INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the proper use and maintenance of the Generic Water Flosser Nozzles Replacement, specifically the 3-piece Orthodontic set. These nozzles are designed to enhance oral hygiene, particularly for individuals with braces or other orthodontic appliances, by effectively cleaning hard-to-reach areas.

COMPATIBILITY

These replacement nozzles are compatible with the following water flosser models:

- F400 Water Flosser
- F300 Water Flosser
- ME0701 Water Flosser
- ME0702 Water Flosser

Ensure your water flosser model matches one of the listed compatible devices for proper fit and function.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. **Preparation:** Ensure your water flosser unit is turned off and unplugged from the power source.
2. **Remove Old Nozzle (if applicable):** If replacing an existing nozzle, press the nozzle release button (if present on your flosser model) and gently pull the old nozzle straight up from the handle.
3. **Insert New Nozzle:** Select one of the orthodontic replacement nozzles. Insert the stem of the new nozzle into the opening on the water flosser handle. Push down firmly until it clicks into place. A click indicates a secure fit.
4. **Verify Connection:** Gently tug on the nozzle to ensure it is securely attached and does not wobble.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the nozzle is securely installed, you can operate your water flosser as usual. The orthodontic nozzle is specifically designed to navigate around braces, wires, and other dental work.

1. **Fill Reservoir:** Fill the water flosser reservoir with lukewarm water. You may add a small amount of mouthwash if desired.
2. **Select Pressure Setting:** Start with the lowest pressure setting and gradually increase to a comfortable level.
3. **Position Nozzle:** Lean over a sink. Place the nozzle tip at a 90-degree angle to your gumline. For orthodontic appliances, gently guide the tip around brackets and wires, allowing the water stream to flush out food particles and plaque.
4. **Begin Flossing:** Turn on the water flosser. Move the nozzle along your gumline, pausing briefly between teeth and around orthodontic hardware. Allow the water to flow into the sink.
5. **Complete Cleaning:** Continue until you have cleaned all areas of your mouth, including both the front and back surfaces of your teeth and around all orthodontic appliances.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and hygiene of your water flosser nozzles.

- **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, remove the nozzle from the flosser handle. Rinse the nozzle thoroughly under running water to remove any debris or residue.
- **Deep Cleaning (Weekly/Bi-weekly):** For a more thorough cleaning, soak the nozzle in a solution of 2 parts water and 1 part white vinegar for 10-15 minutes. Rinse thoroughly with fresh water afterward.
- **Storage:** Store cleaned nozzles in a dry, hygienic place, away from direct sunlight and dust.
- **Replacement:** It is recommended to replace water flosser nozzles every 3-6 months, or sooner if they show signs of wear or damage, to maintain optimal performance and hygiene.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Nozzle does not fit securely.	Incorrect nozzle type or not fully inserted.	Ensure the nozzle is compatible with your flosser model. Push firmly until a click is heard.
Weak or no water flow from nozzle.	Nozzle clogged or flosser unit issue.	Clean the nozzle as per maintenance instructions. Check your water flosser unit's manual for troubleshooting water flow issues.
Nozzle appears damaged.	Physical wear or accidental damage.	Replace the nozzle with a new one from the set.
