INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Electactic 3-Burner Propane Gas Grill, Model JD-3F-01. Designed for outdoor cooking, this grill features three stainless steel burners, a 24,000 BTU output, a spacious 485 sq. in. cooking surface, and convenient foldable side shelves. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the grill for the first time and retain it for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: For outdoor use only. Do not store or use gasoline or other flammable vapors and liquids in the vicinity of this or any other appliance. An LP cylinder not connected for use shall not be stored in the vicinity of this or any other appliance.

- Always operate the grill on a level, non-combustible surface.
- Maintain a minimum distance of 3 feet (1 meter) from combustible materials.

- Never leave a lit grill unattended.
- Keep children and pets away from the grill at all times.
- Ensure proper ventilation.
- Check for gas leaks regularly using a soapy water solution.
- Do not attempt to repair the grill yourself. Contact qualified service personnel.
- Always turn off the gas supply at the cylinder after each use.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND FEATURES

The Electactic 3-Burner Propane Gas Grill is designed for efficient and enjoyable outdoor cooking. Key features include:

- **Powerful Performance:** Three stainless steel burners deliver a total of 24,000 BTU for precise temperature control and even heat distribution.
- **Durable Construction:** Crafted from corrosion-resistant stainless steel for longevity and resistance to outdoor elements.
- **Spacious Cooking Area:** A total of 485 sq. in. grilling space, including a porcelain-enameled main grate and a warming rack.
- **Foldable Side Shelves:** Collapsible side shelves provide convenience for food preparation and compact storage.
- **Easy Mobility:** Equipped with heavy-duty wheels for effortless transport.
- **Integrated Thermometer:** Lid-mounted thermometer for monitoring internal grill temperature.
- **Easy Cleanup:** Features a pull-out drip tray for simplified grease management.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of your Electactic Propane Gas Grill requires careful attention to detail. Please follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the separate assembly guide included with your product packaging. Ensure all components are present and undamaged before beginning assembly.

Key Assembly Steps:

1. Unpack all components and verify against the parts list.
2. Assemble the grill cart and attach the heavy-duty wheels.
3. Mount the main grill body onto the cart.
4. Connect the gas hose and regulator to the propane tank (not included).
5. Attach the foldable side shelves.
6. Perform a leak test on all gas connections using a soapy water solution before first use.

Important: The igniter may be located underneath the burner assembly. Refer to the detailed diagrams in your assembly guide for precise location and connection.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Lighting the Grill:

1. Ensure the grill lid is open.

2. Turn all burner control knobs to the "OFF" position.
3. Open the valve on the propane cylinder slowly.
4. Push and turn one burner control knob to the "HIGH" position.
5. Press the electronic igniter button repeatedly until the burner ignites. You should hear a clicking sound and see a flame.
6. If the burner does not ignite within 5 seconds, turn the control knob to "OFF", wait 5 minutes for gas to dissipate, and repeat the process.
7. Once one burner is lit, you can ignite adjacent burners by turning their control knobs to "HIGH".

Temperature Control:

Each burner has an independent control knob, allowing you to adjust the heat for different cooking zones. Use the lid-mounted thermometer to monitor the internal temperature of the grill. For preheating, close the lid and allow the grill to reach the desired temperature, typically 10-15 minutes on high.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your grill and ensure optimal performance.

After Each Use:

- Turn off all burners and the gas supply at the cylinder.
- Allow the grill to cool completely.
- Brush cooking grates with a grill brush to remove food residue.
- Empty and clean the pull-out drip tray.

Periodic Cleaning:

- **Exterior Surfaces:** Wipe stainless steel surfaces with a soft cloth and a stainless steel cleaner. Avoid abrasive cleaners.

- **Cooking Grates:** For a deeper clean, remove the porcelain-enameled grates and wash with warm, soapy water.
- **Burners:** Inspect burner ports for blockages (e.g., spider webs, food debris). Clean with a wire brush or pipe cleaner if necessary.
- **Drip Tray:** Regularly remove and clean the drip tray to prevent grease buildup and potential flare-ups.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Burner fails to ignite	No gas flow, clogged burner port, faulty igniter.	Check propane tank valve, clear burner ports, check igniter battery/connection.
Low flame or uneven heat	Low gas pressure, clogged burner, regulator issue.	Ensure tank valve is fully open, clean burners, reset regulator (refer to gas grill safety guide).

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Flare-ups	Excess grease buildup, high heat.	Clean drip tray and cooking grates regularly, reduce heat, trim excess fat from food.
