OXS Thunder Duo Speaker System User Manual

Model: Thunder DUO

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the OXS Thunder Duo Speaker System. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your new speaker system. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the device and retain it for future reference.

The OXS Thunder Duo is a 3.1.2 channel bookshelf speaker system designed for an immersive audio experience, compatible with various devices including TVs, PCs, gaming consoles, and mobile devices.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Power Source:** Use only the provided power adapter. Ensure the voltage matches your local power supply.
- **Placement:** Place the speakers on a stable, flat surface. Avoid placing near heat sources, direct sunlight, or in areas with high humidity or dust.
- **Ventilation:** Do not block any ventilation openings. Ensure adequate space around the speakers for proper airflow.
- **Water and Moisture:** Do not expose the device to water, rain, or moisture. This product is not waterproof.
- **Cleaning:** Disconnect from power before cleaning. Use a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosols.
- **Servicing:** Do not attempt to repair or disassemble the unit yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.

- **Batteries:** The remote control uses AAA batteries. Ensure correct polarity when inserting. Do not mix old and new batteries.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The OXS Thunder Duo speaker system consists of two bookshelf speakers designed for tabletop placement. Below is a general representation of the product and its typical components.

4.1. Speaker Components

- **Main Speaker Unit:** Houses the primary audio drivers and control circuitry.
- **Satellite Speaker Unit:** Connects to the main unit to provide a wider soundstage.
- **Power Input:** For connecting the power adapter.
- **Audio Inputs:** HDMI IN, USB-C, eARC, Optical for various source connections.

4.2. Remote Control

The included remote control allows for convenient operation of the speaker system from a distance. It typically includes buttons for:

- Power On/Off
- Volume Up/Down
- Input Source Selection (HDMI, USB-C, eARC, Optical)
- Mute

- Audio Mode Selection (e.g., Surround)

5. SETUP

5.1. Speaker Placement

Place the OXS Thunder Duo speakers on a stable, flat tabletop surface. For optimal sound, position them equidistant from your listening position and at ear level. Ensure there are no obstructions between the speakers and your listening area.

5.2. Power Connection

1. Connect the power adapter to the power input port on the main speaker unit.
2. Plug the power adapter into a wall outlet.
3. The power indicator on the speaker will illuminate, indicating it is in standby mode.

5.3. Connecting Audio Sources

The OXS Thunder Duo offers multiple connectivity options:

- **HDMI (eARC):** For connecting to TVs with an HDMI eARC/ARC port. Use the provided HDMI cable. This connection supports high-quality audio and allows TV remote control of speaker volume.
- **HDMI IN:** For connecting other HDMI-enabled devices like gaming consoles or Blu-ray players.
- **Optical:** For connecting to TVs or other devices with an optical audio output. Use the provided optical cable.
- **USB-C:** For connecting to PCs, laptops, or compatible mobile devices.

Connect your desired audio source to the corresponding input port on the main speaker unit.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Powering On/Off

Press the Power button on the remote control or the main speaker unit to turn the system on or off. The power indicator will change status accordingly.

6.2. Selecting Input Source

Press the 'Input' or dedicated source buttons (e.g., HDMI, Optical, USB-C) on the remote control to switch between connected audio sources. The current input source will typically be indicated by an LED or display on the main speaker unit.

6.3. Volume Control

Use the 'Volume Up' (+) and 'Volume Down' (-) buttons on the remote control to adjust the audio level. Press the 'Mute' button to temporarily silence the audio.

6.4. Audio Modes

The OXS Thunder Duo supports surround sound audio output. Use the 'Mode' button on the remote control to cycle through available audio modes, if applicable, to optimize your listening experience for different content types.

7. CONNECTIVITY

The OXS Thunder Duo offers versatile connectivity for a wide range of devices:

- **HDMI IN:** Connects to various HDMI-enabled devices.
- **USB-C:** Ideal for direct digital audio connection to computers (PC), laptops, and mobile devices running Windows, Android, or iOS.
- **eARC (Enhanced Audio Return Channel):** Connects to compatible TVs for high-fidelity audio transmission and simplified control.
- **Optical:** Provides a digital audio connection for TVs, game consoles (PlayStation, XBOX, Switch), and other devices with an optical output.

8. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and performance of your OXS Thunder Duo speaker system.

- **Cleaning:** Regularly wipe the speaker surfaces with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents.
- **Dust:** Keep the speaker grilles free from dust accumulation. Use a soft brush or a vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment on a low setting.
- **Storage:** If storing the speakers for an extended period, disconnect them from power and store them in a cool, dry place, preferably in their original packaging.

9. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your OXS Thunder Duo, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cable not connected; Power outlet not active; Speaker is off.	Ensure power cable is securely connected. Test the outlet with another device. Press the Power button on the remote or speaker.
No sound	Incorrect input source selected; Volume too low or muted; Audio cable not connected properly; Source device not outputting audio.	Select the correct input source. Increase volume and check if muted. Reconnect audio cables. Check audio settings on your source device.
Remote control not working	Batteries are dead or incorrectly inserted; Obstruction between remote and speaker.	Replace batteries, ensuring correct polarity. Remove any obstructions. Ensure remote is pointed at the main speaker unit.
Distorted sound	Volume too high; Poor audio source quality; Loose cable connection.	Lower the volume. Check the audio quality from the source. Ensure all cables are securely connected.
