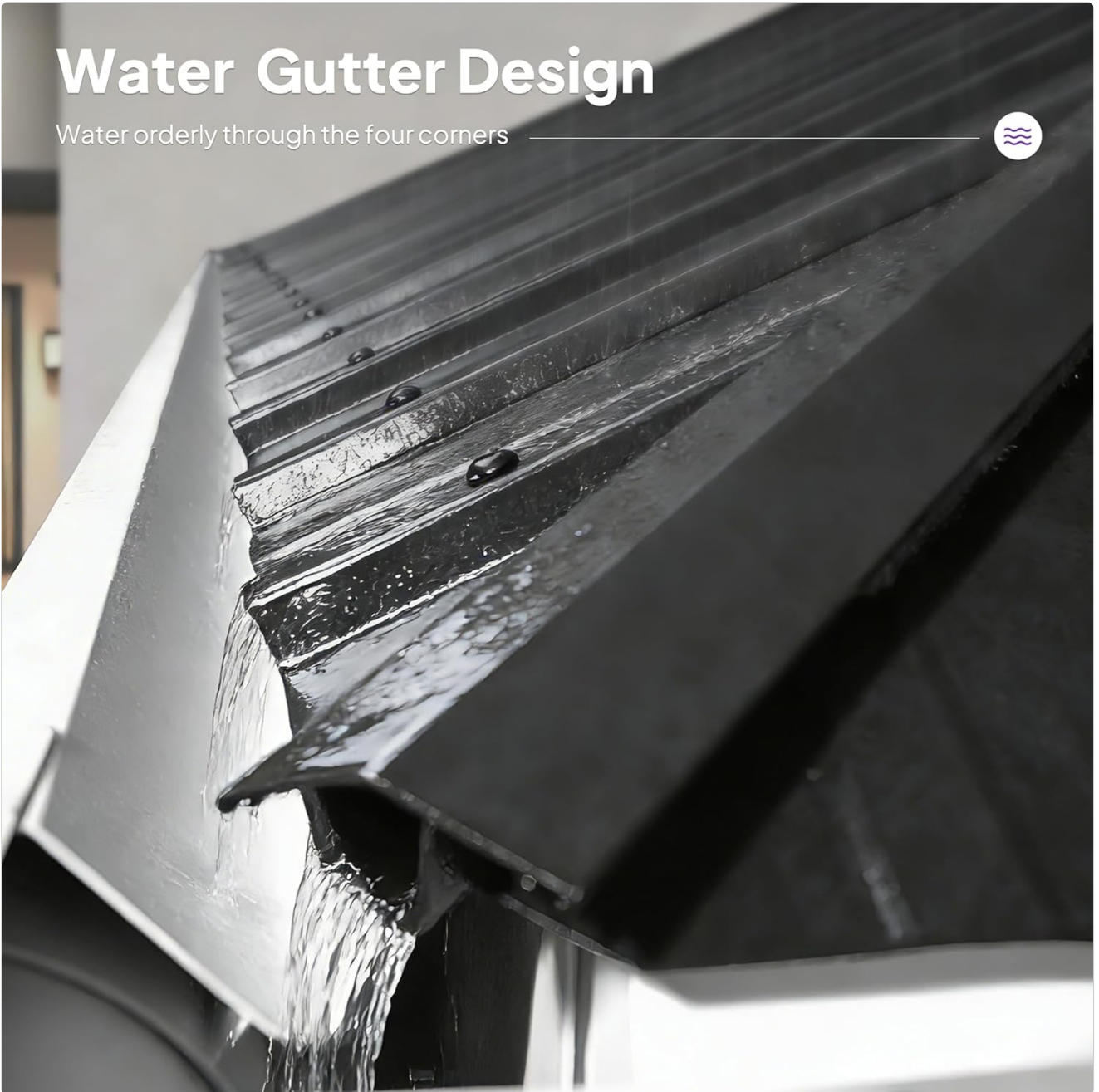


Image: Technical drawing illustrating the dimensions of the 13' x 15' gazebo, including height, length, and width measurements for the frame and roof.
