1. INTRODUCTION

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps for proper assembly of your poultry cage. It is recommended to have at least two people for assembly.

1. **Prepare the Site:** Choose a level, clear area for the cage. Ensure adequate drainage and space around the structure for maintenance.
2. **Assemble the Frame:** Connect the galvanized steel pipes using the provided connectors. Utilize the spring plungers for secure connections. Refer to the diagram for correct pipe orientation.
3. **Install Reinforced Braces:** Attach the reinforced triangular braces at the corners and other designated points to enhance the frame's stability.
4. **Attach Enclosure Netting:** Securely attach the high-strength enclosure netting to the assembled frame. Ensure the netting is taut and covers all open sides to prevent escapes and predator intrusion.
5. **Install Access Door:** Assemble and install the lockable access door according to the instructions. Ensure it opens and closes smoothly and can be securely locked.
6. **Secure with Ground Stakes:** Drive the heavy-duty ground stakes firmly into the ground at the base of the frame to anchor the cage and provide exceptional durability and stability.
7. **Apply Waterproof Cover:** Drape and secure the waterproof and UV-resistant PE cover over the top section of the cage. Ensure it is properly fastened to shield the interior from sun, rain, and wind.

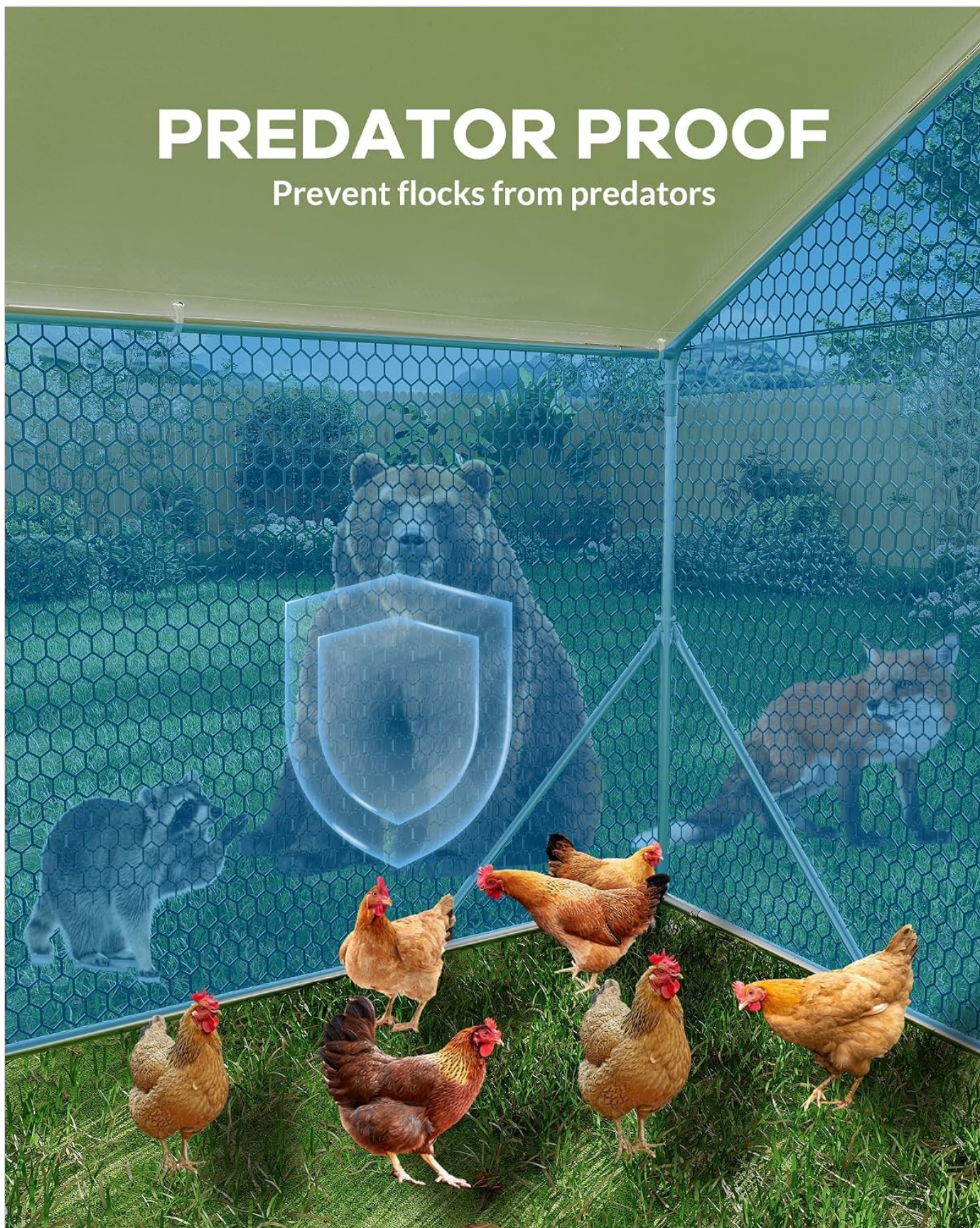

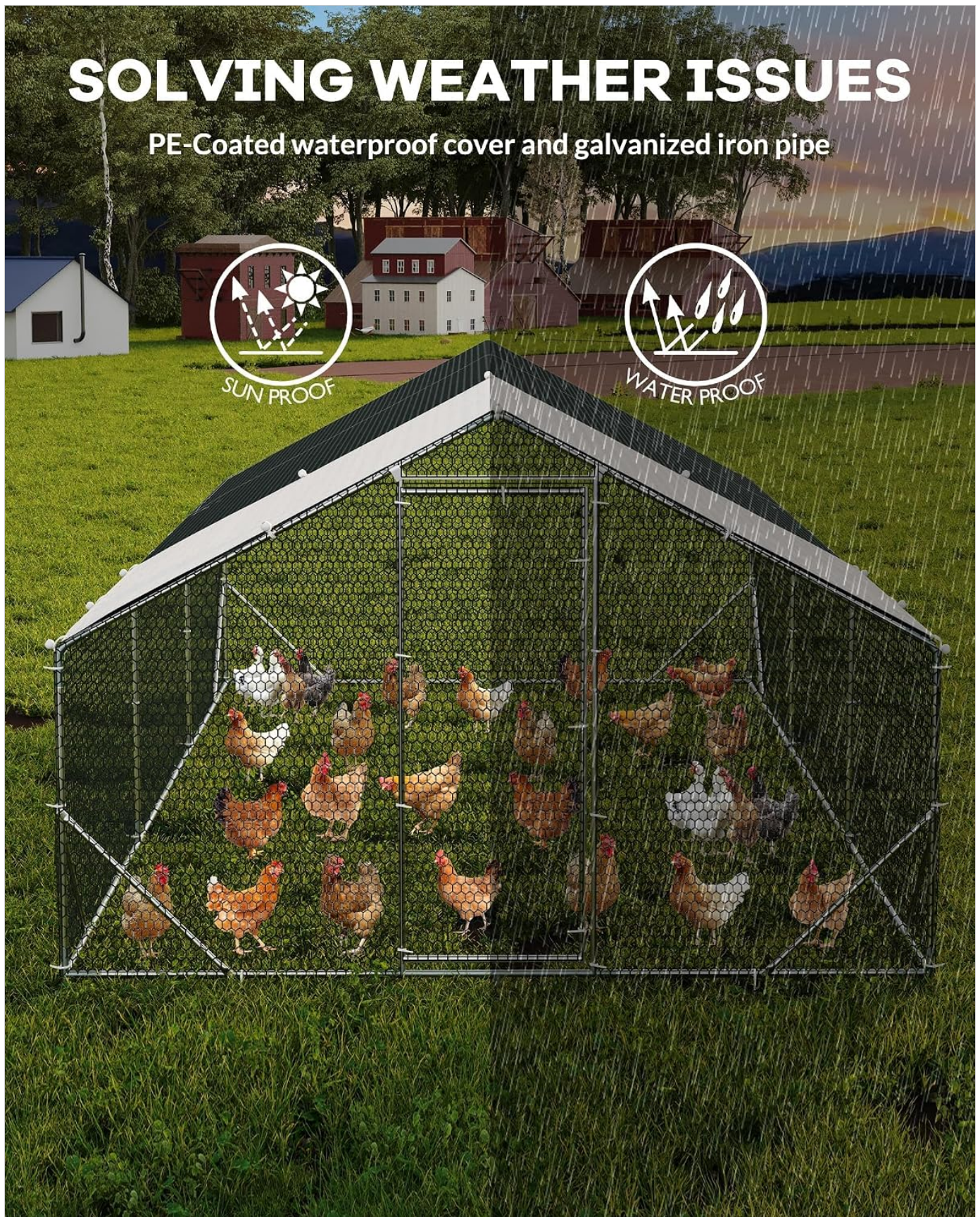
6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cover Care:** Examine the PE cover for rips or excessive wear. Clean the cover as needed. Ensure it remains securely fastened to provide continuous weather protection.
- **Ground Stakes:** Verify that ground stakes remain firmly in place, especially after strong winds or heavy rain. Re-secure if necessary.

