## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Giantex 3-in-1 Folding Dining Table is required. Please follow the included Assembly Guide carefully. It is recommended to have two people for assembly due to the item's weight and size. Ensure you have an Allen Key and a Screwdriver available.

### Folding Mechanism

The table features a 3-in-1 design, allowing it to transition between three states: fully expanded, half-expanded, and fully folded. This is achieved using high-quality panel control pins.

- 1. Fully Expanded:** Extend both drop leaves outwards. Secure them in place using the panel control pins located underneath the tabletop. This configuration provides a large dining surface for 4-6 people.

2. **Half-Expanded:** Extend one drop leaf outwards and secure it with its panel control pin. Keep the other drop leaf folded down. This configuration is suitable for use as a computer desk or a smaller dining area.
3. **Fully Folded:** Fold both drop leaves downwards. Ensure they are securely tucked against the central unit. In this compact state, the table functions as a console table and occupies minimal space.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Utilizing Storage Space

The table includes two large drawers and two single-door cabinets, offering organized storage for various items.

- **Drawers:** Pull the integrated handles to open the drawers. These are suitable for smaller items like utensils, stationery, or napkins.
- **Cabinets:** Open the cabinet doors to access the interior storage. These compartments can hold larger items such as bottles, canned goods, or other kitchen supplies.

### Mobility and Stability

The table is equipped with six universal casters for easy movement. Two of these wheels are lockable to ensure stability when the table is in use.

- **Moving the Table:** To move the table, ensure both lockable wheels are in the unlocked position. Gently push or pull the table to its desired location.
- **Securing the Table:** Once the table is in position, engage the locks on the two designated wheels. This will prevent the table from moving unintentionally during use.

## MAINTENANCE

---

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the table surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these may damage the finish.
- **Spills:** Clean up spills immediately to prevent staining or damage to the wood finish.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Tighten if necessary to maintain stability.
- **Wheels:** Keep the casters free of debris to ensure smooth movement. Lubricate if necessary.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Table feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose fasteners or uneven floor.	Check and tighten all assembly screws. Ensure the table is on a level surface. Engage wheel locks.
Drop leaves do not stay in position.	Panel control pins not engaged or damaged.	Ensure the panel control pins are fully extended and locked into place. Inspect pins for damage.
Drawers are difficult to open/close.	Overloaded, debris in tracks, or misaligned.	Reduce drawer contents. Clear any debris from the drawer slides. Check for proper alignment during assembly.
Wheels do not roll smoothly or lock.	Debris in wheels or lock mechanism.	Clean wheels and lock mechanisms. Ensure no hair or carpet fibers are obstructing movement.