SOLVING WEATHER ISSUES

PE-Coated waterproof cover and galvanized iron pipe

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Cage Feels Unstable:**

- Ensure all pipe connections are fully engaged and secured with spring plungers.
- Verify that all reinforced triangular braces are correctly installed.
- Check that ground stakes are driven deeply and firmly into the ground.
- **Netting is Loose or Sagging:**
 - Re-tension the netting and secure it more tightly to the frame using appropriate fasteners.
 - Inspect for any broken attachment points and repair them.
- **Water Accumulates on Cover:**
 - Ensure the PE cover is stretched taut and properly angled to allow water runoff.
 - Check for any sagging areas in the frame that might cause pooling.
- **Door Does Not Close/Lock Properly:**
 - Inspect the door hinges and latch mechanism for obstructions or damage.
 - Ensure the frame around the door opening is square and not warped.
- **Animals Escaping:**
 - Thoroughly inspect the entire enclosure for any gaps, holes, or unsecured sections in the netting or around the door.
 - Ensure the door is always securely locked.

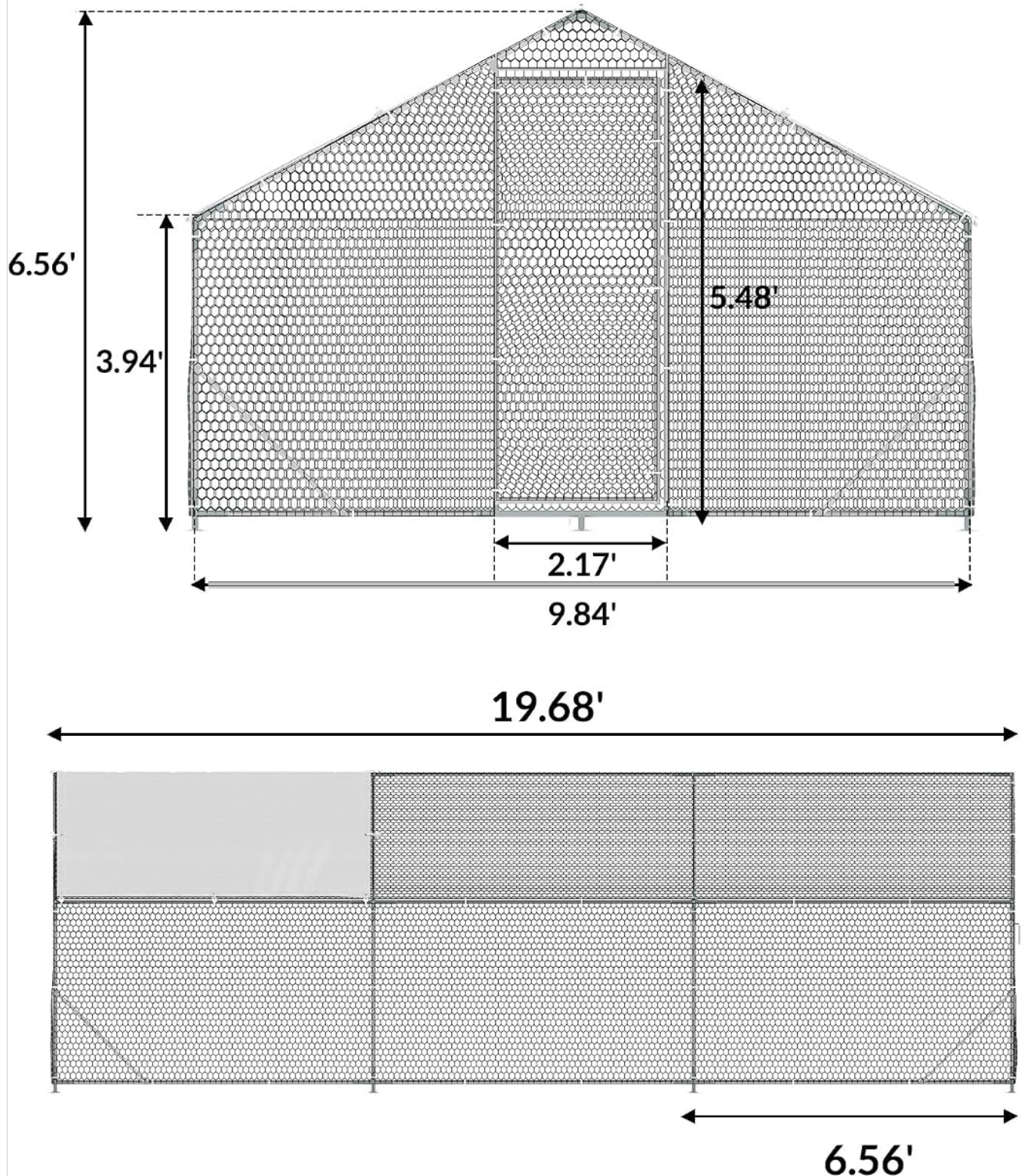
